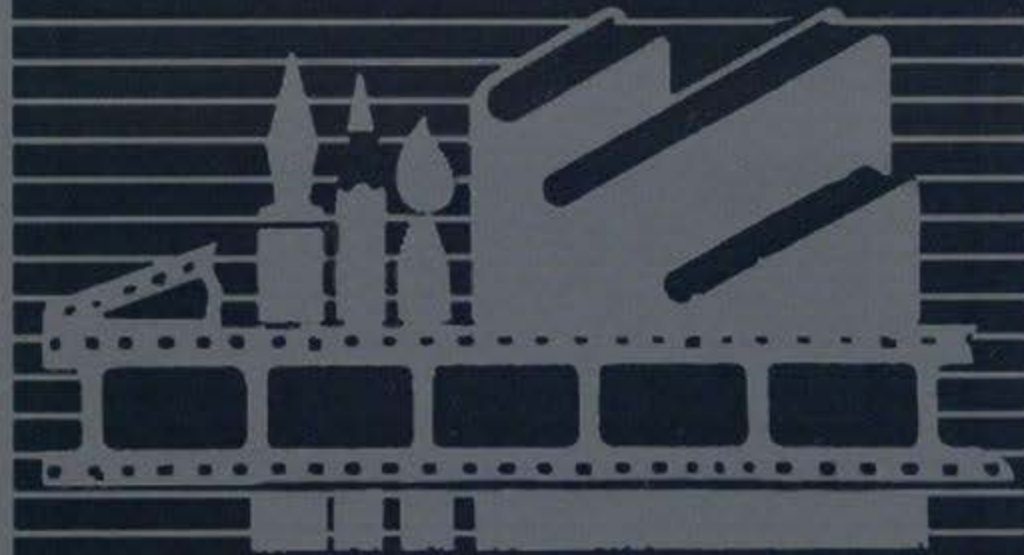

THE HONORABLE WILLIAM H. FRIST

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Harold P. Freeman, M.D.
Member, Board of Trustees

First elected to the U.S. Senate on November 8, 1994, Senator Frist was the only challenger to defeat a full-term incumbent and the first practicing physician elected to the Senate since 1928. A fourth generation Tennessean whose great, great grandfather was one of Chattanooga's 53 original settlers, Frist is the 54th U.S. Senator from Tennessee. On November 7, 2000, Bill Frist was elected to a second term in the United States Senate by the largest margin ever received by a candidate for statewide election in the history of Tennessee.

Born and raised in Nashville, Frist graduated in 1974 from Princeton University where he specialized in health care policy at the Woodrow Wilson School of Public and International Affairs. In 1978, he graduated with honors from Harvard Medical School and spent the next seven years in surgical training at Massachusetts General Hospital; Southampton General Hospital, Southampton, England; and Stanford University Medical Center. He is board certified in both general surgery and heart surgery.

In 1985, Frist joined the faculty at Vanderbilt University Medical Center where he founded and subsequently directed the multi-disciplinary Vanderbilt Transplant Center, which under his leadership became a nationally renowned center of multi-organ transplantation. A heart and lung surgeon, he performed over 150 heart and lung transplant procedures, including the first successful combined heart-lung transplant in the Southeast. Frist has written more than 100 articles, chapters, and abstracts on medical research

and five books: *Transplant*, which examines the social and ethical issues of transplantation and organ donation; *Grand Rounds in Transplantation: Tennessee Senators, 1911-2001: Portraits of Leadership in a Century of Change*; *When Every Moment Counts*, a family guide on bioterrorism; and *Good People Beget Good People*.

Frist rose rapidly through Senate leadership. In 2000, he was unanimously elected chairman of the National Republican Senatorial Committee (NRSC) for the 107th Congress and in December 2002 was unanimously elected Majority Leader of the U.S. Senate (108th Congress). Under his leadership as Chairman of the NRSC, for the first time in history, the party of the President won back majority control of the U.S. Senate in a midterm election. He assumed the position of Majority Leader having served fewer total years in the U.S. Congress than any previous leader.

He currently serves on the following committees: Finance; Rules; Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions (HELP). In the past, he has served on the following committees: Foreign Relations, Budget, Banking, Commerce, and Small Business. In 2001, he was named one of two Congressional representatives to the United Nations General Assembly.

Senator Frist and his wife, Karyn, have three sons: Harrison, Jonathan, and Bryan. They are Presbyterians. He enjoys flying (commercial, instrument, and multiengine pilot), running (seven marathons), medical mission trips to Africa, and writing.

DR. WILLIAM R. HARVEY

Dr. William R. Harvey has served with distinction as President of Hampton University since 1978. He has created a monumental legacy during his more than twenty-five year tenure – one of the longest tenures of any sitting president of a college or university in the country. Under his helm, Dr. Harvey has made countless contributions to the University, the state of Virginia, and the nation.

