Raimond Mussana J. M. C. the Sum of Two Hund-
-red and Fifty Dollars on account of the
Succession of the late Captain Eugene Sheridan
which money is paid by said Mussana and
received by me with the distinct understanding
that the slave Sylvanie which was to have
been sold this day by the Sheriff at the
Succession Sale of said Sheridan shall
be forthwith emancipated at the expense
of the said Raimond Mussana and
the said Succession of said Sheridan is
not to be put to any expenses whatever
concerning said slave - and the ^{rest} of
of the life of the said Sylvanie is ~~to be~~
