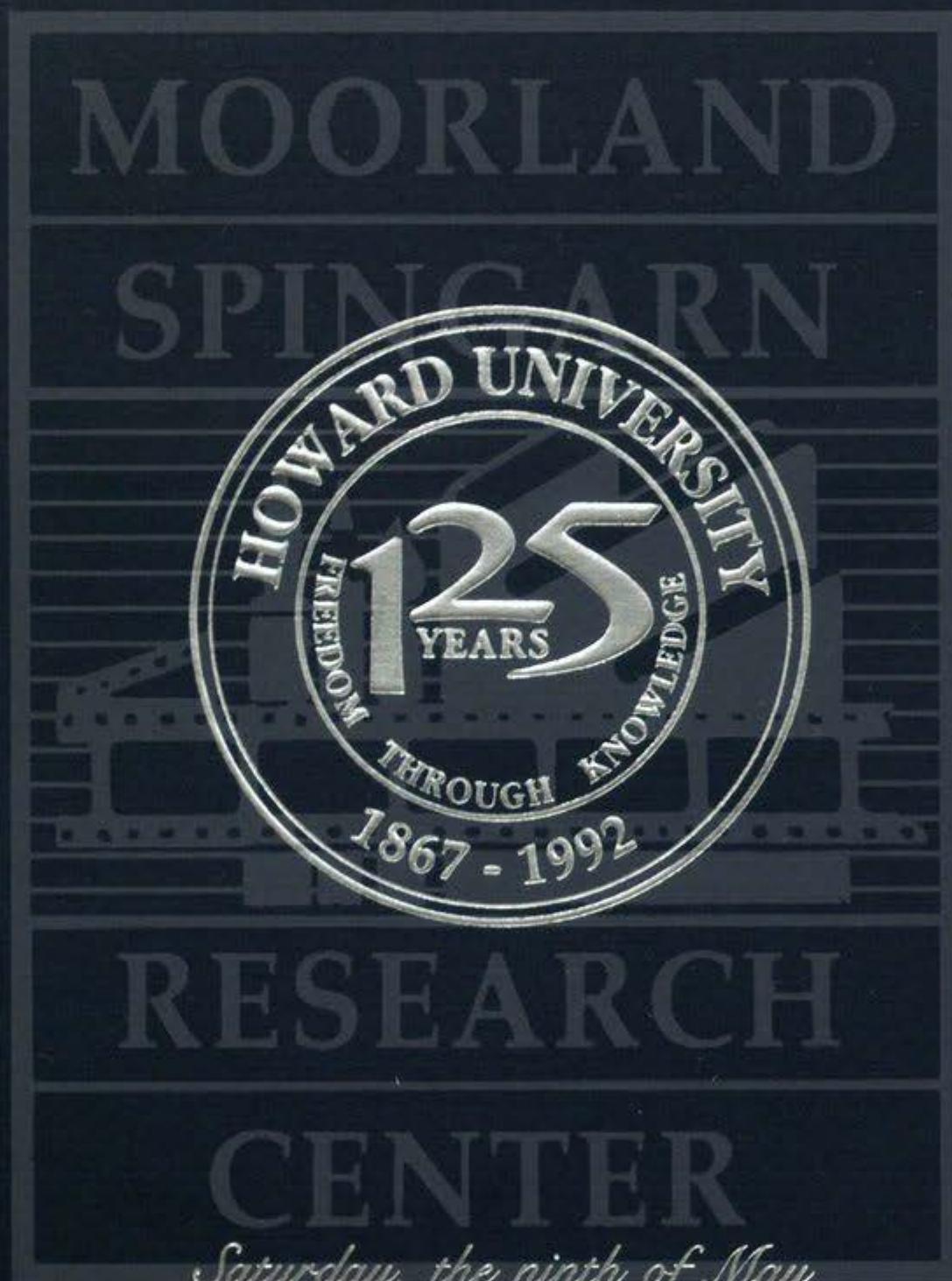

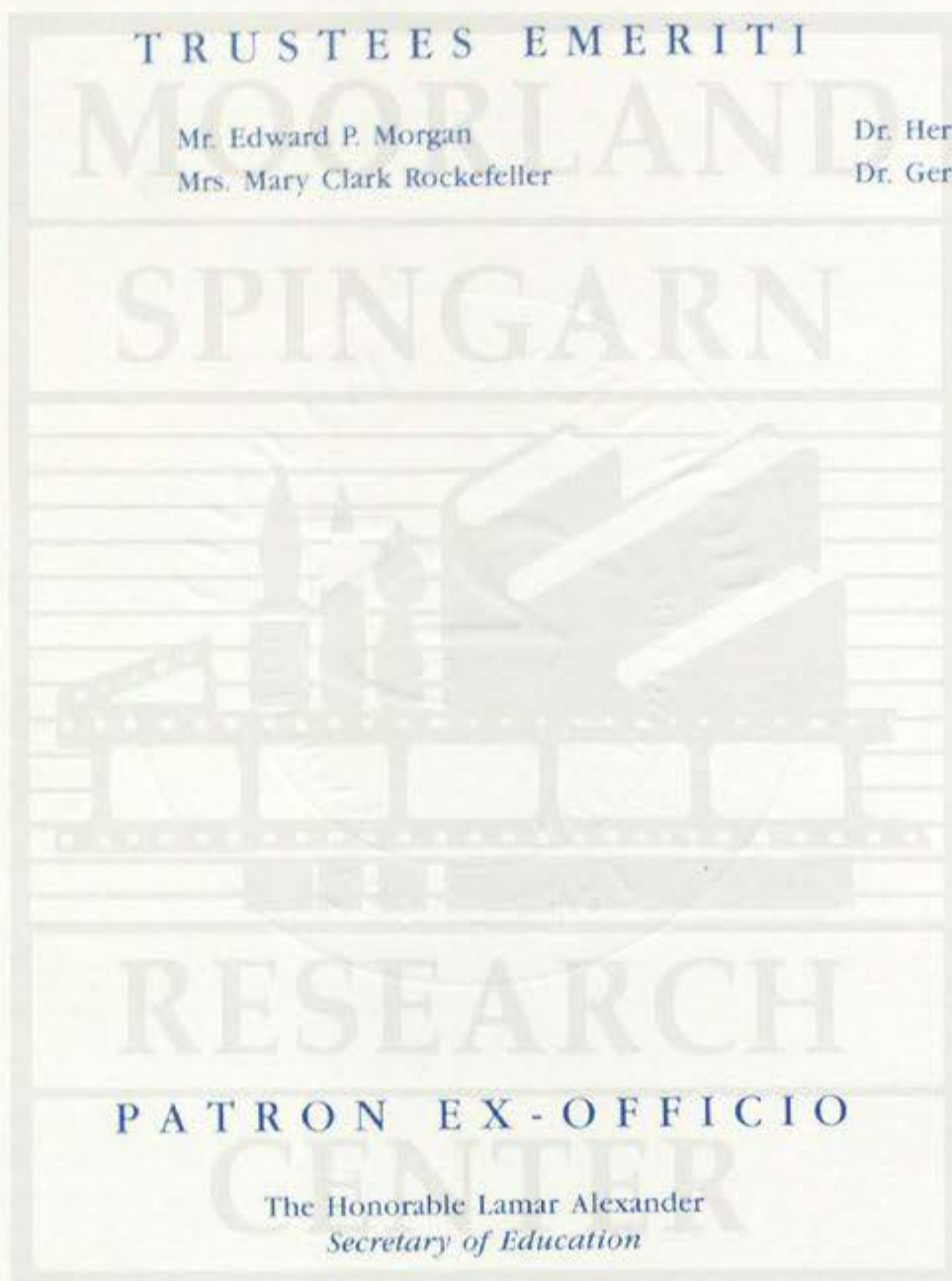

THE CONVOCATION ORATOR THE HONORABLE BENJAMIN LAWSON HOOKS

Benjamin L. Hooks was unanimously elected Executive Director of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People—the oldest civil rights organization in the world—by the NAACP National Board of Directors on January 10, 1977. He assumed office on August 1, 1977, succeeding Roy Wilkins.

The career of Dr. Hooks has embraced the fields of law, ministry and public service.

As the chief executive officer of the NAACP, he has become well-known for his effective and persuasive oratory, and he has also been a major figure in the civil rights movement.

Among the many achievements in those roles, he was known as a leading voice in the successful effort to secure legislation to impose economic sanctions against the apartheid practices of the government of the Republic of South Africa. He was also instrumental in securing passage of the voting rights extension, the Martin Luther King, Jr. Holiday Bill, the defeat of the Bork nomination to the U.S. Supreme Court, and he was the architect of the 1978 demonstration at the Davis Cup Match at Vanderbilt University in Nashville, Tennessee, to protest the participation of players from South Africa.

