SCOPE NOTE

The papers of A. Mercer Daniel (1887-1976), attorney, writer, educator, and librarian, span the period from 1890 to 1971, and measure three linear feet. Daniel's service to the Howard University School of Law lasted for more than thirty-five years. In 1923, Daniel took a part-time position in the law library, which eventually grew into a full-time career. In addition to his own papers, Daniel donated Charles Houston's files, and scrapbooks compiled by former Howard students. Together, these materials chronicle the history of the law school.

Daniel served during a colorful period in the school's history. In 1929 Charles Houston began to change the school from a small evening program into a fully-accredited, day law school. Among the incidents that Houston's files document are disputes with Daniel's predecessor, James Waters Jr., and the effort to win accreditation. The collection also includes Daniel's unpublished history of the School of Law, and law school printed material. Scrapbook #2 provides a rich window of events at Howard University, including the law department, at the turn-ofthe-twentieth century.

A. Mercer Daniel donated the collection to MSRC in 1970 and 1973.

Note: The Civil Rights Documentation Project in the Oral History Department contains the transcript of a 1968 interview with Daniel.
