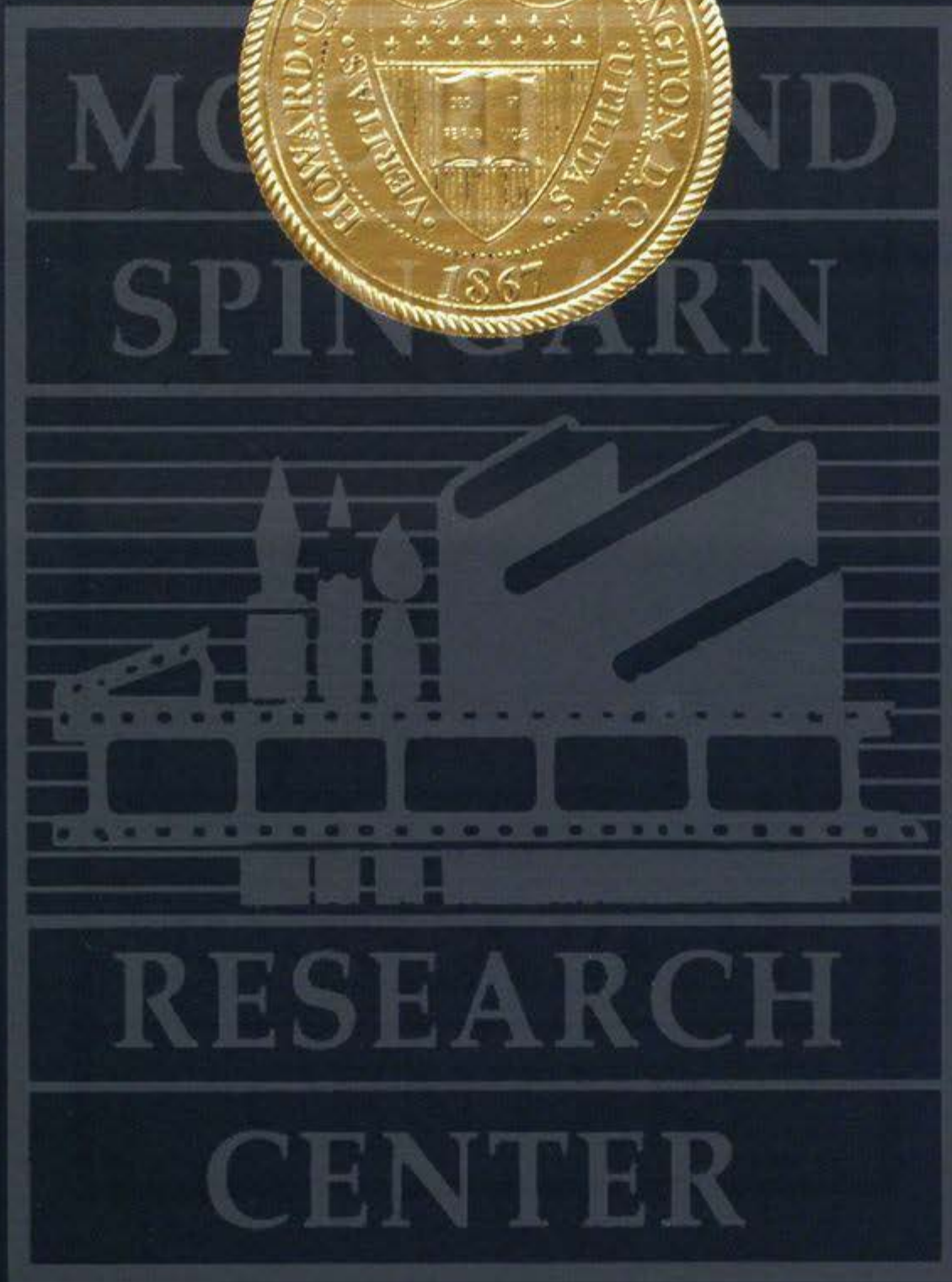

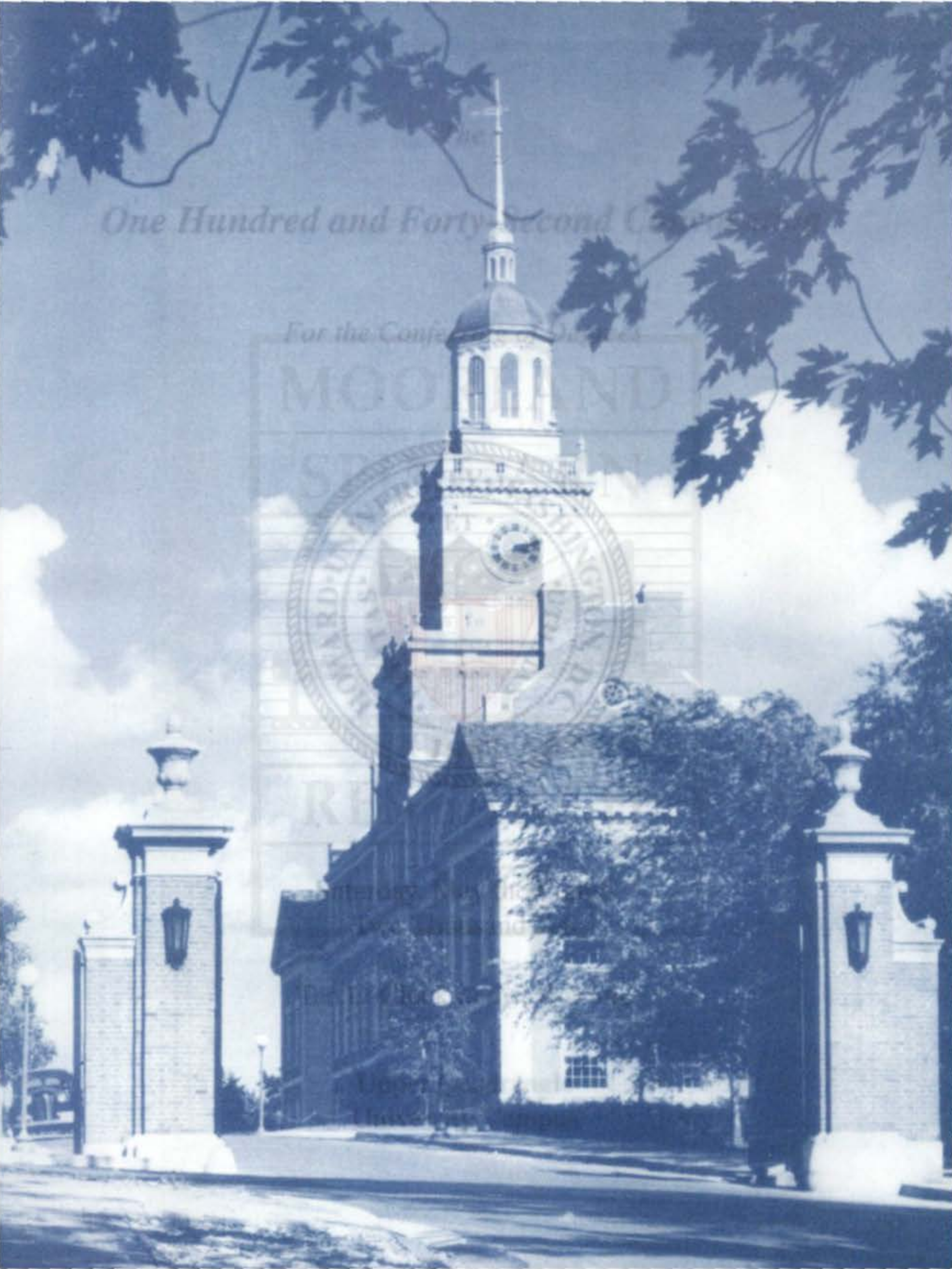

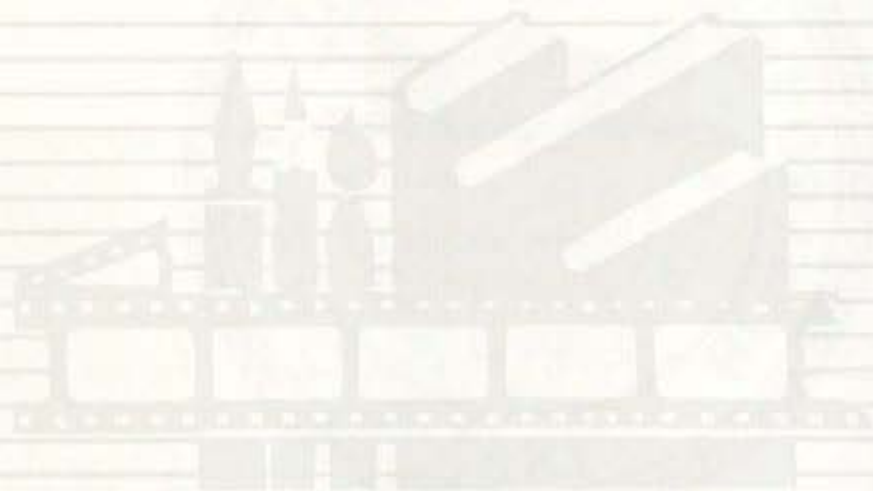

DR. DAVID C. DRISKELL

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Dr. Floretta Dukes McKenzie

Chairwoman Emerita, Board of Trustees

David C. Driskell is the Distinguished University Professor of Art, *Emeritus*, at the University of Maryland, College Park. Trained as a painter and art historian, Driskell works principally in collage and mixed media. Highly regarded as an artist, scholar and curator, he is cited as one of the world's leading authorities on the subject of African-American art. He is also the recipient of ten honorary doctoral degrees in art and has contributed significantly to scholarships in the history of art on the role of Black artists in America. He has authored seven books on the subject of African-American art, co-authored four other books, and published more than forty catalogs from exhibitions he has curated. His articles and essays on African-American art have appeared in major publications throughout the world.

His paintings and prints have been featured in numerous solo and group exhibitions in galleries and museums throughout the USA, including the Corcoran Gallery of Art, the Baltimore Museum of Art, the Oakland Museum, and the Whitney Museum of American Art, among others. He