Under his leadership, the NAACP purchased and retired the debt for the Association's permanent national headquarters in Baltimore, Maryland, and for the first time in its history, the Association owns its home.

Dr. Hooks is or has been a member of the boards of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference, the Leadership Conference on Civil Rights, the League of Women Voters, the National Conference of Christians and Jews, the Public Broadcasting Corporation, the National Alliance of Business and the A. Philip Randolph Institute—to name a few.

Prior to his work with the NAACP, Dr. Hooks served on the Federal Communications Commission. President Richard Nixon nominated him as the first black member of the Commission in 1972.

His career as an attorney started in Memphis, Tennessee, where he served as an assistant public defender, the general counsel and the first black judge of Shelby County (Memphis) Criminal Court. He was the first black judge of a court of record in the South since the Reconstruction.

Born in Memphis, Dr. Hooks attended LeMoyne College (now LeMoyne-Owen) in Memphis and Howard University. He received a law degree from DePaul University in Chicago in 1948.

He has received more than 20 honorary degrees, including an honorary doctorate from Howard University in 1975. In 1986, he became the 71st recipient of the NAACP's highest award, the Spingarn Medal.

PAUL BERTAUCORNELY

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Dr. Charles D. Watts

Dr. Paul B. Cornely retired in 1973 as professor emeritus from the Howard University College of Medicine after more than four decades of achievement in medical education, health services administration and public health.

He served as medical director of the Freedmen's Hospital in Washington, D.C., (the predecessor institution to Howard University Hospital) from 1947 to 1958, and he was professor and chairman of the Department of Community Health and Family Practice from 1955 to 1973.

He has also been a consultant to several federal and voluntary organizations, including the U.S. Agency for International Development. From 1973 to 1983, he was senior medical consultant for System Sciences, Inc., in Bethesda, Maryland.

His research efforts have included studies in tuberculosis, venereal diseases and scarlet fever, as well as studies of the cost and quality of the utilization of physicians extenders. He has published over 100 scientific and popular articles.

Dr. Cornely was president of the Community Group Health Foundation from 1968 to 1973, an organization which administered the Cardozo Comprehensive Neighborhood Health

Center serving more than 50,000 persons in the District of Columbia. He pioneered the utilization of neighborhood health workers in 1958. As founder of the District of Columbia Public Health Association, he served as its first president from 1962 to 1964, and he was also president of the American Public Health Association in 1970.

He has received numerous awards and citations which include the Honorary Fellow of the Royal Society of London, Honorary Fellow of the American College of Hospital Administrators and honorary degrees from the University of Michigan and the University of the Pacific. In 1982, the Citizens Committee for Immigration Reform selected Dr. Cornely and 35 immigrants and refugees as having made extraordinary contributions to this country.

He was president of the John Carroll Society from 1971 to 1973, an organization of outstanding Catholic professional and business men and women in metropolitan Washington, D.C.

Born in Pointe-a-Pitre, Guadeloupe in the French West Indies, Dr. Cornely earned a bachelor's degree, the Doctor of Medicine degree and the Doctor of Public Health degree from the University of Michigan in 1928, 1931 and 1934, respectively.

ANN LANDERS

The Candidate Will be Presented by The Honorable Jewel LaFontant-MANKarious
Member, Board of Trustees

Ann Landers is the most widely syndicated columnist in the world, with an estimated readership of 90 million in over 1,200 newspapers. She began writing the column on October 16, 1955.

Miss Landers has also been very active on health issues. In 1980, President Jimmy Carter appointed her to serve as a member of the National Cancer Advisory Board at the National Cancer Institute for a six-year term. In 1981, President Ronald Reagan appointed Miss Landers to the board of the President's Commission on Drunk Driving.

She is a member of the Visiting Committee for the Board of Overseers for Harvard Medical School, a trustee for the Menninger Foundation and the Dermatology Foundation, and a member of the Mayo Foundation Sponsors Committee. She also serves on the boards of Meharry Medical College, the Rehabilitation Institute of Chicago, the National Board of the American Cancer Society and the Hereditary Disease Foundation.

In 1985, Ann Landers was the first journalist to receive the Albert Lasker Public Service Award, a prestigious medical award for her work to secure federal funding for cancer research and for her work in communicating information about health issues. The American Medical Association also awarded Miss Landers the Citation for Distinguished Service, the highest honor the Association gives to a non-physician.

