Will be held in the Vestry-Room, or in the Church, on MONDAY next, at 4 o'Clock in the Afternoon, (in Compliance with a Requisition delivered to the Churchwardens,) "To take into Consideration the Propriety of presenting Petitions to Both Houses of Parliament early in the next Sessions, praying them to adopt Prompt and Vigorous Measures to Ameliorate the present Condition of the Slaves, and eventually to abolish Slavery in our West India Colonies."