has exhibited internationally in England, Holland, South Africa, Poland, Brazil, Japan and Chili. His work has been reviewed in many publications, including *Art News*, *Arts and Antiques*, *Art Examiner*, *Art in America*, *The Washington Post*, *The Washington Times*, *The Detroit Free Press*, and *The New*

York Times. He has been the recipient of several foundation fellowships including the Harmon Foundation, three Rockefeller Foundation Fellowships, and the Danforth Foundation. He is represented by the DC Moore Gallery in New York City; Midtown Payson Gallery in Jupiter Island, Florida; Stella Jones Gallery in New Orleans; the Sherry Washington Gallery in Detroit, Michigan; and Noel Gallery in Charlotte, North Carolina.

Driskell is the recipient of the Distinguished Alumni Award in Art from Howard University in 1981 and from The Catholic University of America in 1996. In October 1997, he was awarded the President's Medal, the highest honor the University of Maryland bestows on a member of its faculty. He received the Presidential Medal from William Jefferson Clinton in December 2000 as a National Endowment for the Humanities recipient. Upon his retirement from teaching at the University of Maryland in 1998, The David C. Driskell Center for the Study of the African Diaspora was founded to promote his scholarship and service to the University.

Driskell received a Bachelor of Arts from Howard University and a Master of Fine Arts from The Catholic University of America. He and his wife Thelma reside in Hyattsville, Maryland; Falmouth, Maine; and New York City.

MR. HILL HARPER

Hill Harper is the author of three *New York Times* bestsellers: *Letters to a Young Brother*, *Letters to a Young Sister*, and *The Conversation*. *Letters to a Young Brother* was named "Best Book for Young Adults" by the American Library Association in 2007, and to date, his collective work has been recognized with three NAACP Image Awards: Outstanding Literary Work: Debut Author (2007) and Outstanding Literary Work: Youth/Teens (2007, 2008).

Hill currently stars on the hit television drama *CSI:NY* as Dr. Sheldon Hawkes, for which he has been recognized with three Image Awards for Best Actor in a Drama Series. *CSI* is the most successful television franchise in history. He has also appeared in numerous prime-time television shows and feature films, including *The Sopranos*, *ER*, *The Game*,

Fresh Prince of Bel-Air, *Lackawanna Blues*, *He Got Game*, *The Skulls*, *In Too Deep*, *The Nephew*, and *The Visit*. He is the founder of the Manifest Your Destiny Foundation, dedicated to empowering, encouraging, and inspiring underserved youth to succeed through mentorship, scholarship and grant programs.

