MR. JOHN LEGEND

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Renee Higginbotham-Brooks, Esq. Vice Chairwoman, Board of Trustees

Recording artist, concert performer and philanthropist, John Legend has won nine Grammy Awards and was named one of Time Magazine's 100 most influential people. He launched his career as a session player and vocalist, contributing to best-selling recordings by Lauryn Hill, Alicia Keys, Jay-Z and Kanye West before recording his own unbroken chain of Top 10 albums - Get Lifted (2004), Once Again (2006), and Evolver (2008) - each of them reaching #1 on the Billboard R&B/Hip Hop charts.

Legend's debut album, Get Lifted, earned eight Grammy nominations; won Best New Artist, Best R&B album, and Best Male R&B Vocal Performance for Ordinary People while selling more than three million copies worldwide. His follow-up album, Once Again, earned a RIAA platinum certification and a Grammy Award for "Heaven," which also won Best Male R&B Vocal Performance. In 2008, he released Evolver, his third Top 10 album and embarked on an extensive world tour with his ten-piece band.

Most recently, Legend and the band, The Roots, released Wake Up! (2010), a compilation of music from the 60's and 70's, all with an underlying theme of awareness, engagement and social consciousness which won two Grammy Awards for Best R&B Album and Best Traditional R&B Vocal Performance. The album is highlighted with tracks like "Little Ghetto Boy" by Donny Hathaway and Baby Huey and the Babysitters' "Hard Times." Wake Up! also includes Legend's original composition "Shine," which won a Grammy Award for Best R&B Song and is featured in Oscar Award winner Davis Guggenheim's domestic education reform documentary Waiting for

Throughout his career, he has worked to make a difference in the lives of others. In 2007, he launched the Show Me Campaign (ShowMeCampaign.org), an initiative that uses education to break the cycle of poverty. He was awarded the 2010 BET Humanitarian of the Year Award, the CARE Humanitarian Award for Global

Change in June 2009, and received the 2009 Bishop John T. Walker Distinguished Humanitarian Service Award from Africare

He sits on the Boards of The Education Equality Project, Teach for America, Stand for Children and the Harlem Village Academies, and co-chairs the Harlem Village Academies' National Leadership Board. He is the national spokesperson for Management Leadership for Tomorrow, a non-profit organization that assists the next generation of minority business leaders. In 2007, he was named spokesman for GQ Magazine's "Gentlemen's Fund," an initiative to raise support and awareness for five cornerstones essential to men: opportunity, health, education, environment, and justice. He is also a member of the Board of Directors of PopTech, a unique innovation network with a mission to accelerate the positive impact of world-changing people, projects

Legend stars in The People Speak, a film about social change in the United States and is a frequent guest on political talk shows including Real Time with Bill Maher, Anderson Cooper 360° and MSNBC's Morning Joe. He supported President Barack Obama's presidential campaign, including appearances at benefit rallies and concerts; the premiere of a new song, "If You're Out There," at the 2008 Democratic National Convention; and a live Inauguration Day performance.

He partners with Samsung to support education initiatives, with a special focus on science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM). In response to devastation surrounding Hurricane Katrina, he worked with Tide laundry detergent to address the needs of families in hard-hit areas. He partners with Product (RED), which benefits the Global Fund for AIDS, TB and Malaria.

In his Time 100 tribute to Legend, Quincy Jones explained "He is a genius...and we've seen only the tip of the iceberg. For all that he has already achieved in his career, it is going to be fun watching where he goes from here."

first Eisenhower campaign. As a very young teenager, he became enthralled with the historic rivalry of John F. Kennedy and Richard Nixon. It was a time of big downtown rallies and ticker tape parades buttons:

Hardly a decade later, he became engaged in American politics professionally. Back home from the Peace Corps in Africa, he was working in the U.S. Senate. Later he began his tour in the White House as a presidential speechwriter, followed by his front-row seat as top aide to the legendary Speaker of the House, Thomas P. "Tip" O'Neill, Jr.

In the late 1980s, Matthews switched to full-time journalism, serving as Washington Bureau Chief for the San Francisco Examiner. In this capacity, he covered some of the great historic events of the late 20th century, including the fall of the Berlin Wall and the first allraces election in South Africa.