A native of Brewton, Alabama, he is a graduate of Southern Normal High School and Talladega College. After graduating from Talladega College, Dr. Harvey served three years on active duty with the United States Army. He is currently a Lieutenant Colonel in the Army Reserve. Dr. Harvey earned his doctorate in College Administration from Harvard University in 1972.

Since being named President, Dr. William R. Harvey has introduced innovations which have solidified Hampton University's stellar position among the nation's colleges and universities. His innovative leadership is reflected in the growth and quality of the University's student population, academic programs, physical facilities, and financial base. During his tenure, the student enrollment at Hampton University has increased from approximately 2,700 students to over 6,000, and the average SAT score of entering freshmen has increased approximately 300 points.

His commitment to expansion and innovation in academic programs has resulted in 76 new programs being implemented under his watch, including doctoral programs.

Dr. Harvey created a physical environment conducive to learning and living with the construction of 17 new buildings and the investment of over \$50,000,000 in the renovation of existing facilities.

An astute businessman, Dr. Harvey is 100% owner of the Pepsi-Cola Bottling Company of Houghton, Michigan. Entrepreneurially, he developed Hampton Harbor Project, a University-owned commercial venture which funds student scholarships. His fiscal leadership is evident in the financial growth and stability which Hampton has achieved during his twenty-five years as President. His business acumen is also utilized as a director of numerous corporate boards including: Fannie Mae, Trigon Blue Cross Blue Shield, Signet Bank, Newport News Shipbuilding, Wachovia Bank (Mid-Atlantic Region), Newport News Savings Bank, Pepsi Cola Bottling Company of Houghton, Michigan, National Merit Scholarship Corporation, and the Harvard Cooperative Society.

Dr. Harvey has long been active on the national scene as a result of his appointments to national boards by five presidents of the United States. He also currently serves as the Chairman of the Board of the National Association for Equal Opportunity in Higher Education (NAFEO, the HBCU Presidential Organization).

Dr. Harvey is married to the former Norma Baker of Martinsville, Virginia, and they have three children—Kelly Renee, William Christopher, and Leslie Denise—and one grandchild, Taylor.

MR. AUGUST WILSON

August Wilson is the author of *Jitney*, *Ma Rainey's Black Bottom*, *Fences*, *Joe Turner's Come and Gone*, *The Piano Lesson*, *Two Trains Running*, *Seven Guitars*, *King Hedley II*, and *Gem of the Ocean*. These works explore the heritage and experience of African-Americans, decade-by-decade, over the course of the twentieth century. His plays have been produced at regional theaters across the country and all over the world, as well as on Broadway.

In Spring 2003, Mr. Wilson made his professional stage debut in his one-man show, *How I Learned What I Learned*. Mr. Wilson's work has garnered many awards including Pulitzer Prizes for *Fences* (1987), and for *The Piano Lesson* (1990); a Tony Award for *Fences*; Great Britain's Olivier Award for *Jitney*, as well as seven New York Drama Critics Circle Awards for *Ma Rainey's Black Bottom*, *Fences*, *Joe Turner's Come and Gone*, *The Piano Lesson*, *Two Trains Running*, *Seven Guitars*, and *Jitney*. Additionally, the cast recording of *Ma Rainey's Black Bottom* received a 1985 Grammy Award, and Mr. Wilson received a 1995 Emmy Award nomination for his screenplay adaptation of

The Piano Lesson. Mr. Wilson's early works include the one-act plays: *The Janitor*, *Recycle*, *The Coldest Day of the Year*, *Malcolm X*, *The Homecoming*, and the musical satire, *Black Bart and the Sacred Hills*.

Mr. Wilson has received many fellowships and awards, including Rockefeller and Guggenheim Fellowships in Playwriting, the Whiting Writers Award, and the 2003 Heinz Award. He was also awarded a 1999 National Humanities Medal by the President of the United States, and has received numerous honorary degrees from colleges and universities, as well as the only high school diploma ever issued by the Carnegie Library of Pittsburgh. He is an alumnus of New Dramatists, a member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, and in 1995, he was inducted into the American Academy of Arts and Letters.

Mr. Wilson was born and raised in the Hill District of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and currently makes his home in Seattle, Washington. He is the father of two daughters, Sakina Ansari and Azula Carmen Wilson, and is married to costume designer, Constanza Romero.

Ann M. Fudge is Chairman and CEO of Young & Rubicam, Inc., a global network of preeminent companies that cover the full range of marketing communications. She also serves as Chairman and CEO of its largest division, Y&R Advertising. Y&R Companies also include Burson-Marsteller (public relations and public affairs), Wunderman (direct and database marketing), Landor Associates (brand consulting and creative design), Sudler & Hennessey (healthcare communications), among others. The appointments make Ms. Fudge one of the few African-American female CEOs in the United States.

