For the Degree of Doctor of Literature

MISS GWENDOLYN BROOKS

The Candidate Will be Presented by Mr. John E. Jacob
Member, Board of Trustees

The work of Gwendolyn Brooks depicts her concern for the liberation of Black people and her role as one of the most influential figures in the Black Renaissance. She is an outstanding and nationally-acclaimed poet whose work has motivated and inspired a generation of young Black writers.

In 1950, she became the first Black writer to win the Pulitzer Prize, the nation's highest literary award, for her work *Annie Allen*.

Her outstanding creativity and literary contributions have won

many honors, including her selection by the State of Illinois as Poet Laureate.

Besides *Annie Allen*, her poetry collections include: *A Street in Bronzeville*, *The Bean Eaters*, and *In the Mecca*. She also has written *Maud Martha*, a novel, and *Report from Part One*, an autobiography.

Born in Topeka, Kansas, she was reared in Chicago and graduated from Wilson Junior College.

MR. ALEX HALEY

One of the country's foremost authors, Alex Haley wrote *The Autobiography of Malcolm X*, one of the ten best books written in America in the 1960's.

Five years of painstaking genealogical research have resulted in *Roots*, a book which traces Mr. Haley's maternal ancestry to a village in Gambia, West Africa, from where his seventh generation forefather was transported to Colonial America as a slave in 1767. The book is to be published this fall. Movie rights to the book

have been acquired by Columbia Pictures which plans to produce a four-hour epic from it.

As a journalist, Mr. Haley has published in the Nation's most prestigious magazines, among them, *Harpers*, *The Atlantic Monthly*, *The New York Times Magazine*, and *Playboy*.

Born in New York and reared in Tennessee, Mr. Haley finished high school at the age of 15, attended college for two years before a 20-year career in the United States Coast Guard. He retired from the Coast Guard in 1959 to continue his writing career.

Mrs. Jewel Stradford Lafontant, Deputy Solicitor General of the United States, is a former United States Representative to the United Nations. Her impressive achievements as a lawyer, public servant, and crusader for human rights have won her numerous high awards from institutions, and civic and professional organizations.

As a practicing attorney in Chicago, Mrs. Lafontant has combined law with politics to destroy numerous barriers to social and civic progress. She has held key positions in the National Bar As-

sociation, the American Bar Association, the Chicago Branch of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, the American Civil Liberties Union, the Illinois State Advisory Committee to the United States Commission on Civil Rights, and the Advisory Board of the Illinois Fair Employment Practices Commission.

Born in Chicago, Illinois, she received the Bachelor of Arts degree from Oberlin College and the Doctor of Law degree from the University of Chicago.

MR. OSSIE DAVIS

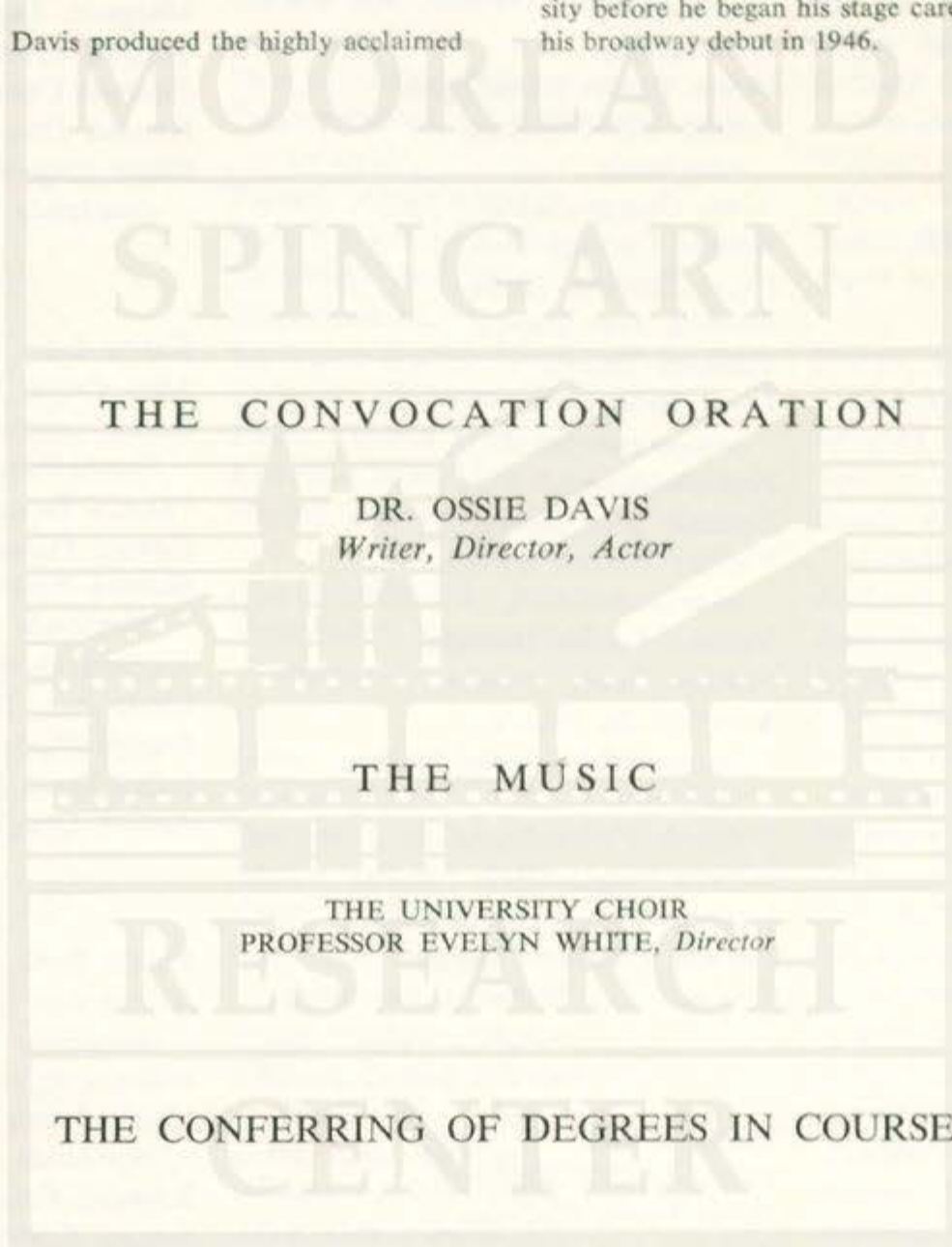
The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. Asa T. Spaulding