He began his career on television in 1994 as host of a two-hour nightly program on the NBC-owned America's Talking network. Three years later, he launched Hardball, now on MSNBC, which was the title of his best-selling handbook on real-life politics published

Chris Matthews has been following American politics since the in 1988. He has been on the air every weekday night since. In 2002, NBC inaugurated Sunday morning's The Chris Matthews Show.

In all the years Matthews has been involved in the country's public life, he's kept an abiding faith in electoral politics, his quadrennial on Wall Street, when supporters were boater hats and bright campaign hope that the American people will make the best judgment on who should lead. He has kept that faith through war and peace, good times and bad, through great leaders and not-so-great. He has never lost his vigorous love of democracy and how it can serve to make this country, through all its challenges, a more perfect union.

He is the author of five best-selling books: Hardball: How Politics is Played, Told by One Who Knows the Game; Kennedy & Nixon: The Rivalry That Shaped Postwar America; Now, Let Me Tell You What I Really Think; American: Beyond Our Grandest Notions; and Life's a Campaign.

His most recent best-selling book, Jack Kennedy: Elusive Hero, brings to bear everything he has learned through a lifetime of watching American politics in action, as well as all the love he has for this country, its history and its hopes.

He is married to Kathleen Matthews, Executive Vice President of Marriott International.

JULIEANNA L. RICHARDSON, ESQ.

Julieanna L. Richardson created a unique path to founding and heading up the largest national collection effort of African American video oral histories on record. With a diverse background in the humanities, corporate law, television production and the cable television industries, she combined her various work experiences and her passion for American studies and history to conceptualize, found and build The History Makers, a national, 501(c)(3) non-profit educational institution headquartered in Chicago with regional offices in Atlanta, Georgia and the Washington, D.C. area, The HistoryMakers organization is committed to preserving, developing and providing easy access to an internationally recognized, archival collection of thousands of African American video oral histories. Richardson graduated magna cum laude with a double major in Theatre Arts and American Studies from Brandeis University in 1976. It was during her studies at Brandeis that she first experienced the power of oral history while conducting independent research on the Harlem Renaissance and poet and author Langston Hughes.

Richardson received her J.D. degree in 1980 from Harvard Law School and began her career as a corporate lawyer at the Chicago-based law firm of Jenner & Block prior to serving in the early 1980s as both the Assistant Cable Administrator and the Cable Administrator for the City of Chicago's Office of Cable Communications. There she established the Chicago Cable Commission, the City's regulatory body. In 1986, she founded *Shop Chicago*, one of two regionally-based home shopping channels in the United States. In 1990, she started her own production company, SCTN Teleproductions, which

for eight years managed three local cable channels for TCI, then the nation's largest cable operator, and served as the local production arm for C-SPAN.

Over the past twelve years under her leadership, The HistoryMakers has grown into a vibrant national initiative with a digital archive and users in 51 countries. Its signature programs include The HistoryMakers Education Institute, Back to School With The HistoryMakers, The HistoryMakers Speakers Bureau, and The HistoryMakers An Evening With...PBS-TV celebrity interview series that have featured such notables as Harry Belafonte, Diahann Carroll, Dionne Warwick, General Colin Powell, Nikki Giovanni, Earl Graves, Sr., Smokey Robinson, Della Reese, Ossie Davis & Ruby Dee, B.B. King, Russell Simmons, Denyce Graves, Quincy Jones, Eartha Kitt, Henry "Skip" Gates, John Rogers, Jr. and Valerie Simpson. Richardson serves as the show's Executive Producer. In 2009, she launched Science Makers, a National Science Foundation initiative to interview 180 of the nation's top African American scientists. Similar initiatives are underway for African American leaders in the media and in the military.

Richardson has been the recipient of numerous honors and awards including the YWCA Outstanding Achievement Award, the University of Illinois' Great Cities Institute Vernon Jarrett Fellowship (2007), and Chicago Magazine's Chicagoan of the Year Award (2007). In 2002, she served on the board of The Henry Hampton Collection, Washington University. She currently sits on the Honors Council of Lawyers for the Creative Arts and was appointed in 2011 to the Comcast NBC Universal African American Diversity Council.

