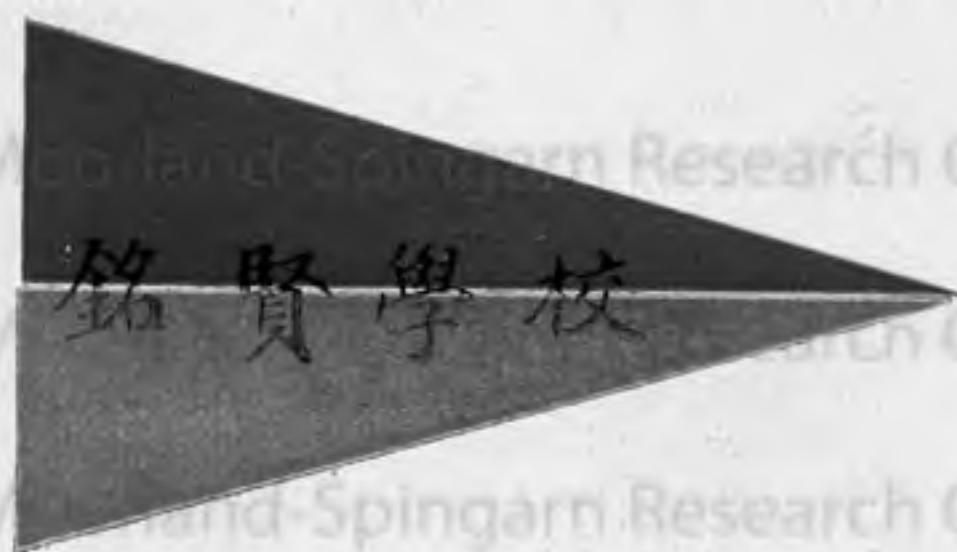

rooms for the school.

Is built in foreign style, with Chinese roof and  
windows steamheated throughout.

Cost \$10,000 gold.

