## THE CHATEAU OF CHAUMONT

### NOTICE

This castle was constructed during the reign of Charles I of Chaumont in the 15th century, on the grounds of a fort erected by Eudes I, comte de Blois in the 10th century.

Cardinal Georges of Amboise was born there in 1463 and was the first minister of King Louis XII. Catherine de Medicis bought it from the Amboise family and on the death of Henry II compelled

Diane of Poitiers to live Chenonceau and gave her the Chateau of Chaumont by the owner who was then M. Leray.

In the interior of the chateau the most historical exhibits of note are :

The guard room containing armoured reliefs of the 15th and 16th century. The consulting room. Wonderful Brussels tapisteries 15th century, magnificent flooring from Palermo (Italy). The bedroom of Catherine de Medicis; old fashioned bed of the 16th century. Beautiful gothic furniture of early days. Medal of Nini. La chapelle with its splendid stained glass windows erected during the period of the Restauration of Chaumont, by Prince Amédée de Broglie, after the model of J.-P. Laurens. The bedroom of Ruggieri, the magician of Catherine de Medicis in which are to be found many beautiful portraits.

The bedroom of Diane of Poitiers, installed in the tower is very curious.
