
Dear Mrs. Cooper:

Referring to your letter of December 11, 1954, with respect to the Frelinghuysen University trust account and savings account, we transmit herewith statement prepared as of January 6, 1955, which shows the bonds originally received, purchased and redeemed since the establishment of the trust. There is also enclosed a statement showing the date the savings account was charged for the fees we have received.

On January 10, 1955, we received the proceeds of redemption of the \$100 Series F bond due January 1, 1955, which makes a balance of \$114.00. To this balance, we have added the sum of \$30.00, withdrawn from the savings account, and have issued instructions for the purchase of two \$100.00 Series "J" bonds at a total cost of \$144.00. We return the savings passbook.

We trust that with this letter and the enclosed statements you will understand the transactions taken place in the University's trust and savings accounts.