For the Degree of Doctor of Letters MS, ISABEL WILKERSON

Isabel Wilkerson, the Pulitzer Prize-winning journalist, is author of *The New York Times*' bestseller, *The Warmth of Other Suns: The Epic Story of America's Great Migration*. The book brings to life one of the greatest underreported stories of the 20th Century, a migration that reshaped modern America. Wilkerson interviewed more than 1,200 people, unearthed archival research and gathered the voices of the famous and the unknown to tell the epic story of the redistribution of an entire people. She chose to tell the story through three unforgettable protagonists as they make the decision of their lives.

Warmth won the 2010 National Book Critics Circle Award for Nonfiction, the 2011 Anisfield-Wolf Award for Nonfiction, the 2011 Hillman Book Prize, the 2011 Lynton History Prize from Harvard and Columbia Universities, the 2011 Heartland Prize for Nonfiction, the Stephen Ambrose Oral History Prize, the Independent Literary Award for Nonfiction, the Horace Mann Bond Book Award from Harvard University, the NAACP Image Award for best literary debut and was shortlisted for the 2011 Pen-Galbraith Literary Award for Nonfiction and the Dayton Literary Peace Prize.

Millerson won the Philizer Prize for her work as Chicago Bureau Chief of *The New York Times* in 1994, making her the first African American woman in the history of American journalism to win a Pulitzer Prize and the first African-American to win for individual reporting. Wilkerson has also won the George Polk Award, a John Simon Guggenheim Fellowship, and was named Journalist of the Year by the National Association of Black Journalists.

Wilkerson has spoken on the topics of migration, social justice, urban affairs and 20th Century history at universities across the country and in Europe. She has appeared on national programs such as CBS's 60 Minutes, PBS's Charlie Rose, NPR's Fresh Air with Terry Gross, NBC's Nightly News, MSNBC, C-SPAN, and others.

She has lectured on narrative writing at the Nieman Foundation at Harvard University and has served as Ferris Professor of Journalism at Princeton University and as the James M. Cox, Jr. Professor at Emory University. She is currently Professor of Journalism and Director of Narrative Nonfiction at Boston University. During the Great Migration, her parents journeyed from Georgia and southern Virginia to Washington, D.C., where she was born and reared.

In her years of research, Wilkerson raced against the clock to reach as many original migrants as she could before it was too late. The result is what the judges of the Lynton History Prize, conferred by Harvard and Columbia Universities, described thusly:

"Wilkerson has created a brilliant and innovative paradox: the intimate opin: At its smallest scale; this towering work rests on a trio of unforgettable biographies, lives as humble as they were heroic... In different decades and for different reasons, they headed north and west, along with millions of fellow travelers. . . In powerful, lyrical prose that combines the historian's rigor with the novelist's empathy, Wilkerson's book changes our understanding of the Great Migration and indeed of the modern United States."

THE HONORABLE ARNE DUNCAN

Will Be Introduced by Mr. Addison Barry Rand Chairman, Board of Trustees

The Honorable Arne Duncan was nominated to be Secretary of Education by President Barack Obama and was confirmed by the U.S. Senate on January 20, 2009.

In his confirmation hearings, Duncan called education "the most pressing issue facing America," adding that "preparing young people for success in life is not just a moral obligation of society" but also an "economic imperative." "Education is also the civil rights issue of our generation," he said, "the only sure path out of poverty and the only way to achieve a more equal and just society." Duncan expressed his commitment to work under the leadership of President Obama and with all those involved in education "to enhance education in America, to lift our children and families out of poverty, to help our students learn to contribute to the civility of our great American democracy, and to strengthen our economy by producing a workforce that can make us as competitive as possible."

Prior to his appointment as Secretary of Education, he served as the chief executive officer of the Chicago Public Schools, a position to which he was appointed by Mayor Richard M. Daley, from June 2001 through December 2008, becoming the longest-serving big-city education superintendent in the country.

As CEO, Duncan's mandate was to raise education standards and performance, improve teacher and principal quality, and increase learning options. In seven and a half years, he united education reformers, teachers, principals and business stakeholders behind an aggressive education reform agenda that included opening over 100 new schools, expanding after-school and summer learning programs, closing down underperforming schools, increasing early childhood and college access, dramatically boosting the caliber of teachers, and building public-private partnerships around a variety of education initiatives.