Additionally, she has received more than 20 honorary degrees from colleges and universities across the country, including Duke University, Baylor College of Medicine, the Medical College of Pennsylvania and Meharry Medical College.

In addition to her column, Miss Landers is the author of several books, including *Since You Ask Me* (1962), *Ann Landers Talks to Teen-Agers About Sex* (1964), *Truth is Stranger* (1968), *Ann Landers Speaks Out* (1975) and *The Ann Landers Encyclopedia* (1978).

In private life, Miss Landers is Mrs. Eppie Lederer and lives in Chicago. She is a native of Sioux City, Iowa, and attended Morningside College in Sioux City.

MICHAEL NORMAN MANLEY

The Candidate will be Presented by Mr. John L. Procope

In February 1989, Michael Manley was elected prime minister of Jamaica for the third time, and on March 30, 1992, he stepped down from office. He had previously been elected to the post for two successive four-year terms in 1972 and 1976.

Manley's political career began in 1952 when he was elected to the National Executive Council of the People's National Party. He was appointed to the Senate (the Upper House of the Parliament) from 1962 to 1967 and was elected to the House of Representatives (the Lower House) in 1967 when he won the seat for the central Kingston constituency in the general election. He was re-elected to successive terms in 1972, 1976 and 1980.

In 1967 he was elected vice president of the PNP and became president in 1969, a post he has held since.

When he was elected prime minister in 1972, he was elected in a landslide victory that made him Jamaica's fourth prime minister.

Manley has also been involved in the trade union movement since 1952, when he was first appointed union organizer of the

National Workers' Union, one of the largest unions in the Caribbean. In 1955 he became Island Supervisor of the NWU, and since 1984, he has held the office of the president of the union. During 1964-72, he also served as president of the Caribbean Bauxite Mine & Metal Workers' Federation.

From 1949 to 1952, Manley worked as a journalist, first with the British Broadcasting Corporation in London and then as associate editor of *Public Opinion*, a Kingston newspaper.

Educated at Jamaica College from 1935 to 1943, he was an honors student at the London School of Economics where he read for the Bachelor of Science degree in Economics (1945-49).

Manley was born in Kingston, the second son of the late Norman Washington Manley who was premier of Jamaica from 1955 to 1962 and National Hero of Jamaica. His mother was Edna nee Swithenbank, a sculptor of international repute and one of the founders of Jamaica's modern art movement. His father, Norman Manley, was awarded an honorary degree by Howard University in 1946.

CARMEN ELIZABETH TURNER

Carmen E. Turner, a professional administrator with more than 30 years of federal and local experience, was appointed the Under Secretary of the Smithsonian Institution in December 1990.

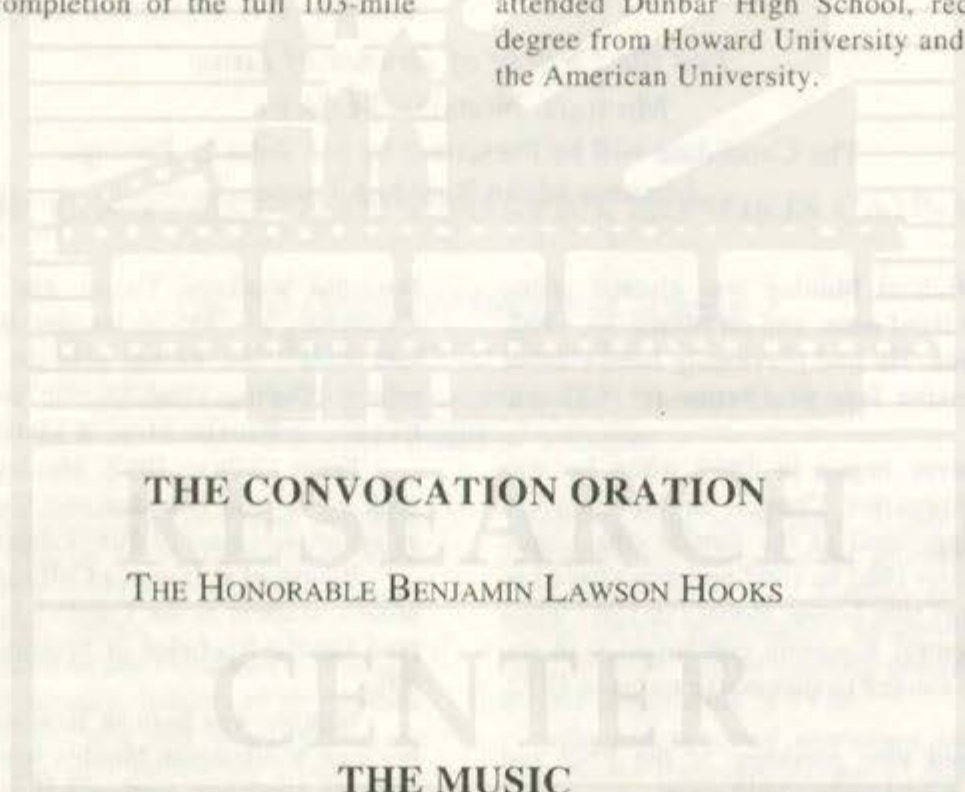
As the Under Secretary, Mrs. Turner was the Chief Operating Officer for the Institution with responsibility for operational oversight and direction of the affairs and activities of the largest museum complex in the world. As the Chief Operating Officer, she oversaw a \$401-million annual budget. These funds support permanent and traveling exhibitions, research, membership programs, a wide range of educational activities, publications and media productions. The Institution employs approximately 6,600 employees.

