JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE
AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

January 28th, 1864.

RESOLVED; That the thanks of the American people and the thanks of their representatives in Congress are due, and are hereby tendered to Major General Oliver O. Howard, and the officers and soldiers of that army, for the skill and heroic valor which at Gettysburg repulsed, defeated and drove back, broken and dispirited, beyond the Rappahannock, the veteran army of the rebellion.
