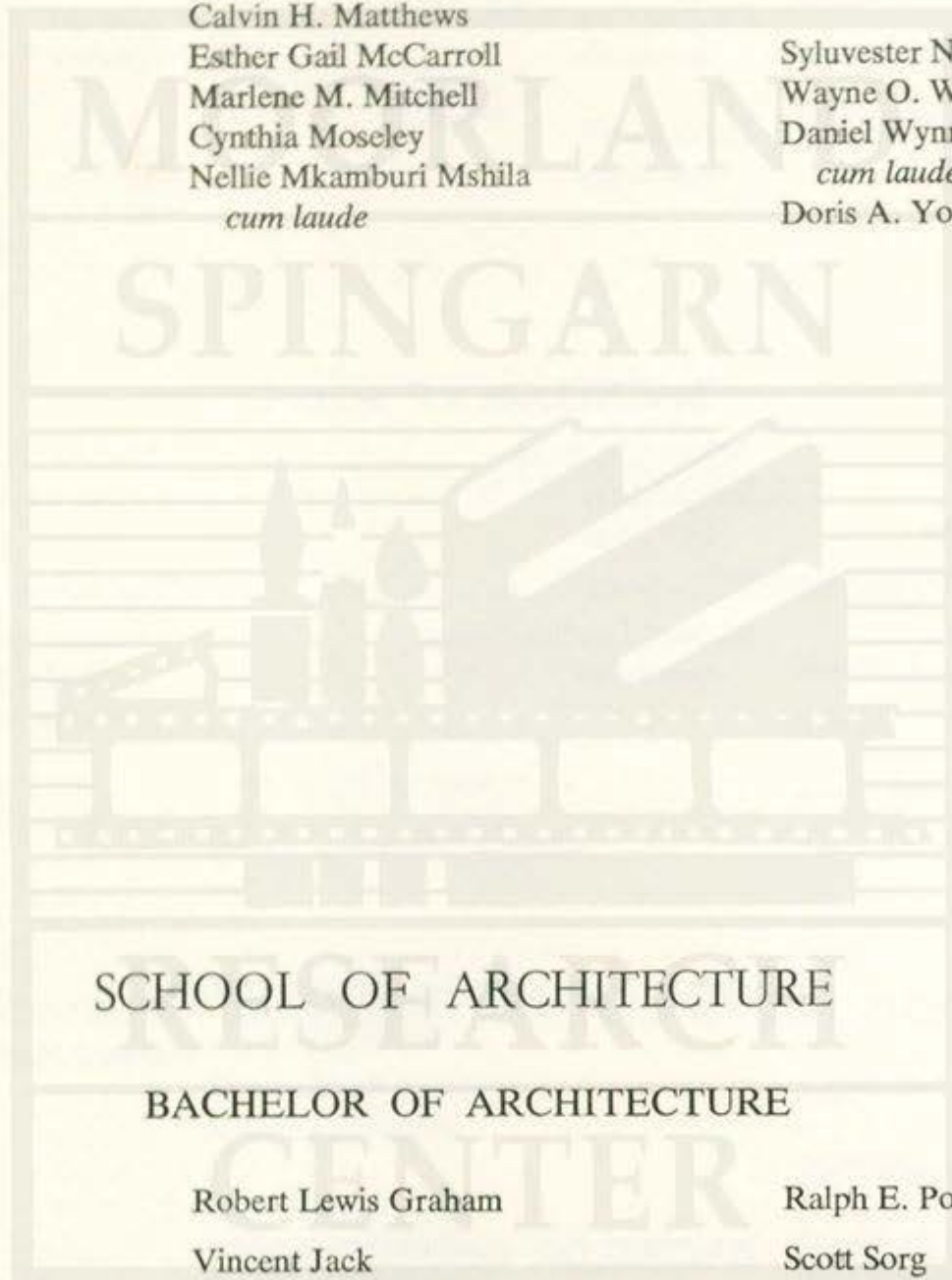

Honorary Degrees

DOCTOR OF MUSIC

EDWARD KENNEDY ELLINGTON

Edward Kennedy Ellington, universally known as "Duke," was born in Washington, D. C. in 1899. Since the age of eighteen, he has been totally committed to the world of music. Early in his career, he attracted the attention of music critics and publishers while appearing with his band at the Kentucky Club in New York between 1923 and 1927. Subsequently, he appeared in programs broadcast over the Columbia Broadcasting System, and made stage appearances at leading theatres. He has consistently composed hit musical scores for stage, screen, recordings, and personal appearances.

