For the Degree of Doctor of Science THE HONORABLE DR. JULIAN M. EARLS

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Mrs. Dianne Atkinson Hudson Member, Board of Trustees

Dr. Julian M. Earls is Executive-in-Residence at the Nance College of Business Administration at Cleveland State University in Cleveland, Ohio, and Co-Chair of the Science and Mathematics Education Policy Advisory Council (SAMEPAC) for the State of Ohio. As Co-Chair of SAMEPAC, Dr. Earls develops findings and makes policy recommendations for improvements in mathematics and science education in Ohio. In January 2006, he retired from the position of Director of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration's Glenn Research Center (GRC) in Cleveland, where he managed a budget in excess of \$800 million and a workforce of over 3500 employees.

A distinguished physicist and the holder of eight university degrees, he earned the Bachelor's Degree in Physics from Norfolk State University in Norfolk, Virginia; the Master's Degree in Radiation Biology from the University of Rochester School of Medicine and Dentistry in Rochester, New York, and the Doctorate Degree in Radiation Physics from the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, Michigan. He completed the equivalent of the Master's Degree in Environmental Health at the University of Michigan and is a graduate of the Program for Management Development at Harvard Business School. Honored by several universities with honorary doctorate degrees in a number of academic disciplines, Dr. Earls was inducted into the inaugural class of the National Black College Alumni Hall of Fame.

A gifted leader who has committed his energy and skills to making the world better through education, science, and service,

Dr. Earls has been a Distinguished Honors Visiting Professor at numerous universities; has received NASA medals for outstanding leadership, exceptional achievement, and distinguished service; received the Meritorious Executive Presidential Rank Award from President Clinton in 1999 and from President Bush in 2004; and was appointed to serve as a panelist for President Clinton's Initiative on Race at the 150th Anniversary Meeting of the American Association for the Advancement of Science. Most notably, Cleveland State awarded Dr. Earls its most prestigious non-academic recognition, The President's Medal.

Dr. Earls co-founded The Development Fund for Black Students, an organization that provides college scholarships to black students who attend Historically Black Colleges and Universities majoring in science, technology, engineering, or mathematics. He is recognized internationally for his exemplary oratorical skills and as an accomplished athlete, having run over 10,000 miles between 2000 and 2005, and completed 27 marathons, including the Boston Marathon. He was selected to carry the Olympic Torch on its route through Cleveland for the 2002 Olympic Games in Salt Lake City.

A member of Tau Boulé of Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity and a life member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity and the NAACP, Dr. Earls and his wife, Zenobia, have two sons: Julian, Jr., a neurologist who graduated from Howard University and the Case Western Reserve University Medical School in Cleveland, and Gregory, a filmmaker who graduated from Norfolk State University and the American Film Institute in Hollywood, California. They also have one granddaughter.

For the Degree of Doctor of Humane Letters DR. HENRY LOUIS GATES, JR.

The Candidate Will Be Presented by The Honorable Jack F. Kemp Member, Board of Trustees

Henry Louis Gates, Jr. is the Alphonse Fletcher University Professor and the Director of the W. E. B. Du Bois Institute for African and African-American Research at Harvard University. Acclaimed as one of the most powerful academic voices in America, Professor Gates is Editor-in-Chief of the Oxford African-American Studies Center, the first comprehensive scholarly online resource in the field of African-American Studies and Africana Studies

Using cutting-edge technology and some of the most popular media and corporate resources available to educate the public, in 2006 Professor Gates wrote and produced the PBS documentary called "African-American Lives," the first documentary series to employ genealogy and science to provide an understanding of African-American history. He also wrote and produced the documentaries, "Wonders of the African World" (2000) and "America Beyond the Color Line" (2004) for the British Broadcasting Corporation (BBC) and the Public Broadcasting Service (PBS), and authored the companion volumes to both series. Professor Gates recently completed the documentary, "Finding Oprah's Roots," which expands on one of the most popular portions of "African American Lives." Professor Gates is currently at work on a sequel to "African American Lives."

Highly recognized and lauded for his critical essays on black literature, Professor Gates is the author of numerous books, works

of literary criticism, articles, essays, and reviews, and has received countless awards and accolades for his work. During his lifetime, he has displayed an endless dedication to bringing African-American culture to the public, as well as co-authored, co-edited, and produced some of the most comprehensive African-American reference materials in the country.

His honors and grants include a MacArthur Foundation "genius grant" (1981), the George Polk Award for Social Commentary (1993), Time magazine's "25 Most Influential Americans" list (1997), a National Humanities Medal (1998), election to the American Academy of Arts and Letters (1999), the Jefferson Lecture (2002), and a Visiting Fellowship at the School of Social Science at the Institute for Advanced Study at Princeton (2003-2004). He has received 44 honorary degrees.

