Scope Note

The Hobson Normal Institute Collection was donated by the Society of Hobsonites in 1953. The Institute was founded in Parsons, Kansas by the Iowa yearly meeting of the Society of Friends in 1882. The purpose of the school was to train students for the teaching profession and provide higher education for Negro youth in the border states, where segregation limited Negro schools to the eighth grade. The school was closed in 1896.

The collection contains 39 items spanning the period 1882-1953. Included are brief sketches of the history of Hobson Normal Institute, its first principal Darius W. Bowles, and the Society of Hobsonites. Also, there is memorabilia consisting of catalogues, programs, diploma, and a gavel. The collection included photographs of the Bowles family, and of students who attended the institute.
