

Earl Clifford Broady was born in Los Angeles, California, where he attended local public schools. He was later graduated from the University of Southern California and the Los Angeles College of Law

He served as a Letter Carrier with the United States Post Office from 1923-1929. He joined the Los Angeles Police Department in 1929, and during sixteen years of service he attended college and law school, resigning in 1945 to open an office for the practice of law in Los Angeles.

During his long and distinguished career in the legal profession, he served as Chief Deputy District Attorney of Los Angeles County, having been appointed to that position in January of 1965. In that position he supervised 200 lawyers and 100 non-professional employees. Later in 1965, he was appointed Judge of the Superior Court of the State of California where he served until his retirement on January 30, 1978.

Judge Broady has been the recipient of numerous honors and awards. Shortly after his appointment to the bench in 1965, then Governor of California, Jerry Brown, appointed him to the McCone Commission to investigate and render a report on the Watts riot. He has received the Award of Merit, the Justice Award and the Gerry Giesler Award for Contributions to the Criminal Justice System presented by the Criminal Courts Bar Association of Los Angeles. He has also received the Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity's Award for Community Service; an award for Outstanding Achievement in the Field of Law by the Progressive Californians; and the "Pioneer of Black Leadership" Award, presented by Brotherhood Crusade. He has been awarded the Honorary Degree of Doctor of Laws by Bishop College of Dallas, Texas.

Judge Broady is married to Anna H. Broady and they are the parents of a son and daughter, Earl C. Broady, Jr. and Elaine G. Pope, both practicing attorneys in Los Angeles, California.

For the Degree of Doctor of Humanities BARBARA PIERCE BUSH The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. Thaddeus Garrett, Jr. Member, Board of Trustees

Barbara Bush, wife of the Vice President of the United States, has lived a life which reflects her husband's varied career in business and public service, her involvement as the mother of five children, and her own energy and commitment to a wide variety of community projects.

As wife of the Vice President, a role requiring extensive travel, entertaining, and her attendance at many official functions, Mrs. Bush has chosen reading and the eradication of illiteracy as her special areas of focus. She serves on the national board of Reading Is Fundamental; is a sponsor of Laubach Literacy International, a world-wide program committed to eradicating illiteracy; an honorary member of the board of the Kingsbury Center in Washington, D.C., an organization for children with learning disabilities; Honorary Chairperson of the National Advisory Council of Literacy Volunteers of America Inc., a national volunteer tutorial organization; and a member of the Board of Directors of the Business Council for Effective Literacy, a foundation established by Harold Mc-Graw, Jr. to encourage business support for efforts to combat illiteracy. All of the proceeds of a book by Mrs. Bush, C. Fred's Story (Doubleday, 1984), a collection of anecdotes about the Bush's late cocker spaniel, are being donated to two major national literacy organizations, Laubach Literacy Action and Literacy Volunteers of America, Inc.

Reflecting her own years as an active volunteer, Mrs. Bush is also encouraging volunteerism and the giving by people of their time and energies for the betterment of others and their communities. She is a member of the Board of Trustees of Morehouse School of Medicine in Atlanta and is an honorary member of boards of the Washington Home and the Children's Oncology Services of Washington, D.C., Inc. She is the National Honorary Chairperson for the Leukemia Society of America and the Hispanic American Family of the Year Awards Program and serves in an honorary capacity with the National School Volunteer Program and the Washington Parent Group Fund. For the past three years she has served as the Honorary National Chairman of Organ Donor Awareness Week; and in conjunction with the Vice President's Constitutional responsibility as President of the U.S. Senate, Mrs. Bush is president of the Ladies of the Senate, the Red Cross unit of Senate wives.

Among the honors Mrs. Bush has received are: the 1982 Dameshek Award of the Leukemia Society of America; the 1983 Woman of the Year Award given by the Women's National Republican Club; the Woman of Achievement Award of the Girls Club of New York in 1983; the 1984 National Outstanding Mother of the Year; and the USO Woman of the Year in 1986. She was the honored guest at the 6th Annual Dinner of the Joint Center for Political Studies in Washington, D.C. in 1983. Mrs. Bush has received honorary degrees from Cardinal Stritch College in Milwaukee, Wisconsin; Mount Vernon College in Washington, D.C.; and Hood College in Frederick, Maryland.