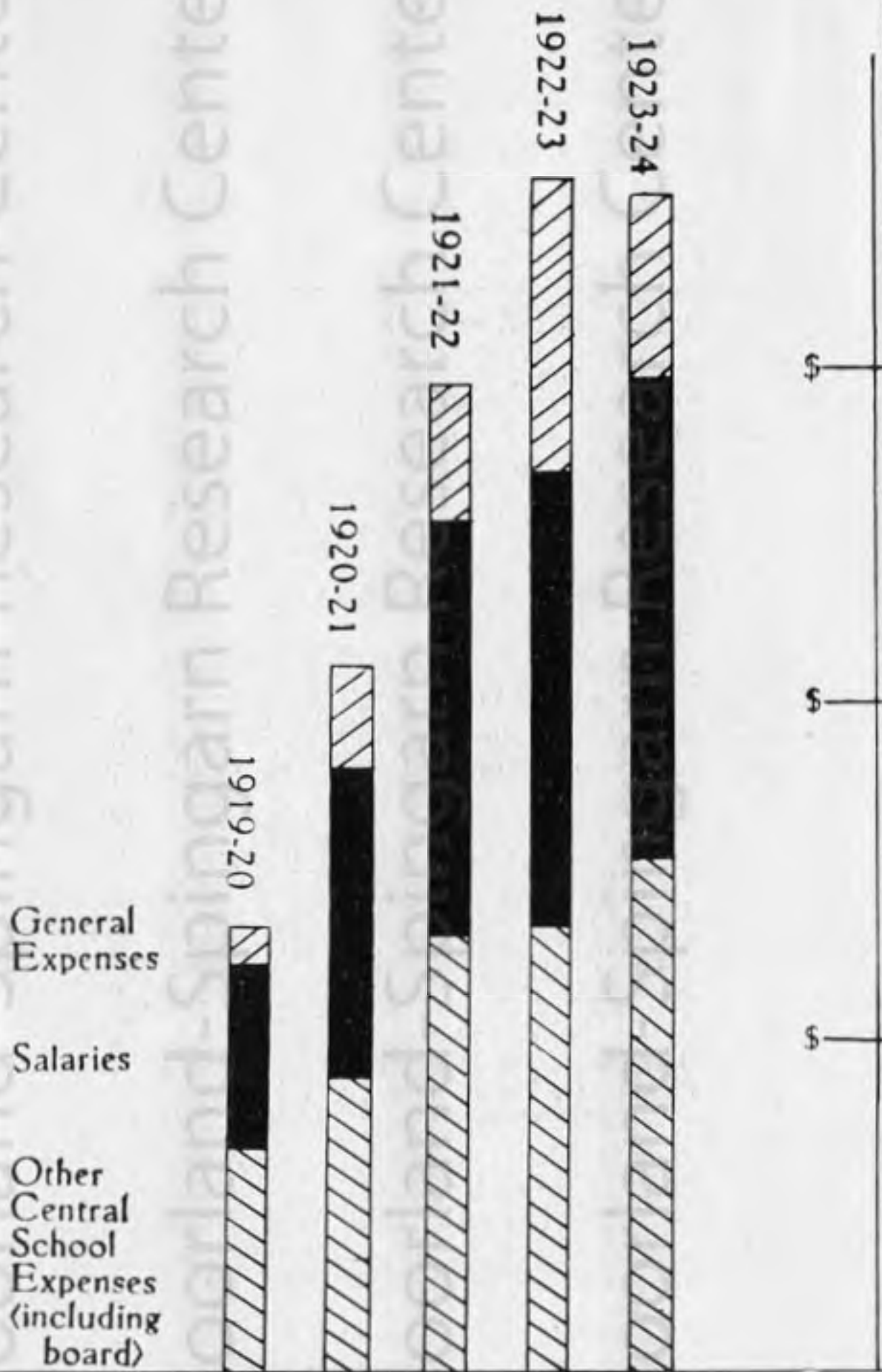

