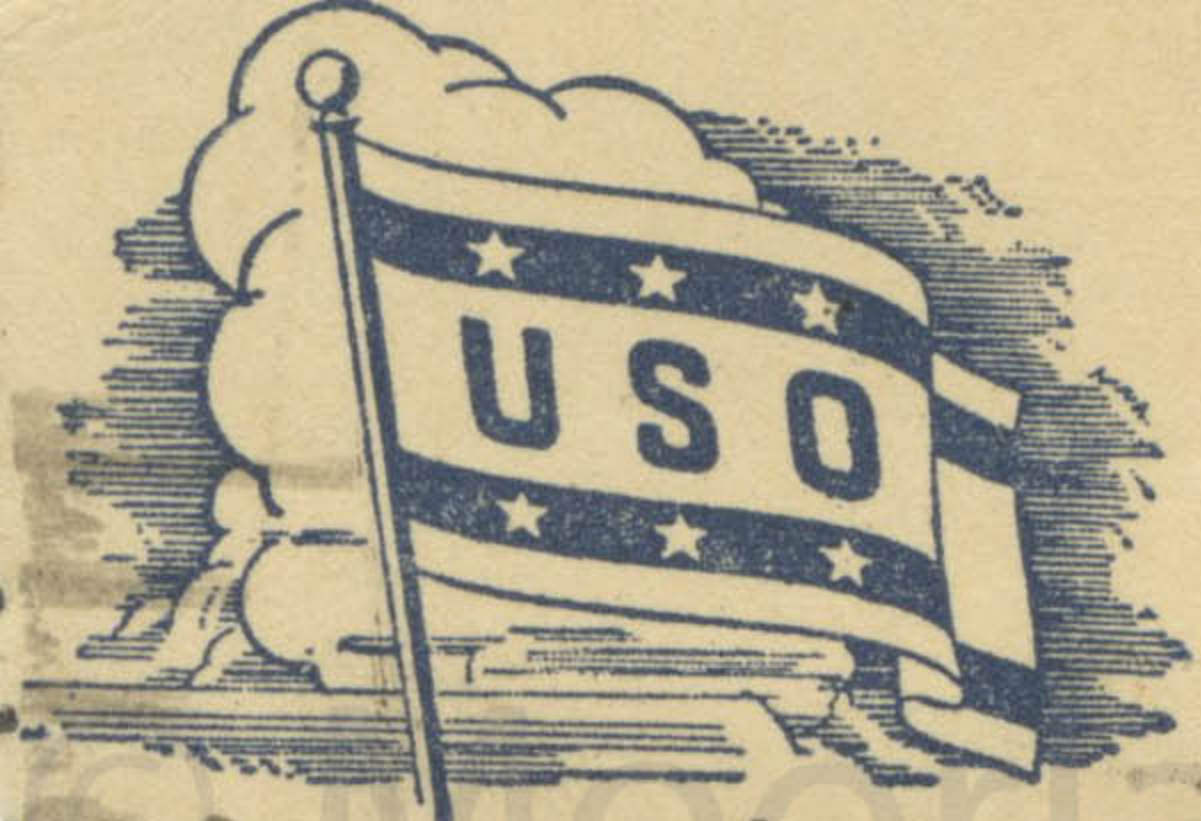

Dear Miss Tate,

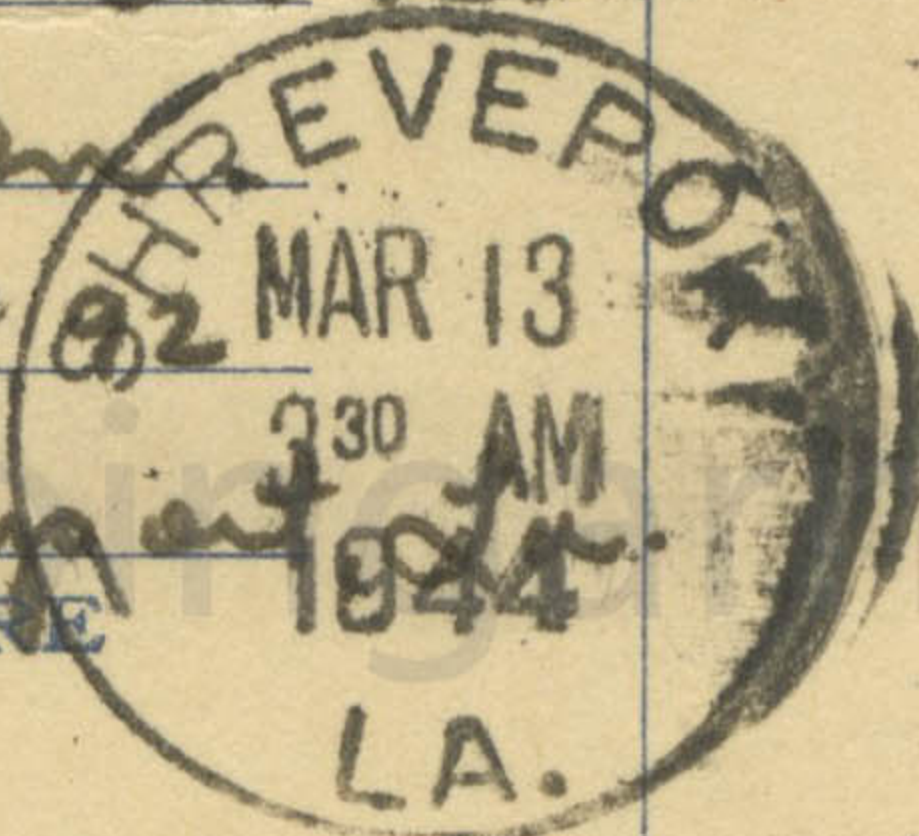
Just a line to say hello. I'm
