

WAYNE RICHARD BRYANT

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Dr. James F. Tucker

Member, Board of Trustees

Assemblyman Wayne Richard Bryant, the first African-American elected as majority leader in the history of the state of New Jersey, was born in Camden, New Jersey on November 7, 1947. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree from Howard University in 1969 and his Bachelor of Laws from Rutgers University School of Law in 1972.

A Democrat from the Fifth Legislative District, he represents Camden-Gloucester counties and has served in the New Jersey General Assembly since 1981. He is also a partner in the law firm of Freeman, Zeller and Bryant, and has held many municipal and county government positions.

Mr. Bryant has served in a number of legal positions, including Special Solicitor, Pennsauken Police Department, Bond Counsel to Boroughs of Lawnside, Somerdale and City of Camden and Deputy General Counsel to BPUM Economic Development Corporation. He is one of New Jersey's leading spokespersons on urban economic policies and transportation.

Mr. Bryant's bar admissions include: Supreme Court of New Jersey; District of Columbia Court of Appeals; United States

Supreme Court; United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit and the United States District Court of the District of Columbia.

Mr. Bryant has received numerous awards and citations including: Legislative Achievement—National Business League, NAACP and the Atlantic County Minority Business Council; Outstanding Legislative Achievement—Association of Black Women Lawyers of New Jersey; Recognition Award for Dedication to the Economic Growth of the Black Community.

Mr. Bryant has served or continues to serve on the Board of Camden County Bar Association; Camden County Board of Trustees—Youth Center; American Bar Association; Phi Alpha Delta Law Fraternity; National Black Caucus of State Legislators; Conference of State Legislators; a member of the Camden County Council on Economic Opportunity, Inc.; Camden County Urban League, Board of Directors; National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (Lifetime member) and many other organizations.

Mr. Bryant is married to the former Jean Woods and they have a son, Wayne Richard, Jr.

MORRIS SELIGMAN DEES, JR.

The Candidate Will be Presented by Mrs. Elizabeth G. Early

Morris Seligman Dees, Jr., Chief Trial Counsel for the Southern Poverty Law Center, was born in 1936 at Shorter, Alabama, the son of a farmer and cotton gin operator.

Mr. Dees attended the University of Alabama where he earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree in 1958. After graduation from the University of Alabama School of Law in 1960, he returned to Montgomery, Alabama where he opened a law office and continued a mail order business he started in college.

The direct mail publishing business (Fuller & Dees Marketing Group) grew to be one of the largest publishing companies in the South. Eventually sales reached \$15 million and in 1969, Mr. Dees sold the company to Times Mirror, the parent company of the Los Angeles Times.

Along with Joseph J. Levin, Jr. and Julian Bond he founded the Southern Poverty Law Center in 1971. The Center has engaged in civil rights lawsuits ranging from the defense of Joan Little in North Carolina to the integration of the Alabama State Troopers.

Mr. Dees was the subject of a made-for-television movie that described Dees's successful fight against the Ku Klux Klan and the \$7 million precedent-setting judgment against the United Klans of America on behalf of the mother of Michael Donald, a young Black

man lynched by the Klan in Mobile, Alabama.

Mr. Dees has received a number of awards and honorary degrees including the Tuskegee Institute, Outstanding Service for Human Rights Award, 1976; Alabama Civil Liberties Union, Annual Award for Outstanding Devotion to Individual Rights, 1981; Trial Lawyers for Public Justice, Trial Lawyer of the Year Award, 1987; American Bar Association, Young Lawyers Distinguished Service Award, 1987; Alabama State NAACP Award, 1987; Honorary Fellowship of the Law School, University of Pennsylvania Law School, 1988; Roger Baldwin Award, ACLU, 1989; Honorary Degree, Providence College, 1990; Honorary Degree, Whittier College, 1990; National Education Association, Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Award, 1990.

