For the Degree of Doctor of Humane Letters Dr. Louise Maxienne Dargans Fleming

The Candidate Will be Presented by The Honorable Scovel Richardson Member, Board of Trustees

Louise Maxienne Dargans Fleming is Director of Research, Committee on Education and Labor, U. S. House of Representatives. Born in Daytona Beach, Florida, she moved to New York City at the age of seven. She attended Hunter College in New York City where her major was mathematics and her minor was physics.

Her career in public service began with the New York State Department of Labor followed by employment with the Selective Service System in New York, the Office of Price Administration, the Internal Revenue Service, and in 1946 she joined the staff of Congressman Adam Clayton Powell, becoming in turn his secretary, legislative aide, and administrative assistant. In 1961,

when the Congressman became Chairman of the Committee on Education and Labor, he called upon her to serve as Chief Clerk of the Committee. For more than six years she served in this capacity, one of two Blacks to head a Congressional Committee Staff.

Dr. Dargans is a member of numerous organizations, and has received citations from the National Council of Negro Women, Delta Sigma Theta National Sorority, the Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, the National Association of Colored Women, as well as honorary degrees from Allen University, Columbia, South Carolina, and Saints College at Lexington, Mississippi.

For the Degree of Doctor of Divinity THE REVEREND KELLY MILLER SMITH

The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. Howard Stone Anderson Member, Board of Trustees

Kelly Miller Smith was born in Mound Bayou, Mississippi, received the Bachelor of Arts degree from Morehouse College in 1942, the Bachelor of Divinity degree from Howard University School of Religion in 1945, and has done further graduate study at Vanderbilt University, Nashville, Tennessee and Harvard University (Merrill Fellow), Cambridge, Massachusetts.

Reverend Smith presently holds dual positions as Pastor of the First Baptist Church, Capitol Hill, Nashville, Tennessee and Assistant Dean, Vanderbilt University Divinity School, the first Black instructor and administrator at this school. He has served as President of the Nashville Branch of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, the Nashville Ministers'

Association, the Nashville Christian Leadership Council, the Tennessee Baptist Leadership Education Council, and the Opportunities Industrialization Center, Nashville affiliate, in addition to serving numerous other organizations as chairman or member of the board.

Among the many honors and awards received by Reverend Smith are: Ebony Magazine's designation as "One of America's Ten Most Outstanding Preachers"; "Clergyman of the Year" awarded by Religious Heritage of America; and citations from Howard University, the National Council of Negro Women, the Nashville NAACP, the Tennessee State Alumni Association, and the Federation of Colored Women's Clubs (Nashville).

For the Degree of Doctor of Laws

DR. ASA T. SPAULDING

The Candidate Will be Presented by Mr. John E. Jacob Member, Board of Trustees

Asa T. Spaulding was born in Columbus County, North Carolina. He received the Bachelor of Science degree (Magna Cum Laude) from New York University in accounting in 1930, and the Master of Arts degree from the University of Michigan in mathematics and actuarial science in 1932; and, he holds honorary degrees from Shaw University, North Carolina Central University, Morgan State University, the University of North Carolina, Duke University, and Saint Andrews Presbyterian College.

Former President of the North Carolina Mutual Life Insurance Company and nationally famed business executive and administrator, Dr. Spaulding has served as consultant and resource specialist to numerous corporate and financial institutions across the country. Among his many appointments are: Vice-President of the Equal Opportunity Services Division, Boyden International Group, Incorporated; Consultant to the Ford Foundation and to the General Electric Company; member of the President's Commission on Income Maintenance Programs; and member of the National Committee of the Boy Scouts of America. In addition, he has served as a member of the United States Delegation to the UNESCO Conference in New Delhi; as a member of the American Delegation to the Inaugural Ceremonies of President Tubman in Liberia; and as a member of the People-to-People Goodwill Delegation to Russia, Poland, Bulgaria, Hungary, Yugoslavia, and Czechoslovakia. While serving in these capacities as well as many others, Dr .Spaulding served Howard University as Chairman of the Board of Trustees from 1971 to 1975.

For the Degree of Doctor of Laws

DR. HERMAN B WELLS

The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. William K. Collins Member, Board of Trustees

Herman B Wells was born in Jamestown, Indiana. He received the Bachelor of Science and Master of Arts degrees from the University of Indiana, the institution he was later to serve as President and Chancellor.