Hill graduated *magna cum laude* with a B.A. from Brown University (and was valedictorian of his department) and *cum laude* with a J.D. from Harvard Law School. He also holds a Master's degree with honors from Harvard's Kennedy School of Government. Hill travels frequently as a motivational speaker and resonates with a wide range of audiences including youth, adults, and couples. Named one of *People Magazine's* Sexiest Men Alive, he lives in Los Angeles.

MS. MELLODY HOBSON

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Mr. Earl G. Graves, Sr.

Mellody Hobson is president of Ariel Investments, a Chicago-based money management firm that manages separate accounts for institutional clients and serves retirement plans and individual investors through its no-load mutual funds. As president, Ms. Hobson is responsible for firm-wide management and strategic planning, overseeing all operations outside of research and portfolio management. Additionally, she serves as chairman of the board of trustees for the mutual funds. She joined Ariel in 1991 after graduating from Princeton University where she received her degree from the Woodrow Wilson School of International Relations and Public Policy.

Ms. Hobson has become a nationally-recognized voice on financial literacy and investor education. Specifically, she is a regular financial contributor on "Good Morning America" and a featured guest on other ABC News programs, including "World News Tonight," "Nightline" and the 2009 special "Unbroke: What You Need to Know about Money" for which she served as executive producer and host. She is also the featured consumer finance expert on Tom Joyner's

"Money Mondays" radio program and a regular columnist for *Black Enterprise*. In addition, she is a spokesperson for both the 2009 Ariel/Hewitt study, "401(k) Plans in Living Color," and the Ariel/Schwab Black Investor Surveys.

Beyond her work in finance and investor education, Ms. Hobson is actively involved with a variety of civic and professional institutions. Her community outreach includes serving as a board member of the Chicago Public Library and its foundation, The Field Museum, The Chicago Public Education Fund, and the Sundance Institute. Additionally, she is on the board of governors of the Investment Company Institute and is a member of the SEC Investment Advisory Committee. She is a director of three public companies: DreamWorks Animation SKG, Inc., the Estee Lauder Companies Inc., and Starbucks Corporation. Ms. Hobson is also a member of the Economic Club of Chicago, the Commercial Club of Chicago, the Young President's Organization (YPO) and is a Henry Crown Fellow of the Aspen Institute.

MS. ROBIN ROBERTS

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Mrs. Sheila C. Johnson

Robin Roberts is anchor of ABC's "Good Morning America." Under her leadership, the broadcast has won three consecutive Emmy Awards for Outstanding Morning Program. When not traveling around the country or the world covering breaking news events, Roberts is at "GMA's" studio in Times Square conducting interviews with a diverse group of newsmakers. Her headline-making interviews include President Barack Obama, First Lady Michelle Obama, actor Sidney Poitier, basketball legend Kareem Abdul-Jabbar on his battle with leukemia, and Lisa Niemi on the loss of her beloved husband, Patrick Swayze.

She has also done extensive reporting around the globe. She traveled to the Middle East with former First Lady Laura Bush, who was on a mission to raise awareness about breast cancer in the Muslim world; to Africa with former President Bill Clinton for a first-hand look at the AIDS crisis in that part of the world; and to Mexico, where she scaled the Mayan Pyramids as part of "GMA's" "The New 7 Wonders of the World" series.

Roberts also broadcast live from inside the Centers for Disease Control in Atlanta in October 2009. It was the first time television cameras were permitted inside the CDC's special command center tracking the H1N1 "swine flu" virus. In November 2009, she hosted her first primetime special, "In the Spotlight with Robin Roberts: Bright Lights, Big Stars. All Access Nashville." The special took Roberts to Nashville, where she interviewed some of country music's biggest stars. She followed that with another primetime hour featuring an exclusive interview with Janet Jackson, the

performer's first since the death of her brother, Michael. In February 2009, she made her red carpet debut as co-host of the ABC Television Network's Oscar pre-show, reporting live from the 81st Annual Academy Awards with fashion expert Tim Gunn.

She played an active role in ABC News coverage of the 2008 presidential race. She interviewed the candidates and a wide-range of political newsmakers for "GMA"; traveled to Des Moines, Iowa, to moderate a town hall debate with then-candidate Hillary Clinton; and reported live from Washington, DC on Inauguration Day. She was the first journalist to interview President Barack Obama after he was sworn in as President. She also traveled the country by train with the "GMA" team as part of the network's ambitious "50 States in 50 Days" initiative in September 2008.

