Know all Men by these presents that we

Augustin Brown Joseph Griffin
are held and firmly bound unto

in the penal sum of fourteen hundred Dollars and Blank
Cents, to which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, and each of our heirs, firmly by these
presents; sealed with our seals, and dated the 22nd day of February 1828

The condition of the above obligation is such, That whereas Geo. P
Sheriff of the County of Madison State of
Alabama, by his Deputy Geo. E. Bayler hath by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias,
issued out of the County Court of said County, on the 8th day of Sept
1827 against the Goods and Chattels, Lands and Tenements, of the above bounden Lewis Moor
at the suit of the above mentioned

for the sum of six hundred & eighty five Dollars and 25th
Cents debt, Joseph Griffin
Dollars and Cents damages, and the
further sum of Dollars and Cents costs of suit, re-
turnable on the 22nd Monday in February 1828

next, levied upon the following goods and chattels of the above bounden

Lewis Moor *viz:* three Negroes - so wit Chan
age about 30 years Charles age about
12 years Robert age about six

Now if the above bounden Lewis Moor & Augustin
Brown

shall produce and deliver to the said sheriff, or other proper officer, at the Court house
in the town of Huntsville

on the fourth day of February at twelve o'clock, (noon) of that day,
being the time appointed for the sale of the above mentioned goods and chattels, then this obligation to be void,
otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
