For the Degree of Doctor of Laws

DR. MARY FRANCES BERRY

The Candidate Will be Presented by Mr. John E. Jacob
Vice Chairman, Board of Trustees

Mary Frances Berry, appointed Assistant Secretary for Education, Department of Health, Education, and Welfare in 1977, was formerly the Chancellor of the University of Colorado, Boulder, and, as such, was the first black woman ever named chief administrator of a major American university and only the second woman to be appointed to such a position.

She was born in Nashville, Tennessee on February 19, 1938 and completed her early education in the Nashville public school system, later attending Howard University in Washington, D. C. where she earned bachelor's and master's degrees.

Continuing her graduate education at the University of Michigan, she completed her Doctor of Philosophy in history there in 1966. An appointment to the faculty of the Central Michigan University as an Assistant Professor of History followed at the same time she was beginning Law School at the University of Michigan. Moving to Eastern Michigan University in 1968 she was later promoted to Associate Professor. In 1970 she joined the faculty of the University of Maryland, College Park as an Associate Professor and

was an Adjunct Associate Professor at the University of Michigan in 1970-71. The University of Michigan also awarded her a Juris Doctor degree in 1970.

In addition to her regular academic duties at the University of Maryland, Dr. Berry served in a series of government consulting positions in 1972-73 with the Office of Policy Planning at the Department of Housing and Urban Development and the Office of Civil Rights at the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare. She was then appointed Provost of Behavioral and Social Sciences of the University of Maryland, College Park in 1973 where she stayed until assuming the position of Chancellor of the University of Colorado, Boulder in 1976. At Colorado, she shared her responsibilities as Chancellor with those of her other two positions, Professor of History and Professor of Law.

Dr. Berry is well known for her scholarly output, having several publications to her credit. She remains active as a legal historical scholar. A member of numerous professional associations, she retains a special interest in the future of teaching and research.

MR. REGINALD HAROLD JONES

The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. Howard Stone Anderson

Reginald H. Jones, Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer of the General Electric Company is a graduate of the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania. He joined General Electric's Business Training Course in 1939. Starting in 1942, he served eight years as a traveling auditor, familiarizing himself with many phases of the Company's business.

In 1950, he was appointed assistant to the comptroller of the Apparatus Department in Schenectady, New York. After a series of assignments in the apparatus area, he was named general manager of the Air Conditioning Division, then located in Bloomfield, New Jersey in 1956.

Two years later, Mr. Jones was appointed general manager of the General Electric Supply Company Division. When the Construction Industries Division was formed January 1, 1964, he was made its general manager. He continued to head both divisions until he was named to head the Components and Construction Materials Group in 1967. He became group executive of the Con-

struction Industries Group when it was established January 1, 1968 and was named Vice President-Finance for the Company on May 1, 1968.

He was elected a Senior Vice President on June 1, 1970; made a member of the Board of Directors on August 1, 1971; Vice Chairman of the Board and member of the Corporate Executive Office on March 1, 1972; and was elected President of the Company on June 23, 1972 and Chairman and Chief Executive Officer later that year.

Mr. Jones was born in the United Kingdom on July 11, 1917 and came to this country as a boy. He is a member of the Executive Committee, Business Council, Co-Chairman of the Business Roundtable, and a member of the President's Export Council. He is also a Trustee of the University of Pennsylvania, Chairman, Board of Overseers of the Wharton School and is an active layman in the Congregational Church.

DR. STEPHEN J. WRIGHT

The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. Dorothy Fosdick
Member, Board of Trustees

Stephen J. Wright, Vice President, College Entrance Examination Board, is a native of Dillon, South Carolina. He received the Bachelor of Arts degree at Hampton Institute in 1934, a Master of Arts at Howard University in 1939, and the Doctor of Philosophy degree at New York University in 1943.

Dr. Wright's first teaching assignment was at Kennard High School, Centerville, Maryland, where he remained until 1936. He then served as principal of Douglas High School at Upper Marlboro, Maryland until 1938.

Joining the faculty of North Carolina College at Durham in September, 1939, Dr. Wright served as Assistant Professor of Education and Director of Student Teaching until 1941 when he was granted a two-year leave of absence to study for a third degree.

Dr. Wright returned to North Carolina College as Professor of Education and Acting Dean of Men. In 1944 he returned to

Hampton, where he held the position of Professor of Education, Director of the Division of Education, and Dean of the Faculty until 1953 when he was appointed President of Bluefield State Teachers College.

In 1957, Dr. Wright was named President of Fisk University at Nashville, Tennessee where he remained until 1966 when he was named President of the United Negro College Fund. In 1969, he became a Consultant to the President, College Entrance Examination Board and the following year he assumed his present position of Vice President, College Entrance Examination Board.

Dr. Wright holds membership in numerous professional and civic organizations. He has an impressive list of contributions to scholarly publications and he has been accorded many awards and honors commensurate with his achievements.

For the Degree of Doctor of Science

DR. M. WHARTON YOUNG

The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. Jesse B. Barber, Jr.

Member, Board of Trustees

M. Wharton Young was born in South Carolina. Due to inadequate educational facilities for blacks, he found it necessary to travel to a private church school to acquire a high school diploma from Claflin College in 1922. He entered Howard University for his premedical and college training and graduated from the College of Liberal Arts in 1926, and the College of Medicine in 1930. In 1932, he received a General Education Board Fellowship for Graduate Study at the University of Michigan, receiving there the Doctor of Philosophy degree in Neuroanatomy.