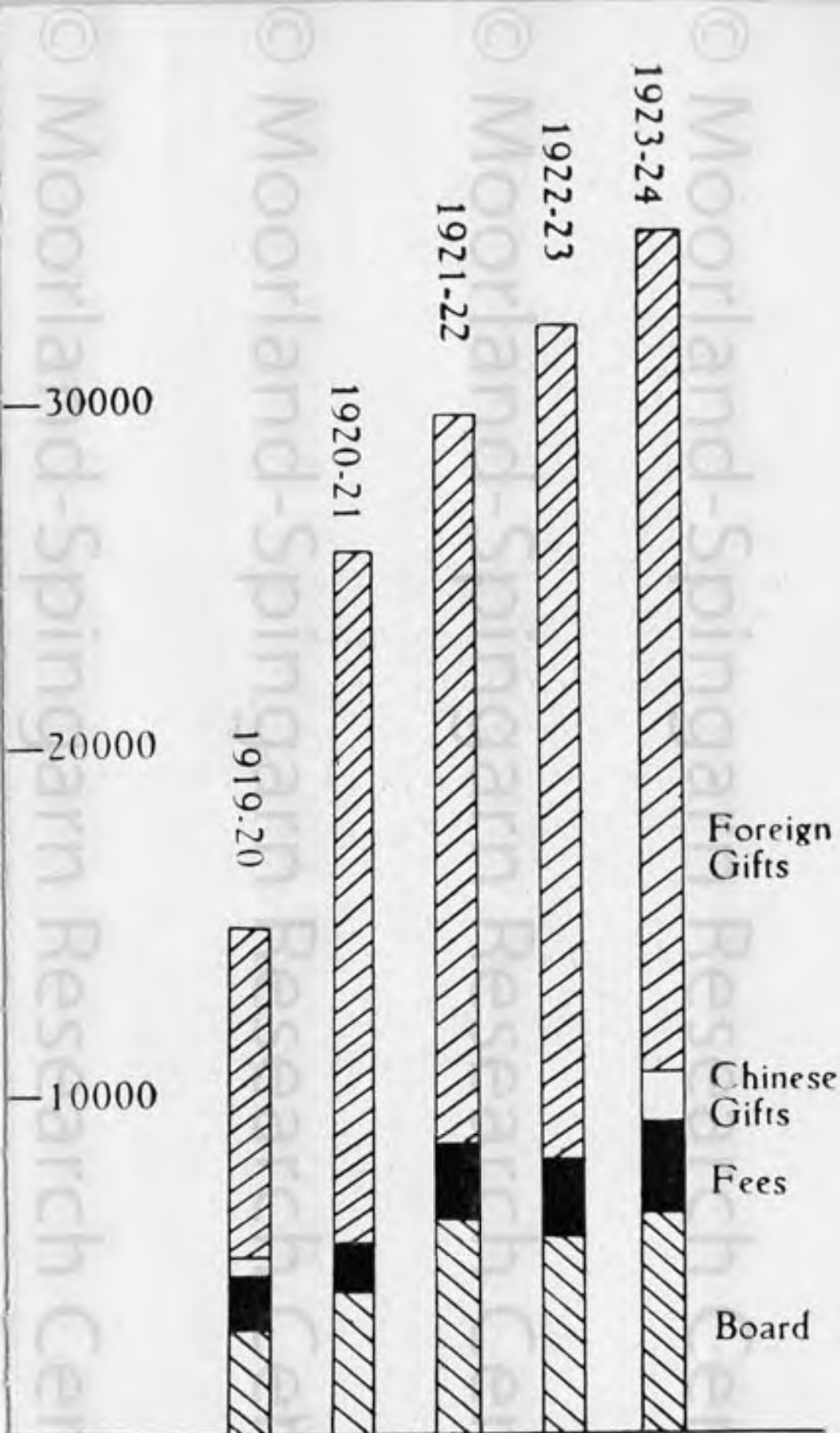

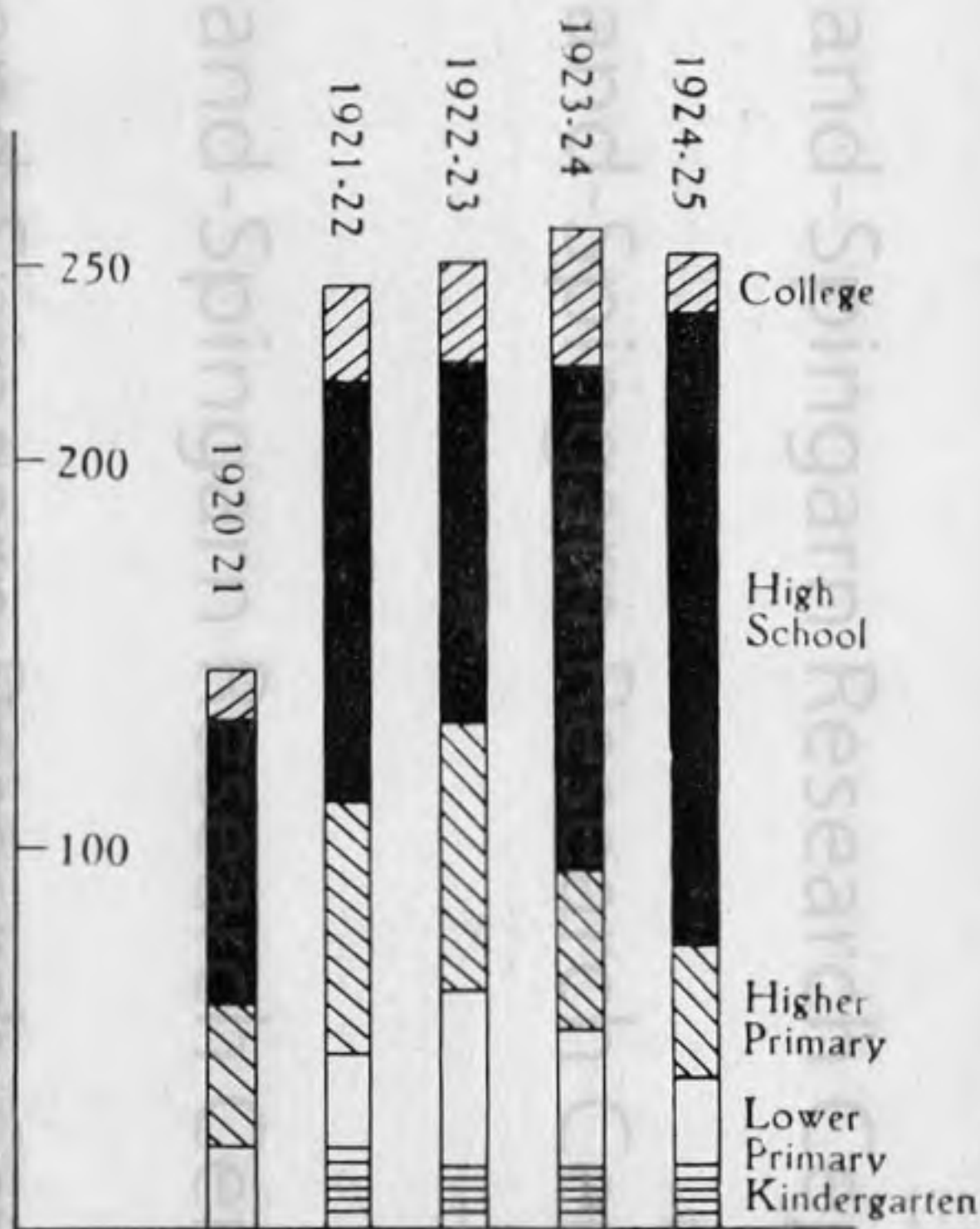