Presently, Mr. Dees through the Southern Poverty Law Center is devoting his time to suing violent white supremacist groups and developing ideas for the new Civil Rights' Education Project. His autobiography, *A Season for Justice*, is due to be published by MacMillan Press.

Mr. Dees is married to Elizabeth Dees and they have three children, Morris III, John and Ellie.

AUGUSTUS FREEMAN (GUS) HAWKINS
The Candidate Will Be Presented by Dr. Frederick L. Stone
Member, Board of Trustees

Augustus Freeman (Gus) Hawkins represented the 29th Congressional District of California for 28 years until his retirement in January.

He was born in Shreveport, Louisiana in 1907, the son of a pharmacist. His family moved to Los Angeles to escape the grip of racial discrimination and to improve their educational prospects when he was eleven years old.

On his first professional venture into politics in 1934, Mr. Hawkins was elected to the California State Assembly, a post he held for 28 continuous years.

As a member of the California State Assembly, Mr. Hawkins compiled an impressive legislative record, eventually assuming the powerful position of Chairman of the Rules Committee. During his tenure he authored over 100 laws, including: slum clearance and low cost housing; the Fair Housing Act; old age pension, child care centers; and The Fair Employment Practice Act of 1959, among others.

Mr. Hawkins was elected in 1962 to the U.S. Congress with the strong support of the late President John F. Kennedy.

Congressman Hawkins was Chairman of the Education and Labor Committee and a member of the Joint Economic Committee. In the more than 55 years of service as a legislator in the California State Assembly and U.S. Congress, he has sponsored major civil rights, education and labor legislation at state and federal levels. He was successful in enacting legislation to grant honorable discharges to the Black soldiers who were involved in the "Brownsville Incident" some 66 years after they had been framed by local townspeople and drummed out of the Army without a fair trial and without honor. As Chairman of the Education and Labor Committee, he was principal guardian of education policy at every level and watchdog of all labor issues. During the 100th Congress (1987-88), Congressman Hawkins authored two landmark pieces of legislation which became law: The School Improvement Act and the Civil Rights Restoration Act which strengthened four important civil rights laws which protect all Americans against discrimination based on race, sex, age or handicap by institutions that receive federal money.

He is married to the former Elsie Taylor.

LOUIS WADE SULLIVAN
The Candidate Will be Presented by Mr. John L. Procope

Louis Wade Sullivan, Secretary of Health and Human Services, was born in Atlanta, Georgia, November 3, 1933. As head of the Department of Health and Human Services, Dr. Sullivan oversees the federal agency responsible for the major health, welfare, food and drug safety, medical research and income security programs serving the American people.

He received a Bachelor of Science degree, *magna cum laude*, from Morehouse College in 1954 and earned his medical degree, *cum laude*, from Boston University in 1958. His internship and medical residency were at New York Hospital-Cornell Medical Center. Dr. Sullivan became a fellow in hematology at the Thorndike Memorial Research Laboratories of Harvard Medical School at Boston City Hospital. His distinctive teaching career includes being an instructor in medicine at Harvard Medical School, assistant professor of medicine at New Jersey College of Medicine, co-director of hematology at Boston University Medical Center, assistant professor of medicine, associate professor of medicine and professor of medicine at Boston University School of Medicine. He was also co-project director and project director of the Boston Sickle Cell Center and Director of Hematology at Boston City Hospital.

Dr. Sullivan returned to Morehouse College, his alma mater, in 1975 as professor of biology and medicine. In July 1975, Dr. Sullivan became founding dean and director of the Medical Education Program at Morehouse College. On July 1, 1981, when the School of

Medicine became independent from Morehouse College, he served as its first dean and president. After accreditation of the Morehouse School of Medicine in April 1985, the School awarded the Doctor of Medicine Degree to its first 16 graduates on May 17, 1985.

