

For the Degree of Doctor of Music

EUBIE BLAKE

The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. William K. Collins Member, Board of Trustees

Eubie Blake was born James Hubert Blake in Baltimore, Maryland on February 7, 1883. He displayed exceptional musical talent at the age of six, and for the next six years took piano lessons and studied classical music. At twelve, he heard ragtime and quickly learned it by ear. In 1899, at sixteen, he composed his first piece of music, Sounds of Africa, which was published in 1919 and released as the Charleston Rag. In October 1914, Chevy Chase became his first published piano composition. It was stage music without lyrics and indicated the direction in which he was moving—musical comedy.

His show business debut was made on July 4, 1901 in Fair-field, Pennsylvania. In 1915, he met vocalist Noble Sissle and the two performers joined forces to write music and lyrics for their own vaudeville acts.

Shuffle Along, with lyrics by Sissle, and music by Blake, opened on May 23, 1921. It was the first black show produced in more than a decade and set the pattern for future Broadway musicals. One of the surprise song hits of Shuffle Along was I'm Just Wild About Harry, which President Harry S. Truman adopted as his campaign song in 1948.

Following a highly successful road tour with Shuffle Along, Blake and Sissle collaborated on a new show originally called In Bamville, later changed to The Chocolate Dandies. Following a run of six months, this revue closed on May 15, 1925 and the

vaudevillians Sissle and Blake, having revived their act in theatres showing full-length silent movies, were offered a European tour. They spent eight months playing in England, Scotland, and France. On Mr. Blake's return to the United States, he resumed performing in vaudeville and hotels and made several Warner Brothers musical shorts, among them Pie, Pie Blackbirds. He also conducted the Broadway musical Singin' the Blues in 1931. In 1946, at the beginning of a long period of semiretirement, he enrolled at New York University to study the difficult Schillinger system of composition, a four-year course that he completed in two-and-a-half years, graduating at the age of sixty-six.

When interest in ragtime revived in the 1960's, Eubie Blake was again in demand. Columbia Records brought out in 1969 a two-record album, The Eighty-Six Years of Eubie Blake, with Blake himself playing thirty rags, marches and blues, most of which he had composed. He also began teaching music at Yale and other universities, and appearing as a frequent guest on television. In December 1972, two months before reaching the age of ninety, Mr. Blake gave a one hour and forty-five minute concert in New York. The musical play Eubie is a tribute to the man and to his compositions.

Among his honors are membership in the Songwriters Hall of Fame, several honorary degrees, the Ellington Medal awarded by Yale, and the keys to the City of Baltimore.

INABEL BURNS LINDSAY

The Candidate Will be Presented by Mr. John E. Jacob Vice Chairman, Board of Trustees

Inabel Burns Lindsay, Dean Emeritus of the School of Social Work at Howard University, was appointed Dean from the school's inception in 1945. Born in St. Joseph, Missouri, she received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Howard University, a Master of Arts degree from the University of Chicago, and the Doctor of Social Work from the University of Pittsburgh.

Although she retired in 1967, she has never been faced with the problem of idleness or stagnation. Dr. Lindsay has remained actively involved in current issues in social work and has made numerous contributions through writings, speeches, and participation in professional proceedings. In addition, she has served as Social Services Advisor, Assistant Secretary for Community and Field Services, Department of Health, Education, and Welfare from October 1967-April 1970; Lecturer, School of Social

Work, University of Maryland, 1968; Lecturer, School of Social Service, Catholic University, and as a Consultant for the National Urban League in 1969.

Dr. Lindsay's professional participation, with emphasis on aging, includes the National Council on Aging, National Advisory Committee for the White House Conference on Aging, and the President's Task Force on Aging. Her memberships include: Chairman, Committee on Social Welfare, National Urban League; Board of Directors, Edwin Gould Foundation and Edwin Gould Services to Children; Lois and Samuel Silberman Fund, Grant Committee; and Board of Directors and Vice President of the Travelers Aid Society of the District of Columbia, among others.

In June 1970, she was honored by the University of Pittsburgh School of Social Work with a Distinguished Alumni Award.

For the Degree of Doctor of Music

JESSYE NORMAN

The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. James F. Tucker Member, Board of Trustees

Jessye Norman was born in Augusta, Georgia, on September 15, 1945. She received a Bachelor of Music degree from Howard University in 1967, a postgraduate degree from the Peabody Conservatory in 1967, and was awarded a Master of Music degree from the University of Michigan in May 1980.