Born in Keyser, West Virginia, Professor Gates earned his M.A. and Ph.D. degrees in English literature from Clare College at the University of Cambridge, and his B.A. summa cum laude in English language and literature from Yale University. Before joining the faculty of Harvard in 1991, he taught at Yale, Cornell, and Duke Universities.

Professor Gates served as Chair of the Department of African and African-American Studies at Harvard from 1991 to 2006.

For the Degree of Doctor of Science DR. WALTER E. MASSEY

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Mr. Earl G. Graves, Sr. Member, Board of Trustees

Dr. Walter E. Massey, a man with extraordinary credentials in science and education, is the ninth president of Morehouse College, the nation's largest private four-year liberal arts college for men. He has served the historic institution with distinction and sterling leadership since 1995.

A nationally recognized scholar in physics, he is former director of the National Science Foundation, the government's lead agency for support of research and education in mathematics, science, and engineering, a position he was appointed to by former President George H.W. Bush. Dr. Massey also served as vice president for research and professor of physics at the University of Chicago, as director of the Argonne National Laboratory, dean of the College and professor of physics at Brown University, and as assistant professor of physics at the University of Illinois.

Immediately prior to Morehouse, Dr. Massey was provost and senior vice president for academic affairs at the University of California (UC), the second most senior position in the UC system, where he was responsible for academic and research planning and policy, budget planning and allocations, and programmatic oversight of the three national laboratories the University manages for the Department of Energy: Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory, Los Alamos National Laboratory and Lawrence Berkeley Laboratory.

After earning a Bachelor of Science Degree in physics and mathematics in 1958 from Morehouse, Dr. Massey received his master's and doctorate degrees in physics in 1966 from Washington University in St. Louis, MO. His scientific research has involved the study of quantum liquids and solids. His written work has also addressed science and math education, the role of science in a democratic society, and university-industry interactions and technology transfer in national and international settings.

An incomparably renowned educator and physicist, Dr. Massey is active with a range of organizations, serving as a past chair of the Secretary of Energy Advisory Board and currently serving his second term as a member of the President's Council of Advisors on Science and Technology, and having also served on this Council under the first President Bush. The recipient of more than 30 honorary degrees from institutions such as Yale University. Northwestern University, Amherst College, and the Ohio State University, Dr. Massey's premier leadership in education includes his service as a member of the Gates Millennium Scholars Advisory Council and the National Commission on Mathematics and Science Teaching for the 21st Century, and chairman of the Atlanta Committee for Public Education. In addition, he is active on several corporate and foundation boards, including the Mellon Foundation, Motorola, Inc., Bank of America Corporation, McDonald's Corporation, and BP p.l.c.

He is a Fellow and past president of the American Association for the Advancement of Science, a Fellow and past vice president of the American Physical Society, and a member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, the American Philosophical Society, and the Council on Foreign Relations.

Born in Hattiesburg, MS, he and his wife Shirley Anne have two adult sons and three grandchildren.

For the Degree of Doctor of Humanities MRS. IRENE SUE POLLIN

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Dr. Floretta Dukes McKenzie

Chairwoman Emerita, Board of Trustees

Irene Sue Pollin, a trailblazer in American health care, is the founder of Sister to Sister: Everyone Has a Heart Foundation, Inc., a 501 (c) (3) charitable organization whose aim is to increase awareness about women's heart disease and to encourage hearthealthy lifestyles among women by providing free cardiac screenings to women nationwide, conducting and publishing research on women and cardiac health, and providing women with the tools to make constructive changes for improved cardiac health.

Founded in 2000, Sister to Sister is the *only* national organization whose focus is screening women for heart disease, the number one killer of women. Mrs. Pollin embraced the chance to make a difference — a life-saving difference for the nation's 143 million women — when her organization held the first National Woman's Heart Day in Washington, DC — from a single screening that attracted more than 2,800 people to screenings in 16 cities that have attracted over 40,000 people. Over 100,000 women have attended Sister to Sister health fairs, and more than one third of them have been screened.

A psychotherapist and native of St. Louis, MO, who forged a dynamic reputation as a psychiatric social worker and lecturer in the Department of Psychiatry at Harvard University, Mrs. Pollin has established a number of other organizations and foundations to help women change behavior in various health-related areas. She created both the Medical Crisis Counseling Center at the

Washington Hospital Center and the NBA "Wives Save Lives" breast cancer awareness campaign.

Mrs. Pollin earned a Bachelor's Degree from American University and a Master of Social Work Degree from The Catholic University of America. Her illustrious career also includes over 30 years working directly with patients in the mental health field. In addition to her extensive work and contributions to the health care profession, Mrs. Pollin also co-owns the Washington Wizards basketball team and the Washington, DC-based Verizon Center.