Mr. Ellington became the first living composer to have been so honored when the independent African nation of Togo issued a postage stamp in his honor, one of a series of stamps issued by that nation commemorating the world's greatest composers. He is also among the first songwriters to be elected to the Songwriters Hall of Fame. Earlier this year,

Mr. Ellington was inducted into the Swedish Royal Academy of Music, marking the first time a musician from the field of popular music has been selected to this 200-year-old institution.

A frequent guest at the White House through several administrations, Mr. Ellington's best known invitation was as guest of honor at a gala birthday party given him in 1969 by President and Mrs. Nixon. It was on this occasion that the President presented him with the Presidential Medal of Freedom, the highest civilian award of this country.

Having presented his first Concert of Sacred Music at Grace Cathedral in San Francisco in 1965, Duke Ellington and his orchestra have performed hundreds of such concerts in the sanctuaries of nearly every denomination around the world.

DOCTOR OF LITERATURE

STERLING A. BROWN

Sterling A. Brown was born in 1901 in Washington, D. C., where he received his primary and secondary education. He earned the bachelor of arts degree from Williams College in 1922, and a year later, the master of arts degree from Harvard University, to which he returned for further graduate study in English from 1931-32.

In 1969, Mr. Brown retired from Howard University after serving on the faculty of the English Department for forty years. Before coming to Howard, Mr. Brown had taught at Virginia Seminary and College, at Lincoln University in Missouri, and at Fisk University. In addition he has served as a Visiting Professor at Atlanta University, New York University, Vassar College, and the University of Minnesota. He is widely acclaimed as an able and beloved teacher.

A prolific writer, Professor Brown has authored and co-authored more than twenty books, and numerous articles for nationally published magazines and journals. Beginning with *Southern Road*, a book of poems written in 1932, he has become renowned for his works in literature. During a recent visit to this campus as a guest of the Department of Afro-American Studies, Professor Brown read a selection of poems from his works. Over the years, he has also lectured and given readings at numerous institutions across the country. He has made several recordings of his work, including *Anthology of Negro Poets* and *A Hand's on the Gate*.

Professor Brown married the former Daisy Turnbull in 1927. They have an adopted son, John L. Dennis.

DOCTOR OF LAWS

JULIAN BOND

Julian Bond, born in Nashville, Tennessee in 1940, graduated from the George School, a coeducational Quaker preparatory school in Bucks County, Pennsylvania, in 1957, and entered Morehouse College that same year.

While at Morehouse, Mr. Bond helped to found the Student Non-violent Coordinating Committee (SNCC) and was also a founder of the Committee on Appeal for Human Rights, a student organization that coordinated three years of anti-segregation protests in Atlanta. He left Morehouse in 1961 to join the SNCC staff. His work with that organization involved him in civil rights drives and voter registration campaigns throughout Georgia, Alabama, Mississippi, and Arkansas.

In January of 1967, Mr. Bond became a member of the Georgia House of Representatives after being barred arbitrarily from membership in two previous elections. He serves as a member of the Education, Insurance, and State Institutions and Properties Committees.

Formerly a Research Associate of the Voter Education

Project of the Metropolitan Applied Research Center of New York City, Mr. Bond is a Visiting Fellow of the Center, and is an Honorary Trustee of the Institute of Applied Politics.

As co-chairman of the Georgia Loyal National Democratic Delegation, an insurgent group, Mr. Bond led the successful attempt to unseat the regular, hand-picked Georgia Delegation at the 1968 Democratic National Convention. When later nominated for Vice President of the United States, he withdrew his name from consideration because of his youth.

The youthful Representative is a member of the respective boards of directors of a number of national and regional organizations, including the Southern Regional Council, the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People Legal Defense and Education Fund, and the Robert Kennedy Memorial Fund. He has produced several books and has written numerous poems and articles which have appeared in "Negro Digest," "Life," and other publications.

Mr. and Mrs. Bond live in Atlanta, Georgia with their five children.