Prior to Young & Rubicam, she served as President, Beverages, Desserts and Post Division—a \$5 billion unit of Kraft Foods. She served on Kraft's Management Committee and has managed many businesses including Maxwell House Coffee, Gevalia Kaffe, Kool Aid, Crystal Light, Post cereals, Jell-O desserts, and Altoids. When she joined Kraft, she made a name for herself by reviving older brands such as Log Cabin Syrup, Minute Rice, and Stove Top Stuffing. Before joining General Foods, she spent nine years at General Mills, Inc., where she began as a Marketing Assistant and rose to the level of Marketing Director. While there, she led the team that developed and introduced Honey Nut Cheerios.

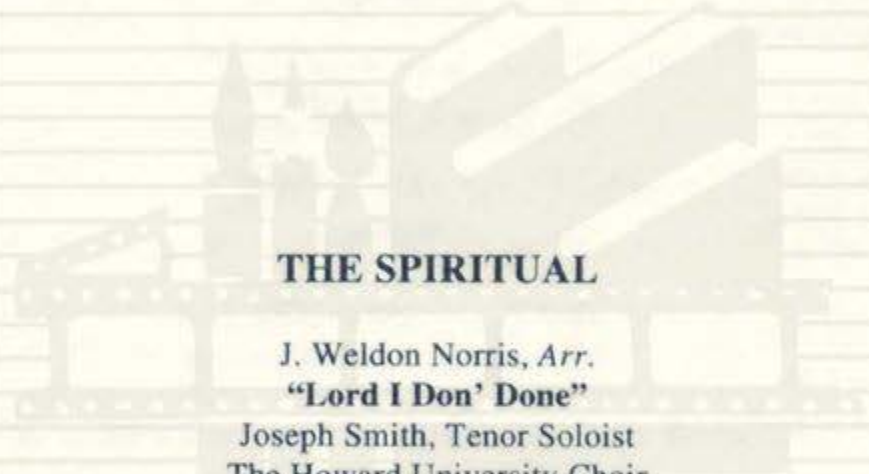
She serves on the Board of Directors of General Electric, Honeywell International, Marriott International, and the Federal Reserve Board. She also serves on the Board of Governors of the Boys and Girls Club of America, the Board of Directors of Catalyst, and is a trustee of the Brookings Institution. She is a member of The Committee of 200—a professional organization of prominent women entrepreneurs and corporate leaders, and The Council on Foreign Relations.

Active in community and civic affairs, Fudge has won Leadership Awards from the Minneapolis and New York City YWCAs. She also received the 1998 Alumni Achievement Award from Harvard Business School, and the 2000 Achievement Award from the Executive Leadership Council. She has been profiled in *Black Enterprise* magazine, *The New York Times*, and most recently, *BusinessWeek* magazine. She was also named by *Fortune* magazine as one of the 50 most powerful women in American business.

Mrs. Fudge received a B.A. in management from Simmons College and an MBA from Harvard University Graduate School of Business. Her husband, Richard, is an educational consultant; they have two grown sons, Richard, Jr. and Kevin, and three grandchildren.

THE CONFERRING OF DEGREES IN COURSE

The order of presentation of schools and colleges for the conferring of degrees is based on two factors—the year of establishment of the school or college and the distinction between graduate and undergraduate programs. The first six schools and colleges, beginning with the College of Arts and Sciences and ending with the College of Pharmacy, Nursing and Allied Health Sciences, were established between the years 1868 to 1997. Undergraduate programs are predominant in these six schools and colleges. The next five schools and colleges, beginning with the School of Divinity and ending with the School of Social Work, were established between the years 1868 and 1945. These schools and colleges offer professional graduate level programs. The last school listed, the Graduate School, was established in 1934 and offers graduate level programs exclusively.

THE MACE

The mace is the ceremonial symbol of the University and is carried by the University Marshal, Dr. Gary L. Harris, Professor of Engineering and Associate Director of the Materials Science Research Center of Excellence. One of the earliest visual images of the mace is on the front-side of the "Narmer Palette" of Ancient Egypt, an oval-shaped cosmetic palette inscribed with human and anthropomorphic figures. King Narmer is depicted on the palette as a mighty conqueror wielding a mace over a symbolic enemy. King Narmer, also known as King Menes or King Midas to the ancient Greeks, unified Upper and Lower Egypt *circa* 3100 B.C., ushering in the Great Pyramid Building Old Kingdom dynasties (c. 3000-2150 B.C.) of Imperial Egypt. At today's Convocation, the entry of the mace heralds the arrival of the academic procession.

THE BATON

The batons carried by the Marshals and Assistant Marshals of each school are being used to lead the academic procession of the respective schools and colleges into and out of the place of the ceremony. The batons are made of wood, painted blue, and tied with blue and white ribbons denoting the colors of Howard University.