The author of two books, Medical Crisis Counseling and Taking Charge: Overcoming the Challenges of Long-Term Illness, Mrs. Pollin has also written numerous articles on coping with chronic illness. She is frequently featured in magazine articles, on TV, and in radio programs, including "The Today Show," and "Nightline" with Ted Koppel. She is a past member of the Advisory Committee of the National Institutes of Health's Office of Research on Women's Health and the Board of the National Health Museum. She is a member of the Harvard School of Public Health Nutrition Roundtable, the Columbia Presbyterian Health Sciences Advisory Council, and the Howard University Women's Health Institute Advisory Committee.

She and her husband, Abe, are avid travelers and enjoy spending time with their children and grandchildren. They reside in Bethesda, Maryland.

For the Degree of Doctor of Humanities MS. OPRAH WINFREY

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Mr. Addison Barry Rand Chairman, Board of Trustees

Through the power of media, Oprah Winfrey has created an unparalleled connection with people around the world. As supervising producer and host of the top-rated, award-winning "The Oprah Winfrey Show," she has entertained, enlightened and uplifted millions of viewers for the past two decades. Her accomplishments as a global media leader and philanthropist have established her as one of the most respected and admired public figures today.

Ms. Winfrey began her broadcasting career at WVOL Radio in Nashville while still in high school. At the age of 19, she became the youngest person and the first African-American woman to anchor the news at Nashville's WTVF-TV. In 1984, she moved to Chicago to host WLS-TV's morning talk show, "AM Chicago," which became the number one local talk show—surpassing ratings for "Donahue"—just one month after she began. In less than a year, the show expanded to one hour and was renamed "The Oprah Winfrey Show," which entered national syndication in 1986, becoming the highest-rated talk show in television history. In 1988, she established Harpo Studios, making her the third woman in the American entertainment industry to own her own studio.

"The Oprah Winfrey Show" has remained the number one talk show for 20 consecutive seasons. Produced by her own production company, Harpo Productions, Inc., the show is seen by an estimated 48 million viewers a week in the United States and is broadcast internationally in 126 countries.

In April 2000, Ms. Winfrey and Hearst Magazines introduced "O, The Oprah Magazine," a monthly magazine that has become one of today's leading women's lifestyle publications. In 2004, "O at Home," a newsstand-only, quarterly shelter magazine designed to help readers create a home that reflects their personal style, made its debut.

Through her company's film division, Harpo Films, she has produced projects based on classic and contemporary literature that have garnered the highest industry honors for quality acting and production. Ms. Winfrey made her acting debut in 1985 as "Sofia" in Steven Spielberg's "The Color Purple," for which she received both Academy Award® and Golden Globe® nominations. Twenty years later, she made her Broadway debut as a producer

for the musical, "The Color Purple," which opened on December 1, 2005, at the Broadway Theatre in New York City.

Oprah has long believed that education is the door to freedom, offering a chance at a brighter future. Through her private charity, The Oprah Winfrey Foundation, she has awarded hundreds of grants to organizations that support the education and empowerment of women, children and families in the United States and around the world. Amongst her various philanthropic contributions, she has donated millions of dollars toward providing a better education for students who have merit but no means. She also created The Oprah Winfrey Scholars Program, which gives scholarships to students determined to use their education to give back to their communities in the United States and abroad.

During a December 2000 visit with Nelson Mandela, Ms. Winfrey pledged US\$10 million to build a school in South Africa. As that commitment broadened, she established The Oprah Winfrey Leadership Academy Foundation, to which she has contributed more than US\$40 million toward the creation of the Oprah Winfrey Leadership Academy for Girls - South Africa, which opened in January 2007. Located in a 28-building campus in Henley-on-Klip, the Leadership Academy is a state-of-the-art independent school that engenders high standards of academic achievement and service leadership for girls from all nine South African provinces who show outstanding promise despite their impoverished backgrounds and social circumstances. Her vision is that the Leadership Academy will help develop the future women leaders of South Africa.

In a 1997 episode of "The Oprah Winfrey Show," Oprah encouraged viewers to use their lives to make a difference in the lives of others, which led to the creation of the public charity, Oprah's Angel Network in 1998. Oprah's Angel Network has raised more than US\$50 million, with 100% of the donations funding charitable projects and grants across the globe and has helped establish 60 schools in 13 countries, create scholarships, support women's shelters, and build youth centers and homes—changing the future for people all over the world.

Ms. Winfrey was born on January 29, 1954, in Kosciusko, Mississippi, and resides in Chicago, Illinois.

THE CONFERRING OF DEGREES IN COURSE

The order of presentation of Schools and Colleges for the conferring of degrees is based on two factors—the year of establishment of the School or College and the distinction between graduate and undergraduate programs. The first six Schools and Colleges, beginning with the College of Arts and Sciences and ending with the College of Pharmacy, Nursing and Allied Health Sciences, were established between the years 1868 to 1997. Undergraduate programs are predominant in these six Schools and Colleges. The next five Schools and Colleges, beginning with the School of Divinity and ending with the School of Social Work, were established between the years 1868 and 1945. These Schools and Colleges offer professional graduate level programs. The last School listed, the Graduate School, was established in 1934 and offers graduate level programs exclusively.