Dr. Wells retired as President of Indiana University in 1962. He was then made Chancellor and elected President of the Indiana University Foundation, an independent non-profit corporation to receive and administer gifts, grants, and bequests for the benefit of the University. He served as President of the Foundation until July 1, 1969, when he became Chairman of the Board.

Dr. Wells has served in numerous capacities in the international field. These include Special Advisor to the United States Department of State; Consultant for the American Council on Education; member with rank of Minister in 1946 of the Allied Missions for Observation of the Greek Election; advisor on cultural and

educational affairs to the American military government of the United States occupied zone in Germany in 1947-48; and, American delegate, upon appointment by President Eisenhower, to the 1957 General Assembly of the United Nations.

As a leader in American education, Dr. Wells has served as member and Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching; Vice President and member of the Governing Board of the International Association of Universities; first President of the National Education Association's Department of Higher Education; President of both the National Association of State Universities and the State Universities Association; and Vice Chairman of the National Commission on Humanities. He has received honorary degrees from twenty-two Amercian colleges and universities.

For the Degree of Doctor of Laws

THE HONORABLE MAYNARD H. JACKSON

The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. Geraldine P. Woods Chairman, Board of Trustees

Maynard Holbrook Jackson, Jr. was born in Dallas, Texas, and reared in Georgia. He attended the David T. Harvard High School in Atlanta and was graduated at the age of fourteen. As a Ford Foundation Early Admission Scholar, he was accepted at Morehouse College. Keeping up his outstanding scholastic achievements, he graduated at eighteen with a bachelor's degree in political science in 1956. He went on to earn his law degree (cum laude) in 1964 from North Carolina Central University in Durham. On October 16, 1973, he was elected Mayor of Atlanta, at 35, becoming not only the city's first Black Mayor, but also the youngest person ever to hold the city's highest executive office and the youngest Mayor of a major American city.

Beginning his political career in 1968, Mayor Jackson left a

position as Attorney for the Emory Community Legal Services Center to declare his candidacy for the United States Senate. Running a hard campaign against incumbent Senator Herman Talmadge, he was defeated in this first race, but he carried the city of Atlanta with a 6,000 vote margin.

In 1969, he entered the race for Vice Mayor of Atlanta, winning handily by out-polling every other candidate in the city-wide election.

Mayor Jackson is a member of numerous organizations, including the National Bar Association, the Atlanta Bar Association, the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, the Atlanta Urban League, and the National Black Caucus of Local Elected Officials.

THE ACADEMIC COSTUME

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students used them to keep warm in medieval castles and halls of learning. From these practical origins, they have developed into the accepted garb which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves, pointed at the fingertips. These gowns may be worn either open or closed.

The master's degree gown is worn open, and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow.

Gowns for the doctor's degree are also worn open. They carry broad, velvet panels down the front, and three velvet bars on the full, round sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the degree.

Mortar boards or caps worn with baccalaureate and master's gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

Faculty members and guests in today's procession are robed in gowns and hoods which represent the institutions from which they have received degrees.

The hood gives color and real meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the colors of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of a prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains as follows: medicine, green; music, pink; nursing, apricot; pharmacy, olive green; public administration, peacock blue; science, golden yellow; social work, citron; theology, scarlet; architecture, brown; arts, letters, and humanities, white; business, drab; dentistry, lilac; education, light blue; engineering, orange; fine arts, brown; law, purple.

THE MACE

THE MACE, carried by the University Marshal, Dr. Michael R. Winston, Director, Moorland-Spingarn Research Center, is the ceremonial symbol of the University. Its origin dates back to the Middle Ages. It is used on all occasions of academic ceremony at the University. At today's Commencement, the entry of the Mace heralds the arrival of the academic procession.

THE BATON

THE BATONS carried by the Marshals and Assistant Marshals of each school and college are being used to lead the academic procession of the respective schools and colleges into and out of the place of the ceremony. The batons are made of wood, painted blue, and tied with white ribbon denoting the colors of Howard University.

THE PRESIDENTIAL CHAIN OF OFFICE (The Medallion)

The Presidential Chain of Office, worn by President Cheek, was presented to the University on the occasion of the Centennial Celebration in 1967 by Trustee Herman B. Wells and his mother, Mrs. Granville Wells. The chain symbolizes the current and past holders of the Office of President. The basic material of the chain is sterling silver, plated with hard gold. Both the University Seal and the Centennial Seal are appended to the chain.