Prior to joining the Smithsonian, Mrs. Turner was the General Manager of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority in Washington, D.C. for seven years. Under her leadership, the Metrorail system grew from 42.37 miles and 47 stations to 73 miles and 63 stations, expanding by 40 percent. In the fall of 1990, Mrs. Turner secured a firm commitment from Congress to fund the completion of the full 103-mile Metrorail system.

In October 1988, the American Public Transit Association chose WMATA to receive its Public Transit Agency Outstanding Achievement Award, given annually to the top transit agency in North America. This was followed in 1989 with APTA presenting Mrs. Turner with the Jesse L. Haugh award, given annually to the transit manager of the year "Who has done the most to advance the urban transit industry in the United States and Canada."

A dedicated volunteer, Mrs. Turner was a member of the many community groups. She served as a member of the Boards of Trustees of Howard University, George Washington University and WETA. In 1988, she was appointed co-chair of the D.C. Committee on Public Education, a committee established by the Federal City Council to conduct an independent assessment of the public schools in the District of Columbia and to develop a long-range plan to improve them. The plan was presented in June 1989. Mrs. Turner is the co-founder of the Conference of Minority Transit Officials.

A long-time resident of Washington, D.C., Mrs. Turner attended Dunbar High School, received her undergraduate degree from Howard University and the Master's degree from the American University.

THE CONFERRING OF DEGREES IN COURSE

The order of presentation of schools and colleges for the conferring of degrees is based on two factors—the year of establishment of the school or college and the distinction between graduate and undergraduate programs. The first ten schools and colleges, beginning with the College of Arts and Sciences and ending with the College of Allied Health Sciences, were established over the years from 1868 to 1974. These ten schools and colleges provide basically undergraduate programs. The next five schools and colleges, beginning with the School of Divinity and ending with the School of Social Work, were established between the years of 1868 and 1945. These schools and colleges offer professional graduate level programs. The last school listed, the Graduate School of Arts and Sciences, was established in 1934 and offers graduate level programs exclusively.

