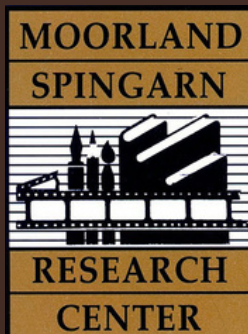

THE RESOURCES OF THE MOORLAND-SPINGARN RESEARCH CENTER COMBINE TO PROVIDE IMPORTANT INSIGHT INTO THE GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT OF BLACK FAMILIES, ORGANIZATIONS, INSTITUTIONS, SOCIAL AND RELIGIOUS CONSCIOUSNESS, AND THE CONTINUING STRUGGLE FOR CIVIL RIGHTS AND HUMAN JUSTICE. 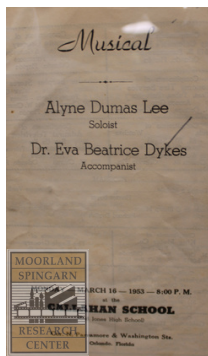

Woman seeking historical facts is 'first lady' in many categories

Mrs. Katherine Stewart Flippin, daughter of Oregon's first Negro attorney, is going to "revisit" her birthplace in Portland, the first time she was born, in another first.

Mrs. Flippin, West Coast representative of Howard University Archives, largest predominantly Negro university in the United States, is visiting Portland to "revisit" and preserve old historical documents, authentic material, concerning the Negro's assistance in developing the West.

Mrs. Flippin said there is very little authentic, documented material about the Negro's participation in the Pacific Northwest, although Howard University has a substantial collection of historical documents concerning the Midwest and East.

"Much of this valuable information is stored in attics, basements and old trunks," she said. "The young people do not realize its value and when the oldsters are gone it will be destroyed.

The material, Mrs. Flippin said, is being gathered for research by graduate students from Yale, Harvard and other universities to lay a foundation for black studies curriculum. "We need an authentic, documented, historical foundation on which to base research for establishing black studies curriculum," the wife of the late Bob Flippin, Washington State University football star, said.

The Moorland Library is attempting to develop a complete collection of Negro history. "Through inaccurate information a hysteria develops and by the same token the hysteria has led to inaccurate information in current textbooks," Mrs. Flippin asserted.

Her immediate family has contributed numerous "firsts" in Negro history and culture. Her husband sponsored the first Alcoholics Anonymous chapter in a prison. With the aid of warden Clayton Duffy, the first world was started in California's San Quentin Prison.

Her father, McCants Stewart, a 1903 graduate of the University of Minnesota Law School, came to Oregon and was admitted to the Oregon State Bar April 27, 1906.

Clay Stewart, an attorney, was U.S. ambassador to the Virgin Islands and was sent by the U.S. government from the Virgin Islands to the first conference that dealt with drafting the first constitution of the Hawaiian Islands.

The Royal Library of Hawaii has the story of his political activity, Mrs. Flippin said.

"The purpose of my Portland visit is to correct inaccuracies and to bring about an awareness of the desirability of preserving old documents dealing with Negro activity," Mrs. Flippin emphasized.

Mrs. Flippin said she was born at 513 N. Union Ave., on property that belonged to Lilburn and Maria Waterford, who came over the Oregon Trail in a covered wagon.

Another first in Mrs. Flippin's historic family association was her father-in-law, Dr. George Albert Flippin, who was the first captain of the football team at the University of Nebraska and a medical doctor who had the first and only hospital in southern Nebraska — in a little Swedish community of Stromberg.

She said the Moorland Library is especially interested in old photographs, old documents, names, dates and places, old documents, old material of personal interest. Portland citizens have been asked to donate such material to the Moorland Library.

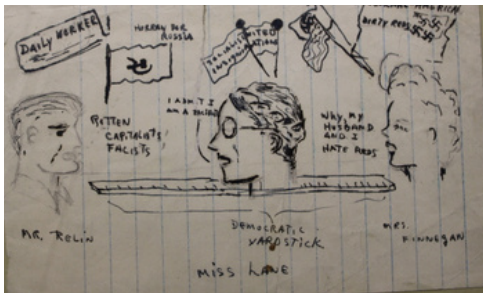

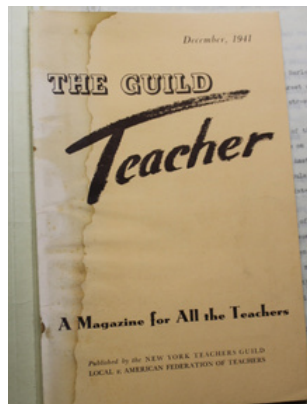