THE MACE

The mace is the ceremonial symbol of the University and is carried by the University Marshal, Dr. Gary L. Harris, Professor of Engineering and Associate Director of the Materials Science Research Center of Excellence. One of the earliest visual images of the mace is on the front-side of the "Narmer Palette" of Ancient Egypt, an oval-shaped cosmetic palette inscribed with human and anthropomorphic figures. King Narmer is depicted on the palette as a mighty conqueror wielding a mace over a symbolic enemy. King Narmer, also known as King Menes or King Midas to the ancient Greeks, unified Upper and Lower Egypt circa 3100 B.C., ushering in the Great Pyramid Building Old Kingdom dynasties (c. 3000-2150 B.C.) of Imperial Egypt. At today's Convocation, the entry of the mace heralds the arrival of the academic procession.

THE BATON

The batons carried by the Marshals and Assistant Marshals of each School are being used to lead the academic procession of the respective Schools and Colleges into and out of the place of the ceremony. The batons are made of wood, painted blue, and tied with blue and white ribbons denoting the colors of Howard University.

THE ACADEMIC DRESS

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students used them to keep warm in medieval castles and halls of learning. From these practical origins, they have developed into the accepted garb which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves, pointed at the fingertips. These gowns may be worn either open or closed.

The Master's degree gown is worn open, and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow.

Gowns for the Doctorate degree are also worn open. They carry broad, velvet panels down the front, and three velvet bars on the full, round sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the degree.

Mortar board or caps worn with baccalaureate and master's gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

The blue Kente stole worn by the graduates was commissioned for the 1996 Commencement by the University and produced in Ghana. The stole depicts the Nkasewa pattern, which means eloquence, wisdom, and intelligence, and the symbol, Fi-Hankra, means safety, security, brotherhood, and solidarity.

Faculty members and guests in today's procession are robed in gowns and hoods which represent the institutions from which they have received degrees.

The hood gives color and real meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the colors of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains as follows: medicine, green; music, pink; nursing, apricot; pharmacy, olive green; public administration, peacock blue; science, gold yellow; social work, citron; theology, scarlet; architecture, blue violet; arts, letters, and humanities, white; business, drab; dentistry, lilac; education, light blue; engineering, orange; fine arts, brown; law, purple; and philosophy, dark blue.

THE HONORS MEDAL AND HONORS CORDS

The Honors Medal is worn by graduates who have achieved cumulative grade point averages making them eligible for the cum laude, magna cum laude, or summa cum laude honors. The Medal and Honors Cords symbolize that excellence is a hallmark of Howard University. The Medal was commissioned by Howard's President, H. Patrick Swygert, for the 1996 graduating class. Its round shape is enhanced with a gold finish, symbolizing the eternal and universal value of excellence. The center of the seal asserts the mission of the University –"Truth and Service." Encircling the seal is the phrase, "Honors Graduate and Leadership for America," which heralds excellence and the contributions of Howard University to the nation. The silver Honors Cord symbolizes the high academic rank of magna cum laude. The gold Honors Cord worn by graduates symbolizes the highest academic rank of summa cum laude.

THE TORCH PIN

The Torch Pin symbolizes that responsibility and excellence in leadership have been passed down and entrusted to the graduating seniors. It was commissioned by Howard's President, H. Patrick Swygert, for the 1997 graduating class. Its round shape is enhanced with a gold finish, symbolizing the eternal and universal value of excellence. Encircling the seal is the phrase, "Howard University – Bearers of the Torch," which emboldens graduates to go forth in the Howard tradition to serve as beacons of hope and light in their respective communities.

THE UNIVERSITY'S HONORARY DEGREE MEDALS

The University's Honorary Degree Medals worn today by our distinguished honorary degree recipients were formally presented to them at the annual "President's Dinner" held last evening in their honor at the Four Seasons Hotel in Washington, D.C. These medals commemorate the high esteem and honor bestowed upon them as honorary degree recipients at Howard University's 139th Commencement Convocation.

THE PRESIDENTIAL CHAIN OF OFFICE

The Presidential Chain of Office, worn by President Swygert, was presented to the University on the occasion of the Centennial Celebration in 1967 by the late Trustee Emeritus, Herman B Wells, and his late mother, Mrs. Granville Wells. The chain symbolizes the current and past holders of the office of President. The basic material of the chain is sterling silver, plated with hard gold. Both the University Seal and the Centennial Seal are appended to the chain.

We have come over a way that with tears has been watered, We have come, treading our path through the blood of the slaughtered;