She won first prize at the Bavarian Radio Corporation International Music Competition in Munich, Germany. As a result, Miss Norman has been engaged by various impresarios for appearances throughout Germany, and later in other European countries.

In December 1969, she made her operatic debut in West Berlin, and signed a three-year contract joining the company of Egon Seefehlner, shortly thereafter. In September 1971, she performed at the Berlin Festivals. Miss Norman made her American operatic debut at the Hollywood Bowl in a concert performance of Aida, in the summer of 1972.

January 1973 brought Miss Norman the special honor of being invited to make her New York recital debut in the "Great Performers" series at Lincoln Center, with the Boston Symphony Orchestra. Later in January, she gave orchestral concerts in Madrid, followed by a recital tour of Germany.

April 1973 marked Miss Norman's debut in Paris with two concert performances of Aida. In October 1973, Miss Norman sang at the opening of the Los Angeles Philharmonic Orchestra's season before giving recitals at the Kennedy Center, Washington, D.C., in Houston and at Dartmouth College. In November, she gave her first London recital at Queen Elizabeth Hall. In 1974, Miss Norman's appearances included further orchestral concerts with Colin Davis and the Boston Symphony Orchestra in Boston, and at Carnegie Hall, New York City. In 1974, Miss Norman made her South American debut in Buenos Aires, with three recitals and an orchestral concert.

The Spring of 1975 saw a return to the "Great Performers" series at Lincoln Center, New York, and recitals and concerts in Buffalo; Philadelphia; Carnegie Hall; Montreal; Los Angeles and Berkeley. She also toured Mexico in June. Miss Norman's 1976/77 season included her first tour of Australia. In Europe her tours included Spain, England, Holland and orchestra concerts with Zubin Mehta in Paris.

Recent seasons have been heavily booked with many recording sessions, recitals, and orchestral performances with major orchestras, including the Los Angeles Philharmonic Orchestra, Boston Symphony, American Symphony, Chicago Symphony and others in every important city in Europe and North America.

For the Degree of Doctor of Laws ELLIOT LEE RICHARDSON

The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. Frankie M. Freeman Member, Board of Trustees

Elliot Lee Richardson is currently the senior resident partner in the Washington office of Milbank, Tweed, Hadley & McCloy, a New York law firm engaging in a diversified domestic and international practice, serving a large number of corporate, institutional and individual clients.

Before joining Milbank, Tweed on October 6, 1980, Mr. Richardson held an impressive number of high-level positions. Included in this list are: United States Attorney for Massachusetts—1959 to 1961; Lieutenant Governor of Massachusetts—January 1965 to January 1967; Attorney General of Massachusetts—January 1967 to January 1969; Under Secretary of State—January 1969 to June 1970; Secretary of Health, Education, and Welfare—June 1970 to January 1973; Secretary of Defense—January 1973 to May 1973; Attorney General of the United States—May 1973 to October 1973; Ambassador to the Court of St. Jame's—February 1975 to January 1976; Secretary of Commerce—February 1976 to January 1977; and Ambassador-at-Large and Special Representative of the President to the Law of the Sea Conference—February 1977 to October 1980.

Born in Boston, Massachusetts, on July 20, 1920, Mr. Richardson graduated cum laude from Harvard College in 1941, and

received his law degree cum laude from Harvard Law School in 1947, where he was President of the Law Review. Since then Mr. Richardson has received numerous honorary degrees and awards.

Enlisting in the U.S. Army in 1942 as a private, Mr. Richardson was a first lieutenant at the time of his honorable discharge in 1945. He was awarded the Bronze Star Medal for Heroic Service and the Purple Heart with Oak Leaf Cluster, and is entitled to wear the Combat Medical Badge and the European Theater Ribbon with Arrowhead and five battle stars.

Mr. Richardson has twice served as a member of the Board of Overseers of Harvard College. He was a Director of the Harvard Alumni Association from 1957 until 1960, and is a former trustee of Radcliffe College and the Massachusetts General Hospital.

Mr. Richardson is the author of *The Creative Balance-Govern*ment, Politics, and the Individual in America's Third Century, Holt, Rinehart and Winston, New York, 1976, and many articles on government, law and foreign policy.

For the Degree of Doctor of Laws (Posthumously)

THE HONORABLE SCOVEL RICHARDSON (Represented by Mrs. Inez Williston Richardson)

Mrs. Richardson Will be Presented by Dr. Lawrence B. Wilson Member, Board of Trustees

Judge Scovel Richardson, the third black Federal Judge to be appointed by a President of the United States, was born in Nashville, Tennessee on February 4, 1912. He died on March 30, 1982 in New Rochelle, New York.

