Dear Dr. Gate,

Now that the war is over, I have made a few plans for a meeting of the fellows in the 1st Bn. There are only seven of us left in this Battalion now. Since the 2nd Bn is only about ten miles from here at Nesci, Italy, my plans are to contact the men of that Bn. as soon as possible, so we can have a larger group.

S/Sgt Owen & Harms returned from the hospital recently where he was treated for wounds suffered from shrapnel. I talked with him last week. Harold Brown is a Capt. in 371st personnel section.

Since the cessation of hostilities here, our mail is not censored by the unit censor and we can talk more freely - telling where we are, etc. This city is northwest of Genoa and southwest of Milan. Very few, hardly any, of us have the necessary 85 points for a discharge.
