THE HONORABLE WALTER EDWARD WASHINGTON

The Candidate Will be Presented by The Honorable Scovel Richardson
Member, Board of Trustees

Walter Edward Washington, veteran public servant, housing expert, public administrator, civic leader, has served as Mayor-Commissioner of the city of Washington, D. C. under President Lyndon B. Johnson and President Richard M. Nixon.

A career public housing official, Mayor Washington has served as both the Executive Director of the National Capital Housing Authority and as Chairman of the Public Housing Authority of the City of New York.

Mayor Washington is nationally recognized as an innovative public administrator. In 1967, his outstanding leadership talents were recognized by President Johnson who brought him back to Washington from New York and nominated him as first Mayor-

Commissioner of the District of Columbia. President Nixon confirmed this view of Mayor Washington by appointing him to a second term under his administration.

His achievements have been recognized with numerous awards and university honors including the Career Service Award of the National Civil Service League and the Distinguished Alumni Achievement Award of his alma mater, Howard University. He received both the Bachelor of Arts and the LL.B. degrees from Howard in 1938 and 1948, respectively. Mayor Washington has also received honorary degrees from twelve institutions.

Born in Dawson, Georgia in 1915, Mayor and Mrs. Washington are the parents of one daughter.

THE HONORABLE BARBARA JORDAN

The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. Asa T. Spaulding
Chairman, Board of Trustees

Harper's Bazaar Magazine's listing of Barbara Jordan as one of the "100 Women in Touch With Our Time," reflects the widespread admiration and respect that Miss Jordan commands for her political astuteness and awareness.

Upon her election to the Texas Senate in 1966, Miss Jordan became the first Black since 1883 to serve on that legislative body. When the Texas Legislature convened for a Called Session on March 28, 1973, she was unanimously elected President Pro Tempore and on June 10, 1972, when that state celebrated its traditional Governor for a Day, Miss Jordan became the first Black woman governor in the history of the United States.

She served in the Texas Senate until 1972 when she was elected to the United States House of Representatives from Houston's 18th

District.

Representative Jordan is a member of the Executive Committee of the National Democratic Policy Council, a member of the Board of Directors of the National Urban League, and a member of several professional and civic organizations.

She was selected by United Press International as one of the top ten most influential women in the state of Texas and received an Honorary Doctor of Laws Degree from Boston University.

Born in Houston in 1936, Representative Jordan graduated from the Houston Public Schools in the upper 5% of her class and obtained a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science-History from Texas Southern University, Magna Cum Laude. She graduated from the Boston University School of Law in 1959.

Katharine Meyer Graham joined the editorial staff of *The Washington Post* in April, 1939. She continued on the *Post* until 1945, working in the Sunday, Circulation and Editorial Departments.

Today, Mrs. Graham is Publisher of *The Washington Post*, Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer and President of The Washington Post Company, which owns *Newsweek Magazine* and Post-Newsweek Stations, Incorporated.

Mrs. Graham is a Trustee of the Committee for Economic Development, the Urban Institute, George Washington University, The Federal City Council, and The University of Chicago. She

is also a member of the Advisory Committee to the John F. Kennedy School of Government for the Institute of Politics at Harvard and a member of the Board of the Newspaper Advertising Bureau, Inc., the National Center for Resource Recovery, Inc., Allied Chemical Corporation, and the American Newspaper Publishers Association. She is Director and Member of the Executive Committee of the Inter-American Press Association.

Born in New York City in 1917, Mrs. Graham attended Vassar College from 1935-36 and graduated from the University of Chicago in 1938. She is the mother of one daughter and three sons.

THE HONORABLE DAMON JEROME KEITH

The Candidate Will be Presented by Mr. Edward P. Morgan
Member, Board of Trustees

A graduate of the Howard University School of Law in 1949, Damon Jerome Keith perceived his role in his early career as that of protecting the rights of citizens under the Constitution.

As his career progressed, his energies were channeled not only to the equal protection of laws but more significantly to changing and making new laws.

On September 22, 1967, he was nominated for United States District Court Judge by President Lyndon B. Johnson and was confirmed by the Senate on October 12, 1967. On October 27, 1967, he was sworn in as Judge of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan.

Since his appointment, Judge Keith has rendered two decisions that have brought him national attention and acclaim, his ruling to desegregate the Pontiac School System and his ruling that the attorney general does not have a right to tap wires in domestic cases without a court warrant. Both rulings were unanimously upheld by the United States Supreme Court.

Born in Detroit, Michigan, Judge Keith was recently honored by the naming of "The Damon J. Keith Elementary School" in that city. He is also the recipient of the 1974 "Distinguished Citizens Award" by Michigan State University. He and Mrs. Keith are the parents of three daughters.

DR. BENJAMIN ARTHUR QUARLES

The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. Geraldine P. Woods
Member, Board of Trustees

Benjamin Arthur Quarles, Professor of History at Morgan State College in Baltimore, Maryland, is one of the country's most outstanding scholars in Afro-American history.