A graduate of Wendell Phillips High School in Chicago, Judge Richardson received his bachelors and masters degrees from the University of Illinois. In 1937 he received his law degree from Howard University and was admitted to practice law before the Illinois Bar in 1938, the Missouri Bar in 1939, and the United States Supreme Court in 1943.

During World War II he was Senior Attorney in the Office of Price Administration (OPA) in Washington and became the Dean of the School of Law and Professor of Law at Lincoln University in 1948, serving to 1953.

President Dwight D. Eisenhower appointed Judge Richardson to the United States Board of Parole in the Justice Department in 1953 and he served as Chairman from 1956 to 1957. Judge

Richardson was appointed to the U.S. Customs Court and in 1966 became Presiding Judge of the Third Division of that Court, now called the United States Court of International Trade.

Judge Richardson served as Secretary and recently as First Vice President of the New Rochelle Hospital Medical Center Board of Governors, on which he had been a member since 1966. He also served on the Board of Trustees of Colgate and Howard Universities and as Chapter Officer of the Westchester Chapter of Sigma Pi Phi, Boule. He served for two years as Chairman of the Howard University Board of Trustees and Chairman of several of its key committees. In addition, Judge Richardson was Past President of the National Bar Association, founding member of the Westchester Black Lawyers Association, member of various committees of the American Bar Association, American Judicature and the Association of the Bar of the City of New York, among other professional organizations.

For the Degree of Doctor of Music SARAH LOIS VAUGHAN

The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. Charles D. Watts Member, Board of Trustees

Sarah Lois Vaughan was born on March 27, 1924 in Newark, New Jersey. She began singing in the church choir with her mother and took piano and organ lessons from the age of seven. Miss Vaughan's first introduction to show business was an amateur contest she entered and won at the Apollo Theater in Harlem at the age of sixteen. First prize was ten dollars and a week's engagement at the theater. From there her career continued to rise.

Miss Vaughan opened at the Apollo Theater on April 23, 1943, with the band of Earl "Fatha" Hines, on Billy Eckstine's recommendation. She spent a year touring with the Hines band. During that year she met and worked with Dizzy Gillespie and Charley Parker, both of whom had a strong influence on the development of her singing style.

When Billy Eckstine formed his own band in June 1944, Miss Vaughan was promptly hired. Her first recording I'll Wait and Pray, was made with the Eckstine band. The first of her records to receive national attention was Dedicated to You. Among her records from this early period to become popular classics are Don't Blame Me and I Cover the Waterfront. Her first million-seller was Broken-Hearted Melody, which made Billboard's Hot 100 chart on July 26, 1959, and remained there for nineteen weeks.

Miss Vaughan made her first European tour in 1953. When she returned home, she made guest appearances on the popular television shows of the 1950's. She also appeared in five short musical films that were made for television.

During the 1960's Miss Vaughan sang with Duke Ellington and his orchestra, toured internationally with Count Basic and his orchestra, recorded the sound track for the motion picture Cactus Flower, and had three songs on Billboard's top 100 chart.

In the course of the 1970's, Miss Vaughan appeared at the Avery Fisher Hall in Lincoln Center, and made guest appearances with the National Symphony and Los Angeles Philharmonic. She also toured South America; Japan; Africa; Australia; and England.

Numerous awards have been won by Miss Vaughan, among them Downbeat's award for best female singer for 18 consecutive years; Downbeat's international critics poll in 1973 and from 1975 through 1979; the Metronome magazine award from 1948 through 1953; the Jazz Journal International poll for best female singer in 1978; and winner of the Emmy in 1981 for the PBS television special Sarah Vaughan Sings George Gershwin.

For the Degree of Doctor of Humane Letters

EDWARD RUDOLPH BRADLEY

The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. Geraldine P. Woods Chairman, Board of Trustees

Edward Rudolph Bradley, CBS co-editor of the weekly newsmagazine, "60 Minutes," is a native of Pennsylvania. Mr. Bradley received a Bachelor of Science degree in education in 1964 from Cheyney State College in Cheyney, Pennsylvania.

Prior to joining CBS News, he was a reporter for WCBS Radio, the CBS-owned station in New York, from August 1967 to July 1971. He had previously been a reporter for WDAS Radio, in Philadelphia, from 1963 to 1967.