Among his most significant accomplishments during his tenure as CEO, an all-time high of 66.7 percent of the district's elementary school students met or exceeded state reading standards, and their math scores also reached a record high, with 70.6 percent meeting or exceeding the state's standards. At high schools, Chicago Public Schools (CPS) students posted gains on the ACT at three times the rate of national gains and nearly twice that of the state. Also, the number of CPS high school students taking Advanced Placement courses tripled and the number of students passing AP classes more than doubled. Duncan increased graduation rates and boosted the total number of college scholarships secured by CPS students to \$157 million.

A study released in June 2008 by the Illinois Education Research Council lauded the Chicago Public Schools for its efforts to bring top teaching talent into the city's classrooms, where the number of teachers applying for positions almost tripled since 2003, from about 8,600 to more than 21,000, or about 10 applicants per teaching position.

The number of teachers achieving National Board Certification—the highest education credential available to teachers—increased from 11 in 1999 to 1,191 in 2008, making Chicago the fastest-growing urban district in this area of achievement.

Prior to joining the Chicago Public Schools, Duncan ran the non-profit education foundation Ariel Education Initiative (1992-1998), which helped fund a college education for a class of innercity children under the I Have A Dream program. He was part of a team that later started a new public elementary school built around a financial literacy curriculum, the Ariel Community Academy, which today ranks among the top elementary schools in Chicago.

Duncan formerly served on the boards of the Ariel Education Initiative, Chicago Cares, the Children's Center, the Golden Apple Foundation, the Illinois Council Against Handgun Violence, Jobs for America's Graduates, Junior Achievement, the Dean's Advisory Board of the Kellogg School of Management, the National Association of Basketball Coaches' Foundation, Renaissance Schools Fund, Scholarship Chicago and the South Side YMCA. He also served on the Board of Overseers for Harvard College and the Visiting Committees for Harvard University's Graduate School of Education and the University of Chicago's School of Social Service Administration.

In 2008, he was honored by the Civic Federation of Chicago and the Anti-Defamation League. In 2007, he received the Niagara Foundation's Education Award, the National Foundation for Teaching Entrepreneurship Enterprising Educator Award, and the University High School Distinguished Alumni Award. He also received honorary degrees from the Illinois Institute of Technology, Lake Forest College and National-Louis University. In 2006, the City Club of Chicago named him Citizen of the Year. He was a member of the Aspen Institute's Henry Crown Fellowship Program, Class of 2002, and a fellow in the Leadership Greater Chicago's Class of 1995.

From 1987 to 1991, he played professional basketball in Australia, where he also worked with children who were wards of the state.

Duncan graduated magna cum laude from Harvard University in 1987, majoring in sociology. He was co-captain of Harvard's basketball team and was named a first team Academic All-American. He credits basketball with his team-oriented and highly disciplined work ethic.

His late father was a professor at the University of Chicago and his mother has run a South Side tutoring program for inner-city children since 1961. As a student in Chicago, Duncan spent afternoons in his mother's tutoring program and also worked there during a year off from college. He credits this experience with shaping his understanding of the challenges of urban education.

Duncan is married to Karen Duncan and they have two children, daughter Claire and son Ryan who attend a public elementary school in Arlington, Va.

THE CONFERRING OF DEGREES IN COURSE

The order of presentation of Schools and Colleges for the conferring of degrees is based on two factors—the year of establishment of the School or College and the distinction between graduate and undergraduate programs. The first seven Schools and Colleges, beginning with the College of Arts and Sciences and ending with the College of Nursing and Allied Health Sciences, were established between the years 1868 to 1997. Undergraduate programs are predominant in these seven Schools and Colleges. The next five Schools and Colleges, beginning with the School of Divinity and ending with the School of Social Work, were established between the years 1868 and 1945. These Schools and Colleges offer professional graduate level programs. The last School listed, the Graduate School, was established in 1934 and offers graduate-level programs exclusively.