Dr. Quarles has authored several books on Black History including *Frederick Douglass* (1948); *The Negro in the Civil War* (1953); *The Negro in the American Revolution* (1961); *Lincoln and the Negro* (1962); *The Negro in the Making of America* (1964); *Black Abolitionists* (1969); *Allies for Freedom*; *Blacks and John Brown* (1974). He has also co-authored several books, and written numerous articles, short pieces, chapters and introductions to books.

He is currently vice-president of the Association for the Study of Afro-American Life and History, and holds memberships on the Board of Editorial Advisors of the Booker T. Washington Papers,

the Editorial Board of the *Journal of Negro History*, the Committee on Publications of the Maryland Historical Society, and the Advisory Board of the Frederick Douglass Institute of Negro Arts and History. He is also an Honorary Fellow of the Atlanta University Center for African and Afro-American Studies, and a member of the Editorial Board of the Frederick Douglass Papers Project, the Advisory Committee of American Historians of Maryland Bicentennial Commission, and the Board of Directors of the Howard University Press.

Dr. Quarles received the Bachelor of Arts degree from Shaw University (Raleigh, North Carolina) and the Master of Arts and the Ph.D. degree from the University of Wisconsin. He has received Honorary Doctorates from Shaw University, Towson State College, Kenyon College, and the University of Maryland.

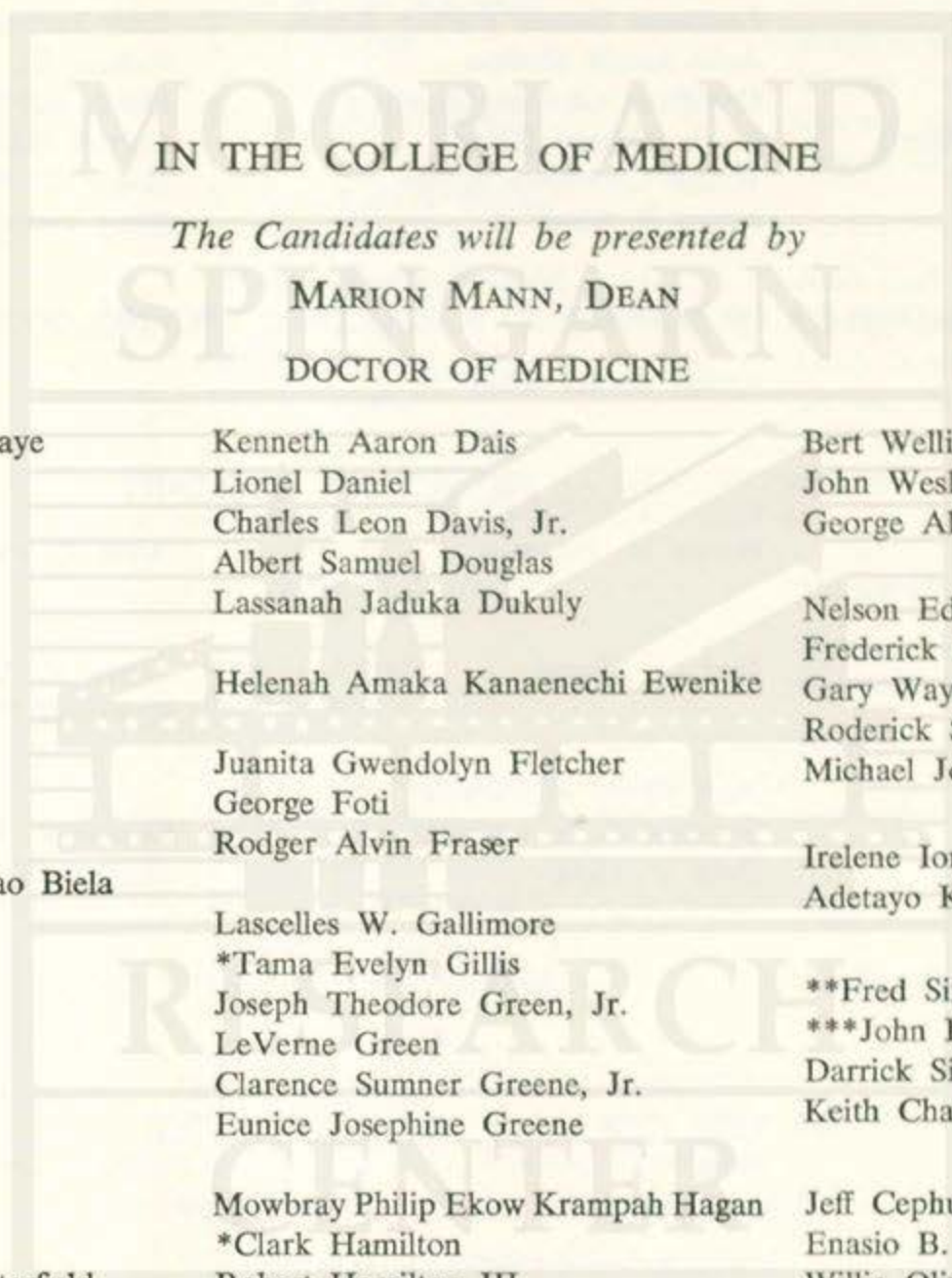
