

### Honorary Degrees

### DOCTOR OF SCIENCE

LLOYD N. FERGUSON

Lloyd Noel Ferguson grew up in Oakland, California, where he was born in 1918. Attending the University of California at Berkeley, he graduated with the degree of Bachelor of Science in 1940, and earned the Doctor of Science degree from the same university in 1943.

For three years after his graduation Mr. Ferguson remained at the university in Berkeley as a research assistant for the National Defense Project, then went on to Greensboro's Agricultural & Technical College, as assistant professor.

In 1945 Lloyd Ferguson joined the faculty of Howard University, where he worked for twenty-one years. He became Professor of Chemistry in 1955, and for eight years was chairman of the department until he left Howard to become Professor of Chemistry at the California State College in Los Angeles.

Dr. Ferguson's achievements have been widely recognized in the United States and abroad. He was government chemist at the National Bureau of Standards and the Naval Ordance Laboratory in the summers of 1950 and 1951, and three years later became series lecturer in Copenhagen, Denmark and Lund, Sweden. He was Guggenheim Fellow at the Carlsberg Laboratory in Copenhagen from 1953-1954, has travelled New York State as a touring lecturer, and has been visiting professor at the University of Oregon for three summers. In 1959 he became visiting scientist in the division of chemical education for the American Chemisal Society, and was a National Science Foundation faculty fellow at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology in Zurich, 1961-1962.

A member of the Chemical Society of Washington, for which he has been at various times, on the board of managers and then treasurer, Lloyd Ferguson is also a Fellow of the Chemical Society of London. He is a member of the American Chemical Society, the American Association for the Advancement of Science, the Washington Academy of Scientists, the American Association of University Professors, the National Institute of Science, and belongs to the fraternity Sigma Xi.

Dr. Ferguson is the author of three books; Electron Structure of Organic Molecules, 1952; Textbook of Organic Chemistry, 1958; The Modern Structural Theory of Organic Chemistry, 1963; and numerous articles.

He is married to the former Gwendolyn Louise Johnson. They have three children.

### DOCTOR OF LAWS LLOYD K. GARRISON

Lloyd Kirkham Garrison was born in New York City on November 19, 1897. As an undergraduate he studied at Harvard University, earning the Bachelor of Arts degree in 1919, and graduating Bachelor of Laws in 1922.

After being admitted to the New York State Bar, Mr. Garrison began his legal career in New York City, where he joined the firm of Root, Clark, Buckner and Howland. Four years later he began practicing with Parker and Garrison, where he worked until 1932. During this time he was also Treasurer of the National Urban League, of which he was later to become president and director.

Mr. Garrison returned to university life to become Dean of the University of Wisconsin Law School and Professor of Law, positions he held for thirteen years. He also served as a member of the Howard University Board of Trustees from 1935 until his resignation in 1949, when he was elected an Honorary Trustee.

Active in a number of other fields outside the university, Mr. Garrison became Vice-Chairman of the National Committee of the American Civil Liberties Union. He co-authored with Solicitor General Thacher a Report to the President on the Bankruptcy Act and its Administration in the Courts of the United States; became Chairman of the National Labor Relations Board; and was appointed a referee for the National Railroads Adjustment Board. Mr. Garrison also became a panel member of the International Board of Arbitration of the American Newspaper Publishers Association, and the International Printing Pressmen and Assistant Union of North America. He was a member of the Arbitration

Board under agreement between the Tennessee Valley Authority and the Tennessee Valley Trades and Labor Council. Lawrence College conferred on him the degree of Doctor of Laws in 1942, the same year that he became General Counsel and Executive Director for the National War Labor Board, of which he later became a public member, and then chairman.

In 1946, Mr. Garrison left the University to join Paul, Weiss, Rifkind, Wharton and Garrison. But he continued his service to society, becoming Director of the American Arbitration Association, being appointed to the Board of Directors for the National Academy of Arbitrators, and serving on the Labor Advisory Committee of the Atomic Energy Commission, and the Legal Advisory Committee of the National Security Resources Board. A Democrat, he became a member of the New York State Commission and the New York County Commission. He was also on the Executive Committee of the Bar Association for New York City, a member of that city's Board of Education, and later Vice President of the Board.

Mr. Garrison has added to his list of achievements his work as trustee for the Institute for Advanced Study, the Practicing Law Institute, the Potomac Institute, and trustee and Vice President of the Taconic Foundation. He is also a member of the Board of Directors for the Field Foundation, and was awarded the degree of Doctor of Laws from the University of Wisconsin in 1964.

He and his wife Ellen live in New York. They have three children.

### DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS

JESSE L. JACKSON

Jesse Louis Jackson, National Director of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference's Operation Breadbasket was born in 1941 in Greenville, South Carolina. A graduate of Sterling High School in Greenville, he attended the University of Illinois on a football scholarship from 1959-1960, then studied at A & T College in Greensboro, where he graduated in 1964 with the degree of Bachelor of Science in sociology.

In the same year Chicago Theological Seminary admitted Mr. Jackson to its Bachelor of Divinity program, where he completed two year's study. While studying at the Seminary, he was awarded a grant by the Rockefeller Fund for Theological Education.

From the beginning of his college days Jesse Jackson was active in numerous organizations and activities. President of Agricultural and Technical College student government from 1963-1964, he was a delegate to the World Assembly of Youth in 1963, a delegate to the United States Youth Council in 1963-1964, and represented A & T College for two years in the North Carolina State Student Legislature. A member of the Young Democrats Club, he served as representative from North Carolina at the National Convention in Las Vegas, and was responsible for the move to organize Young Democrat organizations at the black colleges in North Carolina. In addition he was a field representative for the southeastern region at the Congress of Racial Equality (CORE); was leader of the Greenville civil rights movement in 1960, and later the Greensboro civil rights movement; was elected President of the North Carolina Intercollege Council on Human Rights; was appointed liaison officer to Governor Sanford's office; and chosen to direct a series of statewide television programs and tutorial projects.

Reverend Jackson is a former Director of Field Activities for the Coordinating Council of Community Organizations, and is an Associate Minister at the Fellowship Missionary Baptist Church in Chicago. For some time he was Director of Special Projects and Economic Development of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, and was appointed by Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. to be the National Director of Operation Breadbasket, a position he still holds.

Though still a young man, his activities have already brought him considerable public recognition. He was listed in Who's Who in American Colleges and Universities in 1964; was Greensboro's "Citizen of the Year"; Omega "Man of the Year," was given an award for representing most effectively the college's ideals for community service by the Gate City Alumni Chapter of the Agricultural and Technical College; was made the Chicago Club Frontiers International "Man of the Year" in 1968; and has been awarded two honorary degrees by the Lincoln University in Pennsylvania, and the Chicago Theological Seminary.

Jesse Jackson has made numerous television appearances, and has been the subject of several newspaper and magazine articles and interviews. He is himself the author of magazine articles and has spoken, lectured, and held seminars throughout the United States. He is married to the former Jacquelin Lavinia Davis, and has three children, Santita, Jesse Louis, Jr., and Jonathan Luther.

### DOCTOR OF LITERATURE

CHARLES H. WESLEY

Charles H. Wesley, educator, author, historian, college president and executive director, earned his Bachelor of Arts degree at Fisk University. He then studied for the Master of Arts degree at Yale, and graduated with the degree of Doctor of Philosophy from Harvard University.

After further study as University Scholar at Yale, Austin Scholar at Harvard, and Fellow of the Guggenheim Foundation, London, England, Doctor Wesley joined the faculty of Howard University. He was successively Instructor of History and Modern Languages, Assistant Professor of History, Associate Professor and Head of the Department of History, Director of the Summer School, Dean of the College of Liberal Arts, and Dean of the Graduate School.

Doctor Wesley left Howard to become President of Wilberforce University, and later President of Central State College at Wilberforce, Ohio. He also served as Educational Secretary of the Army YMCA and with the International Committee of the YMCA, as overseas secretary.

Since 1950 he has been President of the Association for the Study of Negro Life and History, becoming executive director in 1965. He is a member of the American Historical Association, the Society for the Advancement of Education, and the American

Association of School Administrators. Charles Wesley is also a Fellow of the American Geographical Society; a member of the Advisory Committee, Ohio Congress of Parents and Teachers; Past President of the Inter-University Council of the State of Ohio; Past President, Association of the Ohio College Presidents and Dean; and Vice President and President of the Ohio College Association.

His educational achievements have won Dr. Wesley numerous awards, including honorary degrees from ten universities, and he has also been elected to Phi Beta Kappa Honor Society.

He is the author of: Negro Labor in the United States; The History of Alpha Phi Alpha; A Development in College Life; Richard Allen: Apostle of Freedom; The Collapse of the Confederacy; The Negro in the Americas; A Manuel of Research and Thesis Writing for Graduate Students; The History of Sigma Pi Phi, First of the Greek Letter Fraternities for Negro Americans; A History of the Improved Benevolent Protective Order of Elks of the World; and co-author with Carter G. Woodson of Negro Makers of History; The Story of the Negro Retold; The Negro in Our History; Neglected History; In Freedom's Footsteps; and The Quest for Equality. He was also editor-in-chief of International Library of Negro Life and History, ten volumes.