Roberts was diagnosed with breast cancer in June 2007. Her courageous and public battle has been recognized with awards and honors from organizations around the country, including The Susan G. Komen Foundation, The Congressional Families Cancer Prevention Program, and Gilda's Club, a non-profit organization founded by the late Joel Siegel.

In August 2005, Roberts found her personal and professional lives collide when Hurricane Katrina devastated the city of New Orleans and the Mississippi Gulf Coast – a part of the country Roberts called home for most of her life. In the days following, she traveled to the hurricane zone and reported live amid the devastation of the storm. She also launched "GMA" Gets It Done," a year-long effort to rebuild

her hometown of Pass Christian, Mississippi. She has returned to the Gulf Coast numerous times in the ensuing years to update viewers on how residents and businesses in the region are recovering post-Katrina.

Roberts was named co-anchor of "Good Morning America" in May 2005. She began contributing to the morning program in June 1995 and has worked in broadcasting for more than 20 years.

From 1990 to 2005, Roberts was a contributor to ESPN, where she was one of the network's most versatile commentators. Her assignments there included hosting "SportsCenter" and contributing to "NFL PrimeTime."

Prior to her work at ESPN, Roberts was a sports reporter and anchor at WAGA-TV in Atlanta. She was also a morning personality on WVEE-FM, Atlanta's top-rated morning show. From 1986 to 1988, she served as sports anchor and reporter for WSMV-TV in Nashville, TN where she won the "Nashville Scene" Sportscaster of the Year Award in 1987. She also worked as a sports anchor and reporter at WLOX-TV in Biloxi, MS from 1984 to 1986 and WDAM-TV in Hattiesburg, MS from 1983 to 1984.

Roberts began her broadcasting career while in college at WHMD/WFPR Radio in Hammond, LA, where she was the sports director. She also served as a special assignment sports reporter for KSLU-FM in 1982.

Robin Roberts graduated *cum laude* from Southeastern Louisiana State University in 1983 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in communications. She was a standout performer on the women's basketball team, ending her career as the school's all-time leading scorer (1,446 points) and rebounder (1,034). She is one of only three Lady Lions to score 1,000 career points and grab 1,000 career rebounds. During her senior season, she averaged a career high 15.2 points per game.

In 2001, Roberts was named a "Louisiana Legend" by Louisiana Public Broadcasting. She was also named to the 1999 FIFA Women's World Cup Advisory Board in January 1998, a board that includes Henry Kissinger, William Simon, Christine Whitman and Lamar Hunt, and in 1994, she was inducted in the Women's Institute on Sport and the Education Foundation's Hall of Fame. She is also active as a speaker for charity and civic functions. In March 2007, her first book, *From the Heart: 7 Rules to Live By*, was published by Hyperion. An updated version of the book, including an additional chapter on her battle with breast cancer, was released in 2008.

Roberts is a native of the Mississippi Gulf Coast and currently resides in New York City.

THE HONORABLE SONIA SOTOMAYOR

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Vernon E. Jordan, Jr., Esq.

Member, Board of Trustees

Sonia Sotomayor was nominated associate justice of the United States Supreme Court by President Barack Obama on May 26, 2009. After confirmation by the United States Senate, she assumed the role on August 8, 2009. She is the third woman to serve on the highest court in our land. Prior to the Supreme Court appointment, she served as a judge on the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit from 1998–2009. In 1991, President George H.W. Bush nominated her to the U.S. District Court, Southern District of New York, and she served in that role from 1992–1998. She litigated international commercial matters in New York City at Pavia & Harcourt, where she served as an associate and then partner from 1984–1992. Early in her career, she served as Assistant District Attorney in the New York County District Attorney's Office from 1979–1984.

Justice Sotomayor's professional affiliations include: Trustee, Princeton University; Member, American Philosophical Society; Member, American Bar Association; Member, Association of Judges of Hispanic Heritage; Member, Hispanic National Bar Association; Member, New York Women's Bar Association; Member, Puerto Rican Bar Association; Member, National Association of Women Judges; and Board of Directors, Puerto Rican Legal Defense and Education Fund, 1980–1992.

Justice Sotomayor was born in Bronx, New York, on June 25, 1954. She earned a B.A. in 1976 from Princeton University, graduating *summa cum laude* and receiving the university's highest academic honor. In 1979, she earned a J.D. from Yale Law School where she served as an editor of the Yale Law Journal.

