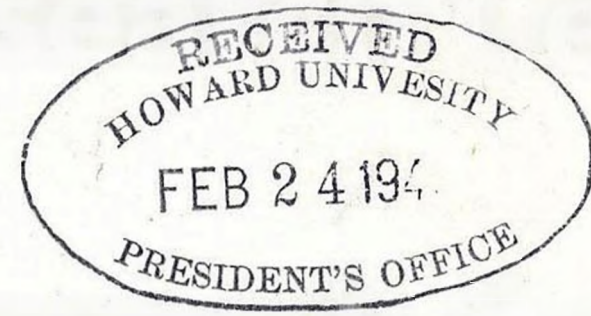

My dear Mr. Johnston.

Yesterday a copy of President Johnson's letter came to me by way of Warrant Officer John Brice who is now in Fort Bragg, N.C. There are several Howard men on the staff of the hospital where we are assigned and to us the letter was indeed one from home. I have posted it upon our bulletin board and all Howard men here will forward information and pictures etc. as will be within the censorship rules.

My father, brothers and sisters, and brothers-in law are Howard graduates. I shall be glad to have my name on Howard's service roster. My name, rank etc. follows:
