2. ~~"Verily I say unto you, except ye ^{be} converted & become as little children ye shall not enter into the kingdom of Heaven.~~

Whoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of Heaven, & whoso shall receive one such little child in my name, receiveth me. But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck & that he were drowned in the depth of the sea."

"My brethren have not the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of Glory, with respect of persons. For if there come unto your assembly a man with a gold ring, in goodly apparel, & there come in also a poor man in vile raiment;

& ye have respect to him that weareth the gay clothing, & say unto him, Sit thou here in a good place; & say to the poor stand thou there, or sit here under my footstool: are ye not then partial in yourselves?"

"If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself, ye do well: But if ye have respect to persons ye commit sin, being convicted by the law as transgressors.

"For whosoever shall keep the whole law, & yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all."

"Have put on the new man which is renewed
in knowledge after the image of him that
created him: Where there is neither Greek nor
Jew; circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian,
Scythian, bond nor free: but Christ is all in all!"

"I beseech thee for my son Onesimus, whom
I have begotten in my bonds. whom I have sent
again: thou therefore receive him... Not now
as a servant, but above a servant, a brother
beloved; specially to me, but how much more
unto thee, both in the flesh & in the Lord! If thou
count me therefore a partner, receive him
as myself. If he hath wronged thee or oweth
anything, put that on mine account... I will
repay it."

"Then shall the king say unto them on his
right hand: Come ye blessed of my Father, inherit
the kingdom prepared for you from the
foundation of the world."

 done it unto me.
