The Conditions of the hiring of the Slaves
Belonging to the Estate of Duncan Wilson dec'd

The negroes are to be hired out for twelve months
those who hire are to furnish them with three Suits of
Clothing — one of which is to be wool. Two pair of
Shoes, Good Wool Hat & Blanket, & pay their
Doctor Bill.

The negroes are not
to be worked in the improvements of the Cape
Fear & deep River or on Rivers as Raft Hands
or to be taken out of Harnett County, except by
permission of the Adm^r Sheriff to give note
with two good and sufficient securities
and also Bonds for the delivery of the negroes
on the 1st of January 1859