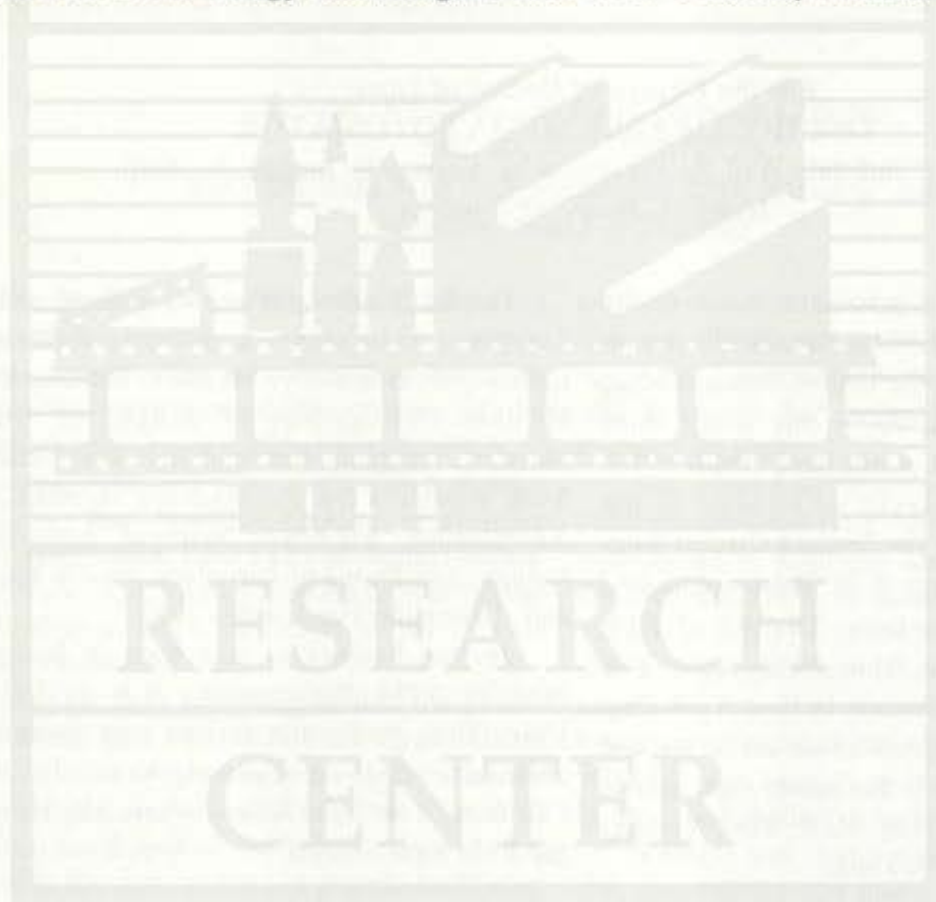
MR. HAROLD FORD, JR.

Harold Ford, Jr. served Tennessee in the United States Congress for ten years. Described by President Bill Clinton as "the walking, living embodiment of where America ought to go in the 21st century," Ford is now Chairman of the Democratic Leadership Council, a news analyst for NBC and MSNBC, and a visiting Professor at the NYU Robert F. Wagner Graduate School of Public Service.

During his five terms in the Congress, Ford's focus was results. Having served on both the Financial Services and Budget Committees, his passion for free enterprise and balanced budgets and confidence in American ingenuity to overcome any foe bolsters his belief that America's best days are in front of us. The challenge and opportunity to grow America's economy, strengthen our moral stature and standing in the world, make America safer and stronger through a revolution in clean energy technologies, and


modernize our military to better be able to fight the enemies of democracy and tolerance around the world continues to inspire his work today. He believes that government is most effective when it's working for the betterment of everyone. He is an overseer on the board of the International Rescue Committee (IRC) and a member of the Council on Foreign Relations. Ford lives and works in New York City with his wife.