Dr. Sullivan is a member of the American Medical Association, National Medical Association, Atlanta Medical Association, Medical Association of Atlanta, Medical Association of Georgia and the Georgia State Medical Association.

In addition to being the recipient of over 17 honorary degrees, Dr. Sullivan has received numerous other honors and awards including: election to Alpha Omega Alpha Honor Medical Society in 1957; Phi Beta Kappa in 1974; the Institute of Medicine (National Academy of Sciences) in 1975; vice chairman of the Commission on Health and Human Services of the Southern Regional Education Board 1985-87; Boston University Alumni Award for Distinguished Public Service in 1985; Honoree of the Year of the State Committee on the Life and Health of Black Georgians in 1963, the first Martin Luther King, Jr. Visiting Professorship at the University of Michigan, 1986, the Morehouse College "Benny" Award for Outstanding Achievement in 1989 and the Equitable Black Achievement Award in Education in 1989.

Dr. Sullivan and his wife, Ginger, have three children: Paul, Shanta and Halstod.

ASA GREENWOOD YANCEY, SR.

Asa Greenwood Yancey, Sr. was born August 19, 1916 in Atlanta, Georgia. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in 1937 from Morehouse College and his Doctor of Medicine degree from The University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, Michigan in June, 1941.

He served a general rotating internship at City Hospital (now Metropolitan General Hospital), Cleveland, Ohio, later choosing General Surgery as a speciality and a residency at Freedmen's Hospital/Howard University School of Medicine in Washington, D.C. under Dr. Charles R. Drew. In 1948, he was appointed Chief of Surgery at Tuskegee Veterans Administration Hospital where he established a fully accredited Type II general surgical training program. This was the first accredited surgical graduate medical education program for Black surgeons in the State of Alabama.

In 1958, he was appointed Chief of Surgery at the Hughes Spalding Pavilion of Grady Memorial Hospital and remained in this capacity until 1972. This led to the first fully accredited senior residency program in general surgery for Black surgeons in the State of Georgia. The Fulton DeKalb Hospital Authority and Emory University School of Medicine were sponsors of the program.

On August 1, 1972, he was appointed as Medical Director, Grady Memorial Hospital and associate Dean, Emory University School

of Medicine where he served until 1989. He was made emeritus Professor of Surgery, Emory University in August of 1986.

He has been the author and/or co-author of many publications dealing with medicine, paramount among which is an article entitled "Medical Education in Atlanta and Health Care of Black Minority and Low Income People," Journal of National Medical Association, (1988).

Dr. Yancey has received numerous awards including: the Aven Cup Award, Medical Association of Atlanta; Roy Wilkins Award of the Atlanta NAACP. He has also been featured as Lecturer at the Charles R. Drew, M.D. Commemorative Stamp Lecture, and W. Montague Cobb annual Ciba-Geigy Lecture. He is a Life member and Golden Heritage Member of the NAACP; member of Friendship Baptist Church; Board of Trustees, American Cancer Society State of Georgia Chapter; member of the Atlanta Urban League; National Medical Association; and 1st Vice President, National Medical Association.

Dr. Yancey is married to the former Carolyn E. Dunbar and they have four children, Arthur H. II; Carolyn L.; Caren L. and Asa G. Jr.

SHARON PRATT DIXON

The Candidate Will be Presented by Dr. John E. Jacob

Sharon Pratt Dixon was born in Washington, D.C. on January 30, 1944. She became the chief executive officer of the District of Columbia in January 1991. She obtained a Bachelors of Arts in Political Science in 1965 from Howard University. Her father, D.C. Superior Court Judge Carlisle E. Pratt, encouraged her to obtain a law degree and she entered the Howard University School of Law in 1965, before it was commonplace for women, and was awarded the Juris Doctor degree in 1968. From 1971 to 1976, Mayor Dixon was in the private practice of law and was a law school professor at Antioch School of Law. In September 1976, she was appointed vice president for public policy with the Potomac Electric Power Company, the first woman to serve as a vice president in the company's history.

