Dear Dr. Tate,

I hope this letter finds you in good health. The members of the Promethians over here are making out fairly good. I want to let you know why you may not be hearing so much from us over here. The disposition of a combat unit in combat is so often muddled that it is virtually impossible for us to see each other. As a matter of fact, I haven't seen some of the fellows in my battalion in over a month. I can assure you, however, that as soon as we are able to get together to call a meeting we will do so and we will be sure to let you know what took place. I hope that the financial end of the picture is working out. I am afraid that such things as that will often slip from the memory over here. However, we will try to remedy that at the earliest possible moment - I intend writing a letter to the battalion adjutant there to find out what they intend to do about organizing. I'll probably have to write it in care of you so please pass it on for me.
