FOR three years Dr. William E. Ingram, of Providence, R. I., has conducted a Dental Health Program in connection with his private practice.

On October 18, 1935, the program for the fourth year was appropriately launched in his office at 56 Washington Street.

The meeting was attended by over two hundred people and twenty-five certificates in Oral Health were awarded to the contestants. The principal speaker was Dr. William H. Higgins, past president of the National Medical Association, who spoke on the subject, "The Price of Dental and Medical Neglect." Music was rendered by Cecile Lawrence's "Modernettes."

Subsequent meetings were held on October twenty-third, November first and fifteenth, at which lectures and demonstrations appropriate for Dental Health Education were given.