THE ACADEMIC DRESS

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students used them to keep warm in medieval castles and halls of learning. From these practical origins, they have developed into the accepted garb which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves, pointed at the fingertips. These gowns may be worn either open or closed.

The master's degree gown is worn open, and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow.

Gowns for the doctor's degree are also worn open. They carry broad, velvet panels down the front, and three velvet bars on the full, round sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the degree.

Mortar board or caps worn with baccalaureate and master's gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

The blue Kente stole worn by the graduates was commissioned for the 1996 Commencement by the University and produced in Ghana. The stole depicts the Nkasewa pattern, which means eloquence, wisdom, and intelligence, and the symbol, Fi-Hankra, means safety, security, brotherhood, and solidarity.

Faculty members and guests in today's procession are robed in gowns and hoods which represent the institutions from which they have received degrees.

The hood gives color and real meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the colors of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains as follows: medicine, green; music, pink; nursing, apricot; pharmacy, olive green; public administration, peacock blue; science, gold yellow; social work, citron; theology, scarlet; architecture, blue violet; arts, letters, and humanities, white; business, drab; dentistry, lilac; education, light blue; engineering, orange; fine arts, brown;

THE HONORS MEDAL AND HONORS CORDS

The Honors Medal is worn by graduates who have achieved cumulative grade point averages making them eligible for the *cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, or *summa cum laude* honors. The Medal and Honors Cords symbolize that excellence is a hallmark of Howard University. The Medal was commissioned by Howard's President, H. Patrick Swygert, for the 1996 graduating class. Its round shape is enhanced with a gold finish, symbolizing the eternal and universal value of excellence. The center of the seal asserts the mission of the University—"Truth and Service." Encircling the seal is the phrase, "Honors Graduate and Leadership for America," which heralds excellence and the contributions of Howard University to the nation. The silver Honors Cord symbolizes the high academic rank of *magna cum laude*. The gold Honors Cord worn by graduates symbolizes the highest academic rank of *summa cum laude*.

THE TORCH PIN

The Torch Pin symbolizes that responsibility and excellence in leadership have been passed down and entrusted to the graduating seniors. It was commissioned by Howard's President, H. Patrick Swygert, for the 1997 graduating class. Its round shape is enhanced with a gold finish, symbolizing the eternal and universal value of excellence. Encircling the seal is the phrase, "Howard University—Bearers of the Torch," which emboldens graduates to go forth in the Howard tradition to serve as beacons of hope and light in their respective communities.

THE UNIVERSITY'S HONORARY DEGREE MEDALS

The University's Honorary Degree Medals worn today by our distinguished honorary degree recipients were formally presented to them at the annual "President's Dinner" held last evening in their honor at the Four Seasons Hotel in Washington, D.C. These medals commemorate the high esteem and honor bestowed upon them as honorary degree recipients at Howard University's 136th Commencement Convocation.

THE PRESIDENTIAL CHAIN OF OFFICE

The Presidential Chain of Office, worn by President Swygert, was presented to the University on the occasion of the Centennial Celebration in 1967 by the late Trustee Emeritus, Herman B Wells, and his late mother, Mrs. Granville Wells. The chain symbolizes the current and past holders of the office of President. The basic material of the chain is sterling silver, plated with hard gold. Both the University Seal and the Centennial Seal are appended to the chain.

LIFT EVERY VOICE AND SING

Where the white gleam of our bright star is cast.

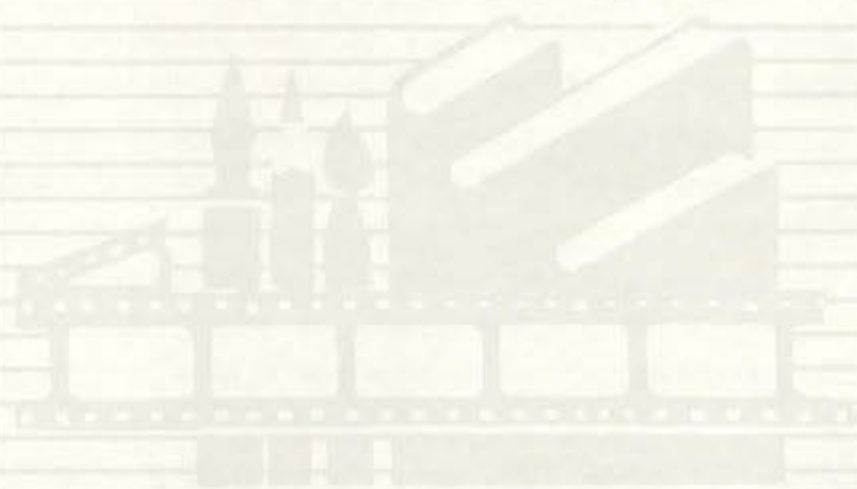
God of our weary years, God of our silent tears,
