Scope Note

The papers of Francis James Grimke, Presbyterian minister, lecturer, and trustee of Howard University, total 23 linear feet and span the period 1833 to 1937. The papers are comprised primarily of writings by Francis Grimke, including sermons, addresses, tributes, obsequies, and notes prepared for prayer meeting, covenant meetings, and adult bible classes. There is also an extensive amount of correspondence. Correspondents include Frederick and Helen Douglass, William Lloyd Garrison, Edward W. Blyden, Benjamin Brawley, and Archibald Grimke. Some of the writings and correspondence have been published in Carter G. Woodson's work, The Works of Francis J. Grimke (Associated Publisher. Washington, D.C., 1942). There is a small amount of personal papers of Francis Grimke, that include his will, a brief autobiography, his academic record while attending Lincoln University, and records documenting his call as pastor to the 15th Street Presbyterian Church, Washington, D.C.

In addition to Francis Grimke's papers are some personal papers of his wife Charlotte Forten Grimke, teacher and writer. Her papers consist of the originals and typescripts of five diaries spanning the period 1854-1892, a few poems, an article "At Sea - 1862", and a calling card plate.

Biographical Sketch

1850 Nov. 4	Born in Charleston, South Carolina, son of Henry and Nancy Weston Grimke.
1870	Received an A.M. degree from Lincoln University, Chester County, Pennsylvania.
1871	Studied law at Howard University Law Department.
1875	Entered Princeton Theological Seminary, Princeton, New Jersey.
1877	Served the pulpit of 15th Street Presbyterian Church, Washington, D.C. during the summer months.
1878	Graduated from Princeton Theological Seminary, called to pastor the 15th Street Presbyterian Church.
1878 July 7	Ordination and Installation services, 15th. Street Presbyterian Church
1878 Dec. 9	Married Charlotte Forten.
1885	Resigned for health reasons from the 15th Street Church, and went to Laura Street Presbyterian Church, Jacksonville, Florida.
1888	Received an honorary degree from Lincoln University.
1889	Accepted an invitation, to return as pastor of the 15th Street Presbyterian Church.
1914	Charlotte Forten Grimke died.
1923 Oct. 14	Resigned as pastor of the 15th Street Church after over 40 years of service. Resignation refused by the congregation.
1928 July 1	50th Anniversary of ordination to the Christian ministry and his installation as pastor of the 15th

Street Presbyterian Church. He held the pastorate until his death.

1937 Oct. 11 Died.

Scope Note

The papers of Francis James Grimke, Presbyterian minister, lecturer, and trustee of Howard University, total 23 linear feet and span the period 1833 to 1937. The papers are comprised primarily of writings by Francis Grimke, including sermons, addresses, tributes, obsequies, and notes prepared for prayer meeting, covenant meetings, and adult bible classes. There is also an extensive amount of correspondence. Correspondents include Frederick and Helen Douglass, William Lloyd Garrison, Edward W. Blyden, Benjamin Brawley, and Archibald Grimke. Some of the writings and correspondence have been published in Carter G. Woodson's work, The Works of Francis J. Grimke (Associated Publisher. Washington, D.C., 1942). There is a small amount of personal papers of Francis Grimke, that include his will, a brief autobiography, his academic record while attending Lincoln University, and records documenting his call as pastor to the 15th Street Presbyterian Church, Washington, D.C.

In addition to Francis Grimke's papers are some personal papers of his wife Charlotte Forten Grimke, teacher and writer. Her papers consist of the originals and typescripts of five diaries spanning the period 1854-1892, a few poems, an article "At Sea - 1862", and a calling card plate.