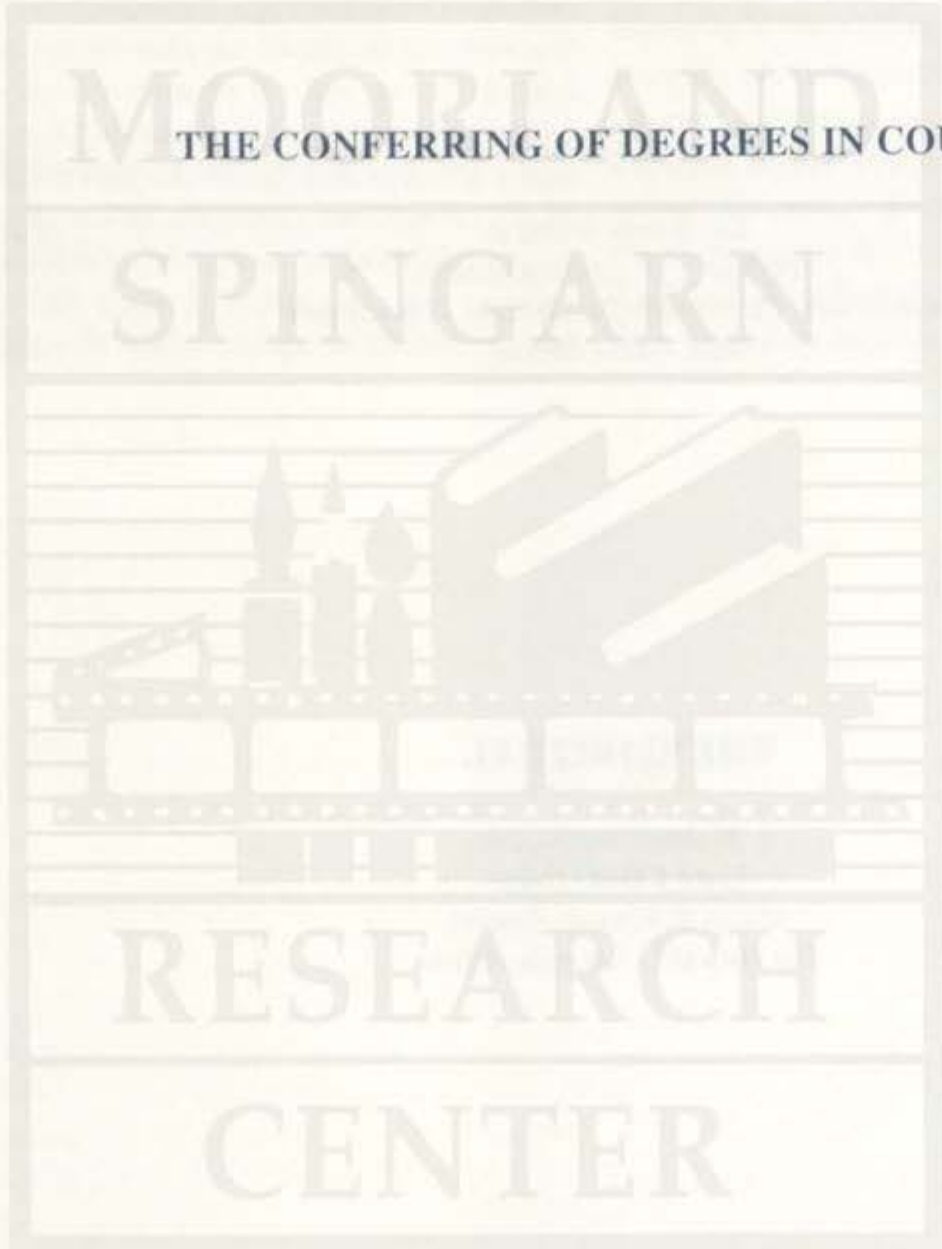

THE CONFERRING OF DEGREES IN COURSE

The order of presentation of Schools and Colleges for the conferring of degrees is based on two factors—the year of establishment of the School or College and the distinction between graduate and undergraduate programs. The first six Schools and Colleges, beginning with the College of Arts and Sciences and ending with the College of Pharmacy, Nursing and Allied Health Sciences, were established between the years 1868 to 1997. Undergraduate programs are predominant in these six Schools and Colleges. The next five Schools and Colleges, beginning with the School of Divinity and ending with the School of Social Work, were established between the years 1868 and 1945. These Schools and Colleges offer professional graduate level programs. The last School listed, the Graduate School, was established in 1934 and offers graduate-level programs exclusively.