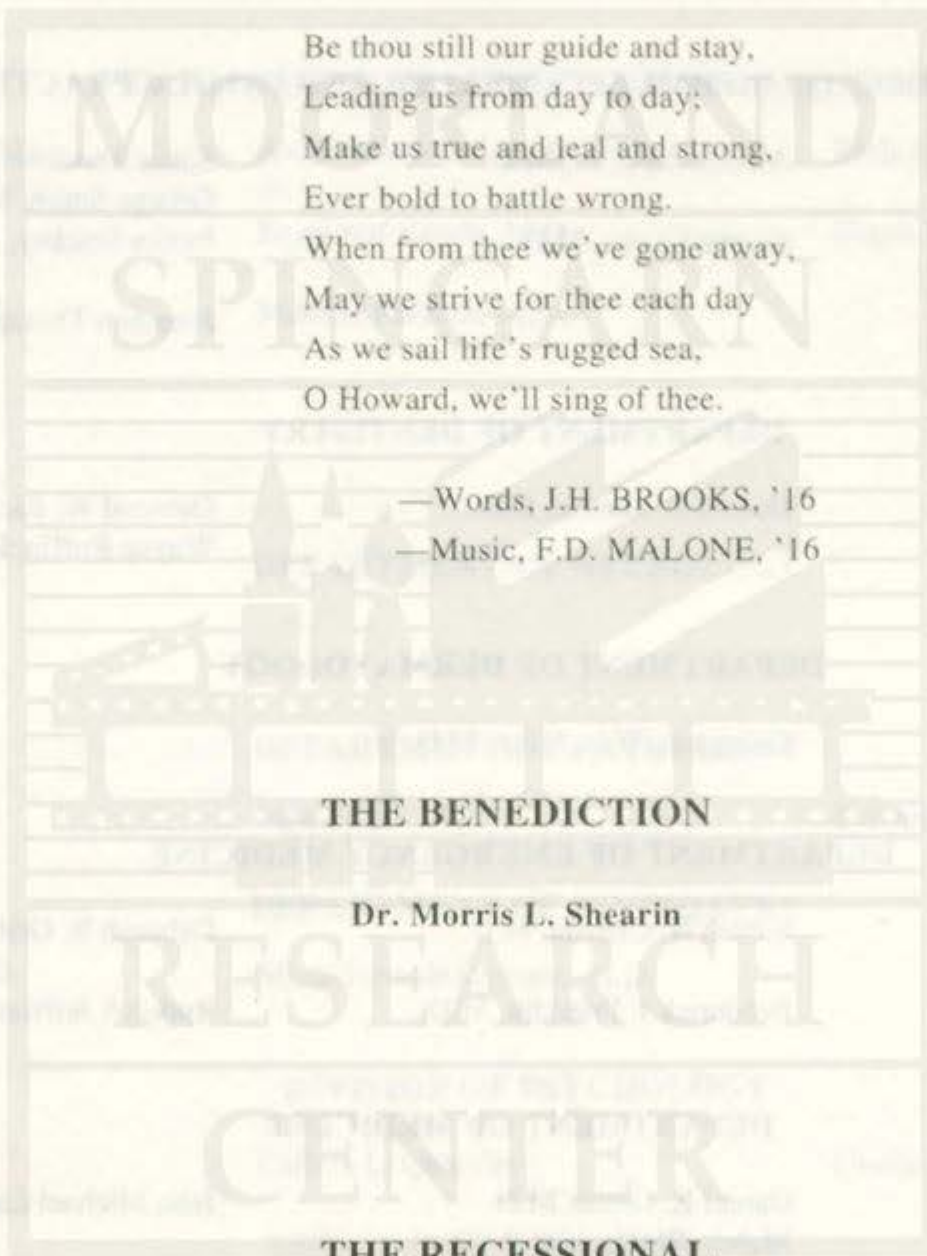
THE ALMA MATER

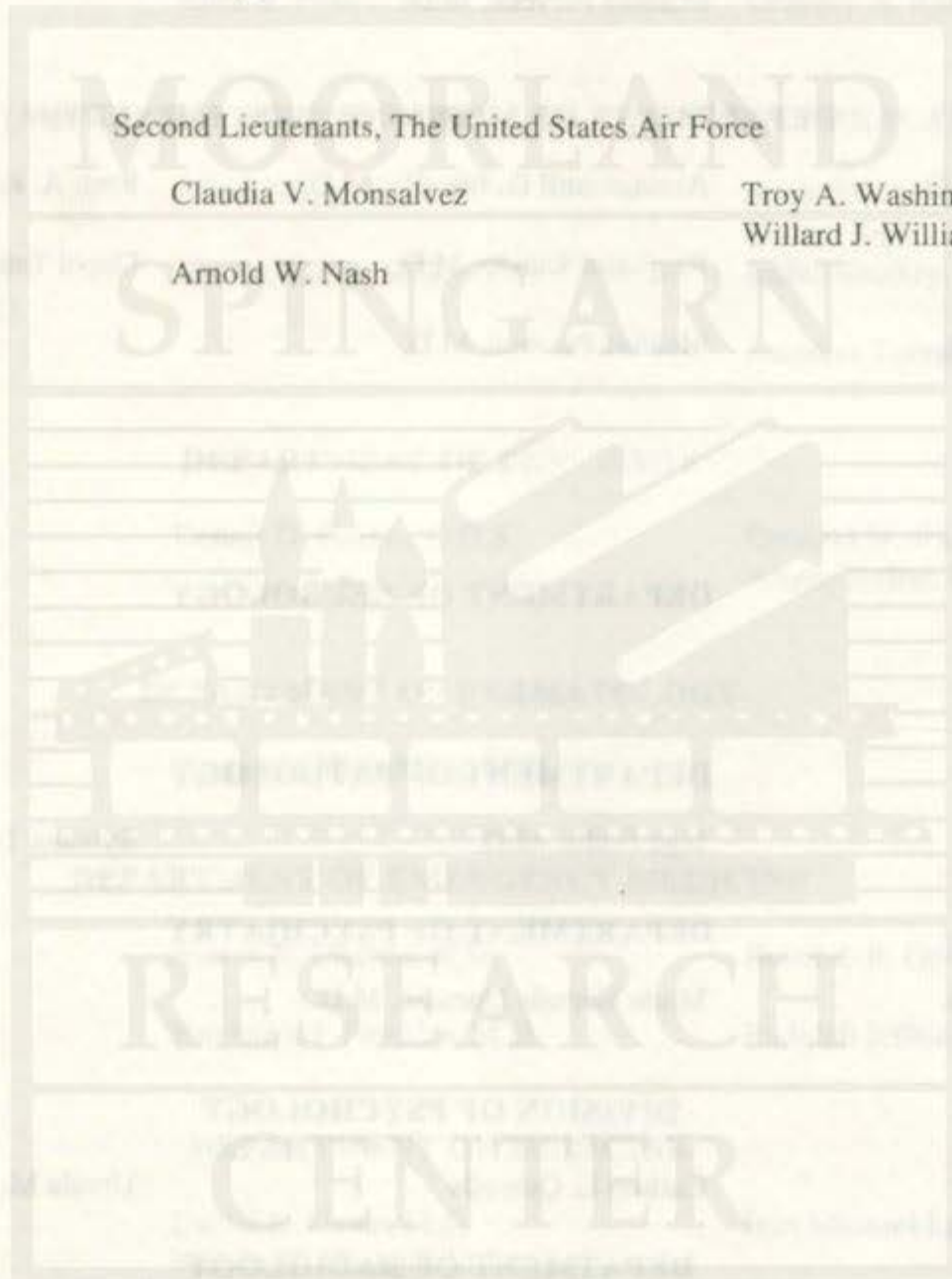

**Distinguished Military Student

THE ACADEMIC COSTUME

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students used them to keep warm in medieval castles and halls of learning. From these practical origins, they have developed into the accepted garb which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves, pointed at the fingertips. These gowns may be worn either open or closed.

The master's degree gown is worn open, and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow.

Gowns for the doctor's degree are also worn open. They carry broad, velvet panels down the front, and three velvet bars on the full, round sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the degree.

Mortar board or caps worn with baccalaureate and master's gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

The gold fourragé on the shoulders of some candidates—commonly referred to as an honor cord—denotes outstanding scholastic distinction.

Faculty members and guests in today's procession are robed in gowns and hoods which represent the institutions from which they have received degrees.

The hood gives color and real meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the colors of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains as follows: medicine, green; music, pink; nursing, apricot; pharmacy, olive green; public administration, peacock blue; science, golden yellow; social work, citron; theology, scarlet; architecture, blue violet; arts, letters, and humanities, white; business, drab; dentistry, lilac; education, light blue; engineering, orange; fine arts, brown; law, purple; philosophy, dark blue.

THE MACE

THE MACE, carried by the University Marshal, Dr. Gary L. Harris, Professor of Electrical Engineering, is the ceremonial symbol of the University. Its origin dates back to the Middle Ages. It is used on all occasions of academic ceremony at the University. At today's Commencement, the entry of the Mace heralds the arrival of the academic procession.

THE BATON

THE BATONS carried by the Marshals and Assistant Marshals of each school and college are being used to lead the academic procession of the respective schools and colleges into and out of the place of the ceremony. The batons are made of wood, painted blue, and tied with white ribbons denoting the colors of Howard University.

THE PRESIDENTIAL CHAIN OF OFFICE

(The Medallion)

The Presidential Chain of Office, worn by President Jenifer, was presented to the University on the occasion of the Centennial Celebration in 1967 by Trustee Herman B. Wells and his mother, Mrs. Granville Wells. The chain symbolizes the current and past holders of the office of President. The basic material of the chain is sterling silver, plated with hard gold. Both the University Seal and the Centennial Seal are appended to the chain.
