CORPORATION OF LYNCHBURG, to wit :

Whereas complaint hath been made to me, *Henry M. Bidlake* a Justice of the
Peace for the Corporation aforesaid, on the oath of *John Adams*
that, on the *2^d* day of *April* at the Corporation aforesaid, *Harriet*

Rouse a free woman of colour did use much abusive
language to him the sa. Adams and also that the said *Harriet*
did use the most abusive language in the presence and
hearing of many gentle females and much other conduct
of the most ungentle character in the street.

These are, therefore, to require you forthwith to apprehend the said *Harriet Rouse*
and bring *her* before me, or some other
Justice of the Peace for the Corporation aforesaid, to answer the said complaint, and farther to be dealt with accord-
ing to law. Given under my hand and seal, this *13th* day of *April*, 183 *3*