For the Degree of Doctor of Music THOMAS ANDREW DORSEY

Thomas Andrew Dorsey, gospel song writer, pianist and blues singer, was born in Villa Rica, Georgia in 1899. He obtained his musical education in the public schools of Atlanta; at Wendell Phillips High School in Chicago; and at Chicago Musical College. In 1916 he settled in Chicago and found employment playing piano in bars, in wine rooms of saloons and in music stores as a song demonstrator. In 1923 J. Mayo ("Ink") Williams asked him to form a band to tour with Gertrude ("Ma") Rainey on the Theater Owners Booking Association (TOBA) circuit. He remained with Ma Rainey for four years during touring seasons, performing and accompanying her with his five-piece Wildcats Jazz Band, making arrangements and writing music, particularly blues, for use in her shows. During 1923-24 he was co-leader of a big band, the Whispering Syncopators. He later recorded with a small group called the Famous Hokum Boys and was an arranger for Ink William's Chicago Music Publishing Company.

The Great Depression of 1929 dealt a severe blow to blues-jazz musical activities, and Dorsey turned to sacred music. In 1932 he was appointed chorus director at the Pilgrim Baptist Church, where he remained into the 1980s. He began writing sacred songs as early as 1921, becoming inspired when he attended the annual meeting of the National Baptist Convention in Chicago and heard a singer perform A. W. Nix's "I do, don't you." One of his early songs was published in Gospel Pearls, a publication of the Sunday School Publishing Board of the National Baptist Convention (copyright 1921). He continued to write his special kind of sacred songs through the early 1920s and coined the term "gospel song" (as distinguished from gospel hymn) to refer to the songs. In 1925 he attempted to sell a song, "If You See My Savior, Tell Him That

You Saw Me." through the mail, sending hundreds of copies to churches all over the nation. The response was meager and discouraging, but in 1930 a singer performed the song at the Jubilee Meeting of the National Baptist Convention (established in 1880) and brought him wide recognition. In 1931 he organized, along with Theodore Frye, the world's first gospel chorus at the Ebenezer Baptist Church. In 1932 he opened the Dorsey House of Music, the first publishing house to sell solely gospel music of Black composers. The same year, along with Sallie Martin, he founded the National Convention of Gospel Choirs and Choruses, which within a few years had an annual attendance of 10,000 to 15,000 delegates. As early as 1927 he began promoting his songs through selling songs in churches (where ministers would allow it), particularly in storefront churches. He was also active as a performer, touring as the official pianist for Mahalia Jackson during the years 1940–42.

Mr. Dorsey has been labeled as the "Father of Gospel Music." Over his long career he wrote nearly a thousand songs and published over half of them. Before the term gospel song entered common usage, his songs were called "Dorsey's" (in the same way as the hymns of Isaac Watts were called "Watts" in Black churches). His best-known song was "Precious Lord, Take My Hand," which was translated into more than fifty languages. Other well-known songs of his include: "Search Me, Lord," "When I've Done My Best," "Hide Me In Thy Bosom," and "Peace In The Valley" (written especially for Mahalia Jackson). His numerous honors include awards from civic, church, and professional organizations and honorary doctorates from several institutions of higher learning.

For the Degree of Doctor of Laws HOWARD NAYLOR FITZHUGH

The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. James F. Tucker Member, Board of Trustees

Howard Naylor Fitzhugh was born in Washington, D.C. on October 31, 1909, the son of Lillian and William Fitzhugh. He was educated at Dunbar High School, where he was president of the Class of 1926. In 1930 he earned the Bachelor of Science degree from Harvard University and in 1933, the Master of Business Administration from the same institution, thus becoming one of the first Black Americans to be awarded the M.B.A. from Harvard. He pursued post graduate studies at Columbia University (1939–1941) and American University (1959–1961).

