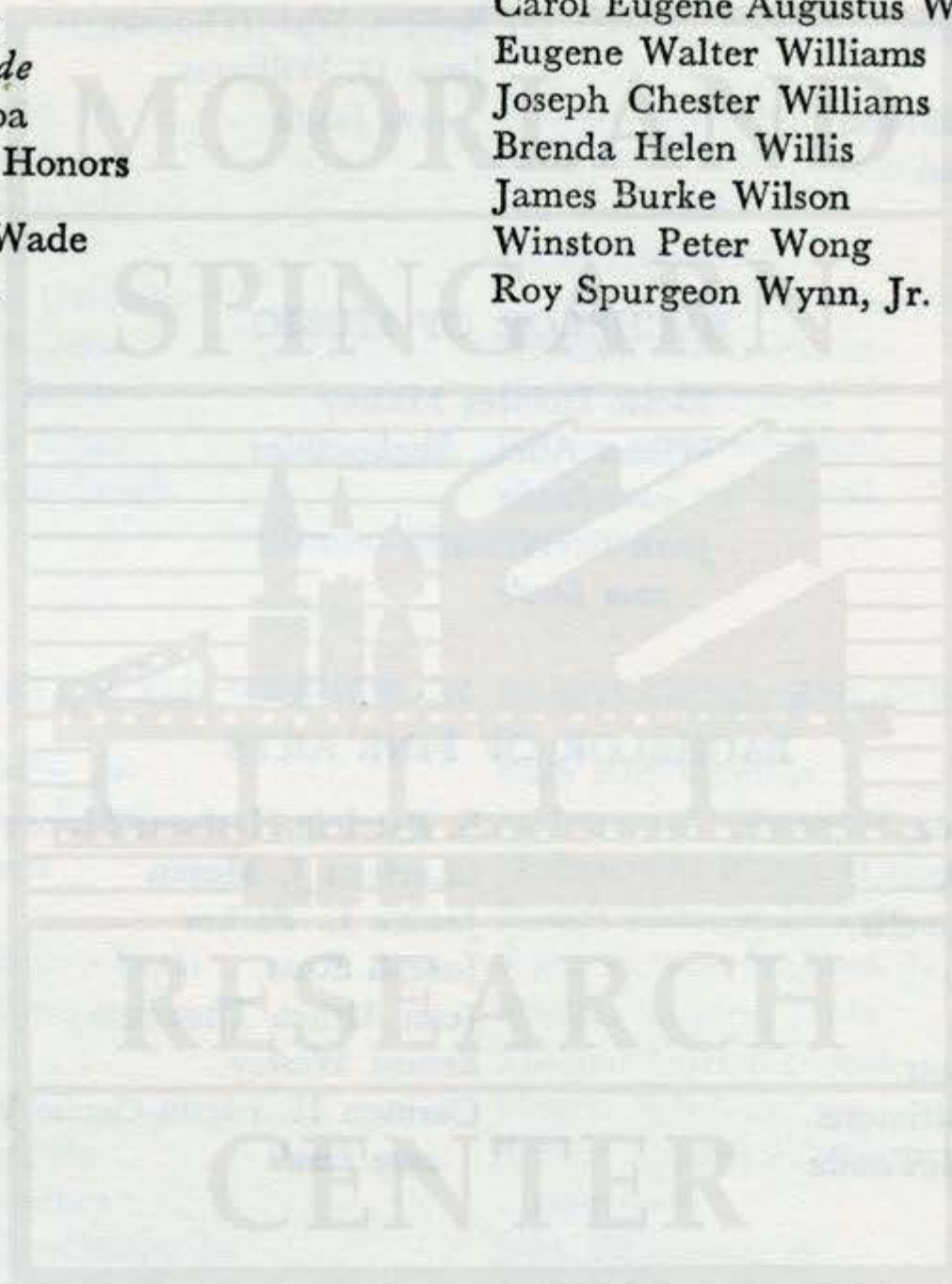

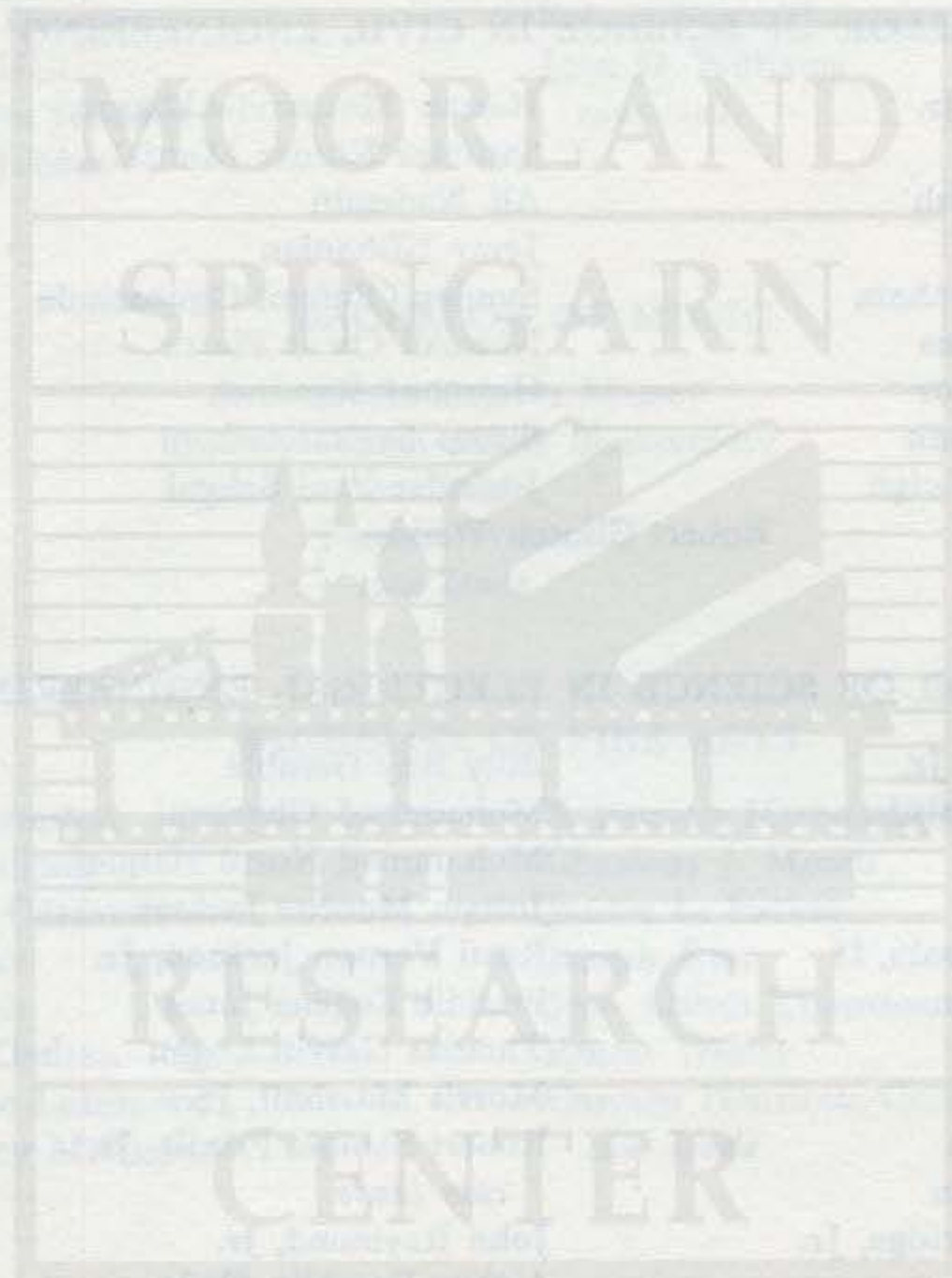

HONORARY DEGREES

DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS

Michael Marks Davis

Michael Marks Davis, retired medical administrator and pioneer in the nation's effort to provide medical care for all of its people, is a native of New York City. He holds the Bachelor of Arts and Doctor of Philosophy degrees from Columbia University. Dr. Davis' career began in 1898, when, as a 19-year old student, he joined the staff of a settlement house in New York City. He was later to serve as director of the Boston Dispensary, the Committee on Dispensary Development of the United Hospital Fund, and as director of Medical Services at the Julius Rosenwald Fund.

From 1932 to 1935 Dr. Davis served as a professorial lecturer at the University of Chicago, as well as consultant to the President's Committee on Economic Security, and consultant in health studies for the Social Security Board. He returned to New York in 1937 to become chairman of the Committee on Research in Medical Economics. He later helped organize and served as chairman of the executive committee of the Committee for the Nation's Health.

In recognition of his outstanding work during a career of more than 60 years, the University of Chicago in 1963 established the **Michael M. Davis Lectureship** in "The Social and Economic Aspects of Medical Care."

DOCTOR OF LAWS

Charles Goode Gomillion

Charles Goode Gomillion, professor of sociology at Tuskegee (Ala.) Institute and a leader in the effort to obtain equal opportunities for the Negroes of Macon County, Alabama, is a native of Johnston, S.C. He holds the Bachelor of Arts degree from Paine College in Augusta, Ga. and the Doctor of Philosophy degree from Ohio State University. He began his career in 1923 as a high school principal at Milledgeville, Ga., and received his initial appointment to the faculty at Tuskegee Institute as an instructor in history in 1928. At Tuskegee he was to serve at different times as dean of the School of Education, dean of students, and chairman of the Division of Social Sciences. He was appointed professor of sociology in 1957.