THE MACE

The mace is the ceremonial symbol of the University and is carried by the University Marshal, Dr. Gary L. Harris, Professor of Engineering and Director of the Howard Nanoscale Science and Engineering Facility (HNF). One of the earliest visual images of the mace is the front-side of the "Narmer Palette" of Ancient Egypt, an oval-shaped cosmetic palette inscribed with human and anthropomorphic figures. King Narmer is depicted on the palette as a mighty conqueror wielding a mace over a symbolic enemy. King Narmer, also known as King Menes or King Midas to the ancient Greeks, unified Upper and Lower Egypt *circa* 3100 B.C., ushering in the great pyramid building of the old kingdom dynastics (c. 3000-2150 B.C.) of Imperial Egypt. At today's Convocation, the entry of the mace heralds the arrival of the academic procession.

THE BATON

The batons carried by the Marshals and Assistant Marshals of each School are being used to lead the academic procession of the respective Schools and Colleges into and out of the place of the ceremony. The batons are made of wood, painted blue, and tied with red, white and blue ribbons denoting the colors of Howard University.

THE ACADEMIC DRESS

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students used them to keep warm in medieval castles and halls of learning. From these practical origins, they have developed into the accepted garb which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves, pointed at the fingertips. These gowns may be worn either open or closed.

The Master's degree gown is worn open, and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow. Gowns for the Doctorate degree are also worn open. They carry broad, velvet panels down the front, and three velvet bars on the full, round sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the degree.

Mortar board or caps worn with baccalaureate and Master's gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

The blue Kente stole worn by the graduates was commissioned for the 1996 Commencement by the University and produced in Ghana. The stole depicts the Nkasewa pattern, which means eloquence, wisdom, and intelligence, and the symbol, Fi-Hankra, means safety, security, brotherhood, and solidarity.

Faculty members and guests in today's procession are robed in gowns and hoods which represent the institutions from which they have received degrees.

The hood gives color and real meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the colors of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains as follows: medicine, green; music, pink; nursing, apricot; pharmacy, olive green; public administration, peacock blue; science, gold yellow; social work, citron; theology, scarlet; architecture, blue violet; arts, letters, and humanities, white; business, drab; dentistry, lilac; education, light blue; engineering, orange; fine arts, brown; law, purple; and philosophy, dark blue.

THE HONORS MEDAL AND HONORS CORDS

The Honors Medal is worn by graduates who have achieved cumulative grade point averages making them eligible for the cum laude, magna cum laude, or summa cum laude honors. The Medal and Honors Cords symbolize that excellence is a hallmark of Howard University. The Medal was commissioned by Howard's President Emeritus, H. Patrick Swygert, for the 1996 graduating class. Its round shape is enhanced with a gold finish, symbolizing the eternal and universal value of excellence. The center of the seal asserts the mission of the University—"Truth and Service." Encircling the seal is the phrase, "Honors Graduate and Leadership for America," which heralds excellence and the contributions of Howard University to the nation. The silver Honors Cord symbolizes the high academic rank of magna cum laude. The gold Honors Cord worn by graduates symbolizes the highest academic rank of summa cum laude.

THE TORCH PIN

The Torch Pin symbolizes that responsibility and excellence in leadership have been passed down and entrusted to the graduating seniors. It was commissioned by Howard's President Emeritus, H. Patrick Swygert, for the 1997 graduating class. Its round shape is enhanced with a gold finish, symbolizing the eternal and universal value of excellence. Encircling the seal is the phrase, "Howard University – Bearers of the Torch," which emboldens graduates to go forth in the Howard tradition to serve as beacons of hope and light in their respective communities.

THE UNIVERSITY'S HONORARY DEGREE MEDALS

The University's Honorary Degree Medals worn today by our distinguished honorary degree recipients were formally presented to them at the annual "President's Dinner" held last evening in their honor at the Four Seasons Hotel in Washington, D.C. These medals commemorate the high esteem and honor bestowed upon them as honorary degree recipients at Howard University's 144th Commencement Convocation.

THE PRESIDENTIAL CHAIN OF OFFICE

The Presidential Chain of Office, worn by President Ribeau, was presented to the University on the occasion of the Centennial Celebration in 1967 by the late Trustee Emeritus, Herman B Wells, and his late mother, Mrs. Granville Wells. The chain symbolizes the current and past holders of the office of President. The basic material of the chain is sterling silver, plated with hard gold. Both the University Seal and the Centennial Seal are appended to the chain.

Shadowed beneath Thy hand, May we forever stand, True to our God,