Mr. Bradley joined CBS News in September 1971 as a stringer in the Paris Bureau. In November 1972, he was transferred to the Saigon Bureau, where he remained until he was reassigned to the CBS News Washington Bureau in June 1974.

In March of 1975, he was among the CBS News Correspondents who volunteered to return to Indochina to cover what became the fall of Cambodia and Vietnam. Mr. Bradley's other assignments have included covering the Presidential campaign of Jimmy Carter during CAMPAIGN '76, and floor associate/relief correspondent for CBS News coverage of the Democratic and Republican National Conventions that year. He reported as CBS News White House Correspondent from November 1976 until September 1978, at which time he was named a Principal Correspondent for CBS Reports. In addition, he has been

anchorman of the "CBS Sunday Night News" on the CBS Television Network.

Mr. Bradley's first documentary assignment for CBS News was the CBS News Special, What's Happened to Cambodia, June 1978. He was then named Principal Correspondent for CBS Reports in September of the same year.

He returned to Southeast Asia in October 1979 and filed a series of reports on the tragedy of the starving and desperately ill Cambodian refugees, which earned him a George Polk Award in Journalism for foreign reporting in the television category. Another 1979 report included, Blacks in America: With All Deliberate Speed?, an examination of the quality of life for Blacks in the North and South.

His most recent CBS Reports broadcasts include Miami: The Trial That Sparked the Riots, (August 1980) and Return of the CIA (June 1980). In the past, Mr. Bradley has distinguished himself with a series of award-winning documentaries. The Boat People, a firsthand look at the plight of homeless Vietnamese refugees, (January 1979), earned an Emmy and a Columbia-duPont Award, as well as the Overseas Press Club Edward R. Murrow Award. The Boston Goes to China (April 1979), was honored with both an Emmy and a Peabody Award.

THE CONFERRING OF DEGREES IN COURSE

The order of presentation of schools and colleges for the conferring of degrees is based on two factors — the year of establishment of the school or college and the distinction between graduate and undergraduate programs. The first eleven schools and colleges, beginning with the College of Liberal Arts and ending with the College of Allied Health Sciences, were established over the years from 1868 to 1974. These eleven schools and colleges provide basically undergraduate programs. The next five schools and colleges, beginning with the School of Divinity and ending with the School of Social Work, were established between the years of 1868 and 1945. These schools and colleges offer professional graduate level programs. The last school listed, the Graduate School of Arts and Sciences, was established in 1934 and offers graduate level programs exclusively.

THE ACADEMIC COSTUME

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students used them to keep warm in medieval castles and halls of learning. From these practical origins, they have developed into the accepted garb which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves, pointed at the fingertips. These gowns may be worn either open or closed.

The master's degree gown is worn open, and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow.

Gowns for the doctor's degree are also worn open. They carry broad, velvet panels down the front, and three velvet bars on the full, round sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the degree.

Mortar boards or caps worn with baccalaureate and master's gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

Faculty members and guests in today's procession are robed in gowns and hoods which represent the institutions from which they have received degrees.

The hood gives color and real meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the colors of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of a prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains as follows: medicine, green; music, pink; nursing, apricot; pharmacy, olive green; public administration, peacock blue; science, golden yellow; social work, citron; theology, scarlet; architecture, brown; arts, letters, and humanities, white; business, drab; dentistry, lilac; education, light blue; engineering, orange; fine arts, brown; law, purple; philosophy, dark blue.

THE MACE

THE MACE, carried by the University Marshal, Dr. Joseph B. Morris, Chairman, Department of Chemistry, is the ceremonial symbol of the University. Its origin dates back to the Middle Ages. It is used on all occasions of academic ceremony at the University. At today's Commencement, the entry of the Mace heralds the arrival of the academic procession.

THE BATON

THE BATONS carried by the Marshals and Assistant Marshals of each school and college are being used to lead the academic procession of the respective schools and colleges into and out of the place of the ceremony. The batons are made of wood, painted blue, and tied with white ribbons denoting the colors of Howard University.

THE PRESIDENTIAL CHAIN OF OFFICE (The Medallion)

The Presidential Chain of Office, worn by President Cheek, was presented to the University on the occasion of the Centennial Celebration in 1967 by Trustee Herman B Wells and his mother, Mrs. Granville Wells. The chain symbolizes the current and past holders of the Office of President. The basic material of the chain is sterling silver, plated with hard gold. Both the University Seal and the Centennial Seal are appended to the chain.
