Richmond to Wit

This day Samuel Dunaway brought before
me a Runaway Negro Slave named bit. Belonging to the
Hon^{ble} Robert Carter Esquire of Westmoreland County (as he
says) which Slave the said Samuel Dunaway made
Oath before me that he took up at his Dwelling Planta-
tion in this County, which is in my Opinion six miles
from his Place of Abode, Certified under my Hand this
25th day of October 1773

Wm. Hall - March 11th 1775
then received of Robert Carter Esq^r -
Seven Shillings for taking up & delivering
negro Kid. the Person, mentioned in the above Certificate
