Dear Mr. Nabrit:

Received this ballot today but too late to be of any use as it has to be in your hands by February 5th 1945. There are many Howard men & women here in Italy and in other parts of the war zones who are similarly affected. The two weeks allowed by the Committee for the receiving and returning of the ballot was, in the case of the overseas alumni, a great injustice. Should next year find us still overseas, I trust that some consideration will be given to the length of time necessary for forwarding, receiving, and returning the ballot in time for it to be valid. I don't profess to speak for all the alumni overseas but the ones here in my unit feel as I do.
