Dear Former 2515th Members,

Your friends and classmates that were transferred to Ft. Huachuca, Arizona have formed a club which is known as the "PROMETHIANS" after the Greek Goddess, "Promethius".

The purpose of this club is to keep in contact with the former 2515th Members for the duration. After the duration, the members plan to meet in Washington and organize into a strong body. Some of the planned functions are to give information (Army & otherwise), moral building assistance, and financial aid to the members. It is also planned that a monthly bulletin be published in the form of a mimeographed sheet telling of the whereabouts and happenings of the PROMETHIANS.

A voluntary contribution of fifty cents (minimum) or more per month to defray the expenses of the club, will be sent to Dr. Merze Tate, c/o PROMETHIANS, Howard University, Washington 1, D. C. If enough money is collected, the PROMETHIANS plan to give financial assistance to its members. For Example: If a member needs money for an emergency furlout etc., he can, by sending a signed statement by his CO or other responsible person (Chaplin etc.), obtain the money from Dr. Tate, with the consent of two other members of the Comptrollers of the Funds. A Form will be sent to each member of the PROMETHIANS for this purpose.

Any person interested in joining the PROMETHIANS can do so by contacting Dr. Tate through medium of the enclosed application blank. If there is more than one former 2515th member on your post, group action headed by your chosen group leader, is favored. In such case, group leaders will forward all applications and contribution for the entire group, indicating the amount contributed by each applicant.