She is a skilled litigator and, in 1977, was appointed by Speaker Thomas P. O'Neill as Vice Chairman of the D.C. Law Revision Commission. Mayor Dixon has been active in Democratic politics both on the national and local level for over 20 years.

Mayor Dixon has served or continues to serve as a member of the Board of Directors of the Maryland-District of Columbia Utilities

Association; a member of the Greater Washington Board of Trade; a member of the Edison Electrical Institute; chairman of the Board of Councillors of the University of the District of Columbia College of Business and Public Management; Howard University Board of Trustees; she is also a member of the Executive Committee of the Democratic National Committee; Eastern Regional Caucus of the Democratic National Committee District of Columbia Democratic State Committee, Unified Bar of the District of Columbia; D.C. Women's Bar Association; National Association of Black Women Attorneys; Pi Sigma Alpha (the National Political Science Honor Society); and numerous other business and professional organizations.

She is a member of the bars of the District of Columbia Superior Court; District of Columbia Court of Appeals; United States District Court for the District of Columbia; United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia and the United States Tax Court.

THE CONFERRING OF DEGREES IN COURSE

The order of presentation of schools and colleges for the conferring of degrees is based on two factors—the year of establishment of the school or college and the distinction between graduate and undergraduate programs. The first eleven schools and colleges, beginning with the College of Liberal Arts and ending with the College of Allied Health Sciences, were established over the years from 1868 to 1974. These eleven schools and colleges provide basically undergraduate programs. The next five schools and colleges, beginning with the School of Divinity and ending with the School of Social Work, were established between the years of 1868 and 1945. These schools and colleges offer professional graduate level programs. The last school listed, the Graduate School of Arts and Sciences, was established in 1934 and offers graduate level programs exclusively.

THE ACADEMIC COSTUME

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students used them to keep warm in medieval castles and halls of learning. From these practical origins, they have developed into the accepted garb which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves, pointed at the fingertips. These gowns may be worn either open or closed.

The master's degree gown is worn open, and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow.

Gowns for the doctor's degree are also worn open. They carry broad, velvet panels down the front, and three velvet bars on the full, round sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the degree.

Mortar board or caps worn with baccalaureate and master's gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

The gold fourragé on the shoulders of some candidates—commonly referred to as an honor cord—denotes outstanding scholastic distinction.

Faculty members and guests in today's procession are robed in gowns and hoods which represent the institutions from which they have received degrees.

The hood gives color and real meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the colors of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains as follows: medicine, green; music, pink; nursing, apricot; pharmacy, olive green; public administration, peacock blue; science, golden yellow; social work, citron; theology, scarlet; architecture, blue violet; arts, letters, and humanities, white; business, drab; dentistry, lilac; education, light blue; engineering, orange; fine arts, brown; law, purple; philosophy, dark blue.

THE MACE

THE MACE, carried by the University Marshal, Dr. Joseph B. Morris, Professor of Chemistry, is the ceremonial symbol of the University. Its origin dates back to the Middle Ages. It is used on all occasions of academic ceremony at the University. At today's Commencement, the entry of the Mace heralds the arrival of the academic procession.

THE BATON


THE BATONS carried by the Marshals and Assistant Marshals of each school and college are being used to lead the academic procession of the respective schools and colleges into and out of the place of the ceremony. The batons are made of wood, painted blue, and tied with white ribbons denoting the colors of Howard University.

THE PRESIDENTIAL CHAIN OF OFFICE (The Medallion)

The Presidential Chain of Office, worn by President Jenifer, was presented to the University on the occasion of the Centennial Celebration in 1967 by Trustee Herman B. Wells and his mother, Mrs. Granville Wells. The chain symbolizes the current and past holders of the office of President. The basic material of the chain is sterling silver, plated with hard gold. Both the University Seal and the Centennial Seal are appended to the chain.