In 1934 Mr. Fitzhugh joined the faculty of Howard University and for 31 years he was the mentor of hundreds of Black business students. During his tenure he served as Professor of Marketing and Faculty Advisor to the Business and Marketing Clubs. In 1964, he organized the Howard University Small Business Center, a vital service to the community which is still very active.

Following retirement from the University in 1965, he became a vice president for PepsiCo. Officially retiring from his corporate duties in 1974, he remains a consultant to that company and maintains an office at corporate headquarters.

He has authored numerous articles, booklets and teaching programs in the areas of Marketing/Public Affairs. His Learn and Earn Marketing/Management Education Project, authored in 1972, received the Distributive Education Clubs of America's 1982 Award of Excellence and the 1984 top Educational Sponsorship

Award from the National Association for Industry-Education Cooperation. Another similar project, *Learning and Doing Business*, authored in 1982, earned the AVA Award of merit for that year. In addition, he has conducted studies and surveys for some of the nation's best known corporations, including Humble Oil Company, the Carnation Company, Gulf Oil and American Airlines.

He has held high policy-making positions with many national organizations and institutions, including Executive Director of the National Association of Market Developers; board member, Interracial Council for Business Opportunity; Chairman, Inter-Organizational Task Force, National Business League; Chairman Visiting Committee, Black Alumni Association, Harvard Business School; member, National Advisory Committee to the Secretary of the United States Department of Commerce; and Chairman, Advisory Committee, Howard University Business School.

Among his many honors and awards are his selection as 1986 Man of the Year Award by Excel magazine; election to Beta Gama Sigma; and Black Enterprise's designation as "Dean of Black Business."

He is married to Thelma Evelyn Hare Fitzhugh. They are the parents of three children: H. Naylor, Jr., M.D.; Richard H., Architect/Artist; and J. Idorenyin (Mrs. Delim) Jamar, Ph.D., Faculty Member, University of Kano, Nigeria.

For the Degree of Doctor of Humanities Lois Mailou Jones Pierre-Noël

The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. Frankie M. Freeman

Lois Mailou Jones Pierre-Noël is a native of Boston, Massachusetts. She received her early education from schools in that area. In 1923 she attended the Boston Museum School of Fine Arts on four Susan Minot Land Scholarships and received a diploma in Design in 1927. She also studied at Harvard University, Columbia University and at the Designers Art School in Boston. In 1928, she established the Art Department at Palmer Memorial Institute, Sedalia, North Carolina, where she remained until joining the faculty of the Art Department of Howard University in 1930, where she served as Professor of Design and Watercolor Painting for forty-seven years. While a member of the Fine Arts faculty, Dr. Jones initiated several tours to Europe and Africa for students, alumni and friends of the University. She received two Howard University Research Grants to study contemporary Haitian art, Afro-American art and to survey contemporary African art in fourteen African countries. Her project, The Black Visual Arts, involved the making of slides and collection of biographical data for the archives at Howard University. A third Howard University research grant resulted in her book, Caribbean and Afro-American Women Artists, published in 1982.

Dr. Jones has received many awards, including The Nathaniel Thayer Prize for Excellence in Design, The Robert Woods Bliss Landscape Award for Oil Painting at the Corcoran Gallery of Art, 1941; three 1st Place Awards for Oil Painting at the National Museum of Art, Washington, D. C.; the John Hope Prize for best Landscape; 1st Prize for Watercolor Painting and the Popular Prize at Atlanta University; Washington Watercolor Club 1st Prize, 1955;