In 1947 Dr. Gomillion was elected president of the Tuskegee Civic Association, an off-campus organization established for the purpose of obtaining equal rights for Negroes. In this capacity he has been at the forefront of the civil rights movement in Macon County. His efforts gained national attention in 1960, when the Association's suit to prevent Alabama from gerrymandering the boundaries of the city of Tuskegee to exclude 3,000 Negro voters was upheld by the U.S. Supreme Court.

Under Dr. Gomillion's leadership Negroes in Macon County have registered and voted in unprecedented numbers. Two Negroes have been elected to the five-man Tuskegee City Council, while Dr. Gomillion has himself been elected to the County Board of Education.

DOCTOR OF LAWS

Roy W. Wilkins

Roy Wilkins, executive secretary of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored people and one of the foremost leaders in the effort to obtain equal rights for Negroes in America, is a native of St. Louis, Mo. He holds the Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Minnesota. Mr. Wilkins began his career in 1923 as managing editor of the Kansas City Call newspaper. He joined the staff of the NAACP in 1931 as assistant secretary, was named acting secretary in 1949, administrator in 1950, and executive secretary in April 1955.

Under the 10-year administration of Mr. Wilkins the membership and financial resources of the nation's oldest and largest civil rights organization have more than doubled. As in the past, the NAACP's primary emphasis in the civil rights movement has been on legislation and litigation; however, the organization has in recent years joined other groups in direct action protests. It also has supplied legal counsel and hundreds of thousands of dollars in bail bond money for members of other civil rights organizations.

In recognition of his outstanding leadership, the NAACP last June conferred upon Mr. Wilkins its highest award, the Spingarn Medal.