THE MACE

The mace is the ceremonial symbol of the University and is carried by the University Marshal, Dr. Gary L. Harris, Professor of Engineering and Director of the Howard Nanoscale Science and Engineering Facility (HNF). One of the earliest visual images of the mace is the front-side of the "Narmer Palette" of Ancient Egypt, an oval-shaped cosmetic palette inscribed with human and anthropomorphic figures. King Narmer is depicted on the palette as a mighty conqueror wielding a mace over a symbolic enemy. King Narmer, also known as King Menes or King Midas to the ancient Greeks, unified Upper and Lower Egypt *circa* 3100 B.C., ushering in the great pyramid building of the old kingdom dynasties (c. 3000-2150 B.C.) of Imperial Egypt. At today's Convocation, the entry of the mace heralds the arrival of the academic procession.

THE BATON

The batons carried by the Marshals and Assistant Marshals of each School are being used to lead the academic procession of the respective Schools and Colleges into and out of the place of the ceremony. The batons are made of wood, painted blue, and tied with red, white and blue ribbons denoting the colors of Howard University.

THE ACADEMIC DRESS

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students used them to keep warm in medieval castles and halls of learning. From these practical origins, they have developed into the accepted garb which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves, pointed at the fingertips. These gowns may be worn either open or closed.

The Master's degree gown is worn open, and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow.

Gowns for the Doctorate degree are also worn open. They carry broad, velvet panels down the front, and three velvet bars on the full, round sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the degree.

Mortar board or caps worn with baccalaureate and Master's gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

The blue Kente stole worn by the graduates was commissioned for the 1996 Commencement by the University and produced in Ghana. The stole depicts the Nkasewa pattern, which means eloquence, wisdom, and intelligence, and the symbol, Fi-Hankra, means safety, security, brotherhood, and solidarity.

Faculty members and guests in today's procession are robed in gowns and hoods which represent the institutions from which they have received degrees.

The hood gives color and real meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the colors of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains as follows: medicine, green; music, pink; nursing, apricot; pharmacy, olive green; public administration, peacock blue; science, gold yellow; social work, citron; theology, scarlet; architecture, blue violet; arts, letters, and humanities, white; business, drab; dentistry, lilac; education, light blue; engineering, orange; fine arts, brown; law, purple; and philosophy, dark blue.

THE HONORS MEDAL AND HONORS CORDS

The Honors Medal is worn by graduates who have achieved cumulative grade point averages making them eligible for the *cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, or *summa cum laude* honors. The Medal and Honors Cords symbolize that excellence is a hallmark of Howard University. The Medal was commissioned by Howard's President Emeritus, H. Patrick Swygert, for the 1996 graduating class. Its round shape is enhanced with a gold finish, symbolizing the eternal and universal value of excellence. The center of the seal asserts the mission of the University – "Truth and Service." Encircling the seal is the phrase, "Honors Graduate and Leadership for America," which heralds excellence and the contributions of Howard University to the nation. The silver Honors Cord symbolizes the high academic rank of *magna cum laude*. The gold Honors Cord worn by graduates symbolizes the highest academic rank of *summa cum laude*.

THE TORCH PIN

The Torch Pin symbolizes that responsibility and excellence in leadership have been passed down and entrusted to the graduating seniors. It was commissioned by Howard's President Emeritus, H. Patrick Swygert, for the 1997 graduating class. Its round shape is enhanced with a gold finish, symbolizing the eternal and universal value of excellence. Encircling the seal is the phrase, "Howard University – Bearers of the Torch," which emboldens graduates to go forth in the Howard tradition to serve as beacons of hope and light in their respective communities.

THE UNIVERSITY'S HONORARY DEGREE MEDALS

The University's Honorary Degree Medals worn today by our distinguished honorary degree recipients were formally presented to them at the annual "President's Dinner" held last evening in their honor at the Four Seasons Hotel in Washington, D.C. These medals commemorate the high esteem and honor bestowed upon them as honorary degree recipients at Howard University's 142nd Commencement Convocation.

THE PRESIDENTIAL CHAIN OF OFFICE

The Presidential Chain of Office, worn by President Ribeau, was presented to the University on the occasion of the Centennial Celebration in 1967 by the late Trustee Emeritus, Herman B Wells, and his late mother, Mrs. Granville Wells. The chain symbolizes the current and past holders of the office of President. The basic material of the chain is sterling silver, plated with hard gold. Both the University Seal and the Centennial Seal are appended to the chain.