Franz Bader Oil Painting Award, 1962; 1st Luban Watercolor Award, 1958; 1st Honorable Mention for Oil Painting, Salon des Artistes Français, 1966; and The Edward M. Bannister Award for Distinguished Contribution to Afro-American and American Art from the Musuem of the National Center of Afro-American Artists, Boston. She is the subject of a book entitled Lois Mailou Jones, 1937-1951, published in France in 1952. The Massachusetts House of Representatives presented her with an Official Citation in Recognition of "Her Contribution, Preservation, Promotion and Development of the Universality of Art." She also received the Candace Award from the National Coalition of 100 Black Women, at the Metropolitan Museum of Art, New York City and the 3rd Annual Mayor's Art Award for Excellence in Artistic Discipline, Washington, D. C., 1983. In 1954, the Government of Haiti awarded her the Diplome and Decoration de l'Ordre National "Honneur et Merite au Grande de Chevalier." She was also elected a Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts of London in 1962. In 1974, the world Who's Who of Women, Cambridge, England, awarded her a diploma. She received the 1978 Howard University Alumni Achievement Award and was honored at the White House by President Carter for Outstanding Achievement in Art in 1980. She has received Honorary Doctorate degrees from Colorado State Christian College, Suffolk University in Boston, and Massachusetts College of Art.

Her works are in numerous private and public collections throughout the continental United States and the international community. She is listed in Who's Who in American Art.

For the Degree of Doctor of Laws
TERRY SANFORD

Terry Sanford, United States Senator from North Carolina, educator and statesman, was born in Laurinburg, North Carolina. Son of Cecil L. Sanford and Elizabeth Martin Sanford, he received the Bachelor of Arts degree in 1939 and the Doctor of Laws degree in 1946 from the University of North Carolina.

In 1941 he started his career as a Special Agent with the Federal Bureau of Investigation, leaving to serve in the Military in 1942. He was discharged as a First Lieutenant in 1945, a veteran of five campaigns, including the Invasion of Southern France and the Battle of the Bulge. He was awarded a Combat Infantryman's Badge, Bronze Star, Purple Heart, and as a member of the 517th Parachute Infantry Combat Team, a Presidential Unit Citation.

Following graduation from law school in 1946, he served as Assistant Director, Institute of Government, University of North Carolina until 1948 when he and others formed the law firm of Sanford, Phillips, McCoy, and Weaver. This association was interruped by his election as Governor of the State of North Carolina (1961–1965) and his service as President of Duke University (1969–1985).

His political and government positions have also included the Presidency of the North Carolina Young Democratic Clubs, 1949– 1950; North Carolina State Senator in 1953; delegate to the Democratic National Convention, 1956-1968 and 1984; national chairman of Citizens for Humphrey-Muskie, 1968; chairman of the Democratic Charter Commission, 1972-1974; chairman of the Democratic National Mid-Term Conference, 1974; and chairman of the Duke Forum on Presidential Nominations, 1981.

Business and professional involvements have included his position as a lawyer at Sanford, Adams, McCullough & Beard, 1965 to 1986; director of A Study of American States, Duke University, 1965–1968. He has received numerous honors and awards, among which are the Distinguished Service Award, Education Commission of States; the Brotherhood Award, National Conference of Christians and Jews; and the North Carolina Award, State of North Carolina. He is a member of the American Bar Association; American Judicature Society; and the American Academy of Political and Social Sciences. He is the author of "But What About the People?", 1966; "Storm Over the States", 1967; and "A Danger of Democracy", 1981.

He was married in 1942 to Margaret Rose Knight and they have two children, Elizabeth Knight and James Terry.

For the Degree of Doctor of Humane Letters CAMILLE HANKS COSBY

Camille Hanks Cosby was born in Washington, D.C., the daughter of Catherine and Guy Hanks, Sr. Following graduation from high school she entered the University of Maryland in 1962 to pursue a degree in psychology. Her academic studies were temporarily interruped when she married Bill Cosby, popular entertainer and television star, on January 25, 1964.

Mrs. Cosby, having married at the early age of 19, chose to pursue her undergraduate education and her graduate education in stages, fitting course work and the writing of papers around her family's needs and particularly around the care of her five children. As the children matured, she and they were able to do their homework together.

Her tireless efforts resulted in the completion of her undergraduate studies, as well as her earning a master's degree in education from the University of Massachusetts in 1980. Focusing on "racism in education", her thesis was developed with the help of her expertise in photography to chronicle the experiences of Black Students at several of the South's Historically Black Colleges and Universities. She is a doctoral candidate, currently on leave, at the University of Massachusetts.