Following graduation from medical school, where he maintained the highest scholastic average in his class during the entire four years and received among others the M. O. Dumas Scholarship Award for such distinction, he served a rotating internship at Freedmen's Hospital from 1930 to 1931, and a residency at Peoples Hospital in St. Louis where he engaged in General Practice. While practicing medicine in St. Louis, he successfully completed the National Board Examination to become a Diplomat of the National

Board of Medical Examiners.

Dr. Young joined the faculty of the Howard University College of Medicine in 1934 where he remained until retirement in 1970. He established a reputation during those almost 40 years as an outstanding teacher and taught every course in the department of Anatomy to all the various student groups, medical students, nurses, graduate and others.

In addition to Howard, he has held positions at the College of Medical School, Meharry Medical College, Chiba Medical College (Japan), Trivandrum Medical College (India) and the Medical College of the University of Maryland, where he presently teaches. His original research publications extend from 1936 to 1970 and include approximately 100 titles from brain research and basic research to technical procedures, deafness and concussion bombs. His professional travel and participation in meetings have taken him to the Soviet Union twice since 1970, to four continents, and twice around the world.

HIS EXCELLENCY ARDESHIR ZAHEDI

Ambassador of Iran

Ardeshir Zahedi was born in Tehran, Iran. He attended the American College of Beirut and received his bachelor's degree from Utah State University in 1950.

In 1953 he participated in the revolution led by his father, General Fazlollah Zahedi, which brought to Iran a "brave new world." Since that year he has held many of the highest and most influential offices of his government, among them: Special Adviser to the Prime Minister, Chamberlain to His Imperial Majesty the Shahanshah Aryamehr of Iran, Head of the Iranian Students' Program, and Foreign Minister of Iran.

In the diplomatic field he has held numerous posts of high distinction. From 1959 to 1961, he was Ambassador of Iran to the

United States; from 1962 to 1966, he was Iran's Ambassador to Great Britain; and in 1963, he represented his nation at the signing of the treaty banning nuclear tests. From 1973 until the present he has been, for the second time, Iran's Ambassador to the United States.

His decorations and awards are far too numerous to list. Twenty-three nations and the Vatican, representing four continents (Africa, Asia, Europe, and South America), have given him the most significant orders and awards. He has been honored by 15 universities, four of them American. In 1976 the Kappa Alpha Fraternity named him Man of the Year.

THE HONORABLE WADE H. MCCREE, JR.

Wade H. McCree, Jr. was born in Des Moines, Iowa. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree from Fisk University in 1941, and his Bachelor of Laws degree from Harvard University in 1944.

On March 28, 1977, he became the Solicitor General of the United States, following eleven years service as Judge of the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit, and five previous years as United States District Judge for the Eastern District of Michigan. His previous public offices include service as Circuit Judge of the Third Judicial Circuit of Michigan (Wayne County) from 1954 to 1961, and as a Michigan Workmen's Compensation Commissioner from 1952 to 1954.

Solicitor General McCree serves on many charitable and civic boards, and has an active interest in education, serving as Trustee and Vice Chairman of the Board of Fisk University, an Overseer of Harvard College, and Member of the Board of Saginaw Valley

College in Michigan. He was a founding Trustee of The Fisk School in Detroit, and has served on the Visiting Committees of Case Western Reserve Law School, the University of Chicago Law School, and Wayne State University, where he has been a part-time faculty member.

He has served as a Director of the American Judicature Society and was a founding Director of the Federal Judicial Center. He is a member of the Institute of Judicial Administration, a member of the Editorial Advisory Committee of the American Bar Association, a Fellow of the American Bar Foundation, a member of the American Bar Association Commission on the Standards of Judicial Administration, Judicial Conference of the United States.

He is the recipient of nine honorary degrees and a member of Phi Beta Kappa, The Phi Beta Kappa Associates and the Order of The Coif (Honorary, Vanderbilt Law School).

THE ACADEMIC COSTUME

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students used them to keep warm in medieval castles and halls of learning. From these practical origins, they have developed into the accepted garb which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves, pointed at the fingertips. These gowns may be worn either open or closed.

The master's degree gown is worn open, and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow.

Gowns for the doctor's degree are also worn open. They carry broad, velvet panels down the front, and three velvet bars on the full, round sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the degree.

Mortar boards or caps worn with baccalaureate and master's gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

Faculty members and guests in today's procession are robed in gowns and hoods which represent the institutions from which they have received degrees.

The hood gives color and real meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the colors of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of a prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains as follows: medicine, green; music, pink; nursing, apricot; pharmacy, olive green; public administration, peacock blue; science, golden yellow; social work, citron; theology, scarlet; architecture, brown; arts, letters, and humanities, white; business, drab; dentistry, lilac; education, light blue; engineering, orange; fine arts, brown; law, purple.

THE MACE

THE MACE, carried by the University Marshal, Dr. Thomas F. Johnson, Associate Dean of Student Affairs, The Graduate School of Arts and Sciences, is the ceremonial symbol of the University. Its origin dates back to the Middle Ages. It is used on all occasions of academic ceremony at the University. At today's Commencement, the entry of the Mace heralds the arrival of the academic procession.

THE BATON

THE BATONS carried by the Marshals and Assistant Marshals of each school and college are being used to lead the academic procession of the respective schools and colleges into and out of the place of the ceremony. The batons are made of wood, painted blue, and tied with white ribbon denoting the colors of Howard University.

THE PRESIDENTIAL CHAIN OF OFFICE (The Medallion)

The Presidential Chain of Office, worn by President Cheek, was presented to the University on the occasion of the Centennial Celebration in 1967 by Trustee Herman B. Wells and his mother, Mrs. Granville Wells. The chain symbolizes the current and past holders of the Office of President. The basic material of the chain is sterling silver, plated with hard gold. Both the University Seal and the Centennial Seal are appended to the chain.
