Two of the fully identified members of the Newsom family include William Jennings Newsom and John T.C. Newsom. William Jennings Newsom served as a reserve army officer and high school teacher. John T.C. Newsom operated the Eureka Exchange in Washington, D.C.

Two of the family members featured most prominently are William Jennings Newsom and John T.C. Newsom.