Mrs. Cosby serves as vice president and co-director of the diversified Cosby corporation which handles her husband's recordings, film and television projects. Her toughness in business dealings and her general business acumen are widely respected.

Her philanthropic activities, together with her husband and children, have been both generous and relevant. Many Black institutions and organizations have benefitted from her largess. She has contributed to and worked in conjunction with fund raising efforts to support People United to Save Humanity (PUSH), the United Negro College Fund (UNCF), the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (SCLC), and the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP). Education is a high priority with the Cosby's, as their exceedingly generous donation of \$1.3 million to Fisk University exemplifies.

In addition to her philanthropic activities, Mrs. Cosby is on the Boards of Essence Communications, the National Council of Negro Women and the Rainbow Coalition. She is also a full-time producer of albums and recently, videos for home distribution. She and Judith Rutherford James, her co-producer, are currently in the pre-production phase of a film based on the life of Nomzamo Winnie Mandela.

If there is one theme that unites the interests to which Mrs. Cosby gives her time, it is the education of Black children, even as they grow to become parents of other Black children.

THE CONFERRING OF DEGREES IN COURSE

The order of presentation of schools and colleges for the conferring of degrees is based on two factors—the year of establishment of the school or college and the distinction between graduate and undergraduate programs. The first eleven schools and colleges, beginning with the College of Liberal Arts and ending with the College of Allied Health Sciences, were established over the years from 1868 to 1974. These eleven schools and colleges provide basically undergraduate programs. The next five schools and colleges, beginning with the School of Divinity and ending with the School of Social Work, were established between the years of 1868 and 1945. These schools and colleges offer professional graduate level programs. The last school listed, the Graduate School of Arts and Sciences, was established in 1934 and offers graduate level programs exclusively.

THE ACADEMIC COSTUME

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students used them to keep warm in medieval castles and halls of learning. From these practical origins, they have developed into the accepted garb which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves, pointed at the fingertips. These gowns may be worn either open or closed.

The master's degree gown is worn open, and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow.

Gowns for the doctor's degree are also worn open. They carry broad, velvet panels down the front, and three velvet bars on the full, round sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the degree.

Mortar boards or caps worn with baccalaureate and master's gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

The gold fourragere on the shoulders of some candidates—commonly referred to as an honor cord—denotes outstanding scholastic distinction.

Faculty members and guests in today's procession are robed in gowns and hoods which represent the institutions from which they have received degrees.

The hood gives color and real meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the colors of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains as follows: medicine, green; music, pink; nursing, apricot; pharmacy, olive green; public administration, peacock blue; science, golden yellow; social work, citron; theology, scarlet; architecture, blue violet; arts, letters, and humanities, white; business, drab; denistry, lilac; education, light blue; engineering, orange; fine arts, brown; law, purple, philosophy, dark blue.

THE MACE

THE MACE, carried by the University Marshal, Dr. Joseph B. Morris, Chairman, Science Policy and Planning Council, is the ceremonial symbol of the University. Its origin dates back to the Middle Ages. It is used on all occasions of academic ceremony at the University. At today's Commencement, the entry of the Mace heralds the arrival of the academic procession.

THE BATON

THE BATONS carried by the Marshals and Assistant Marshals of each school and college are being used to lead the academic procession of the respective schools and colleges into and out of the place of the ceremony. The batons are made of wood, painted blue, and tied with white ribbons denoting the colors of Howard University.

THE PRESIDENTIAL CHAIN OF OFFICE (The Medallion)

The Presidential Chain of Office, worn by President Cheek, was presented to the University on the occasion of the Centennial Celebration in 1967 by Trustee Herman B. Wells and his mother, Mrs. Granville Wells. The chain symbolizes the current and past holders of the Office of President. The basic material of the chain is sterling silver, plated with hard gold. Both the University Seal and the Centennial Seal are appended to the chain.
