Head quarters 4th Army Corps
Cleveland, Tennessee April 19th 1864

I congratulate you on getting so good a division and so good a staff. I can't think what you have done with Buschbeck. Steinweber, I believe, has gone to the 14th A. C. I am gratified for your courtesy in finishing up the little church [in Sackout Valley]. I will regard it a compliment to me, and a pleasant record to dedicate it "Howard Chapel". Give my kind regards to General Hooker and other friends.
