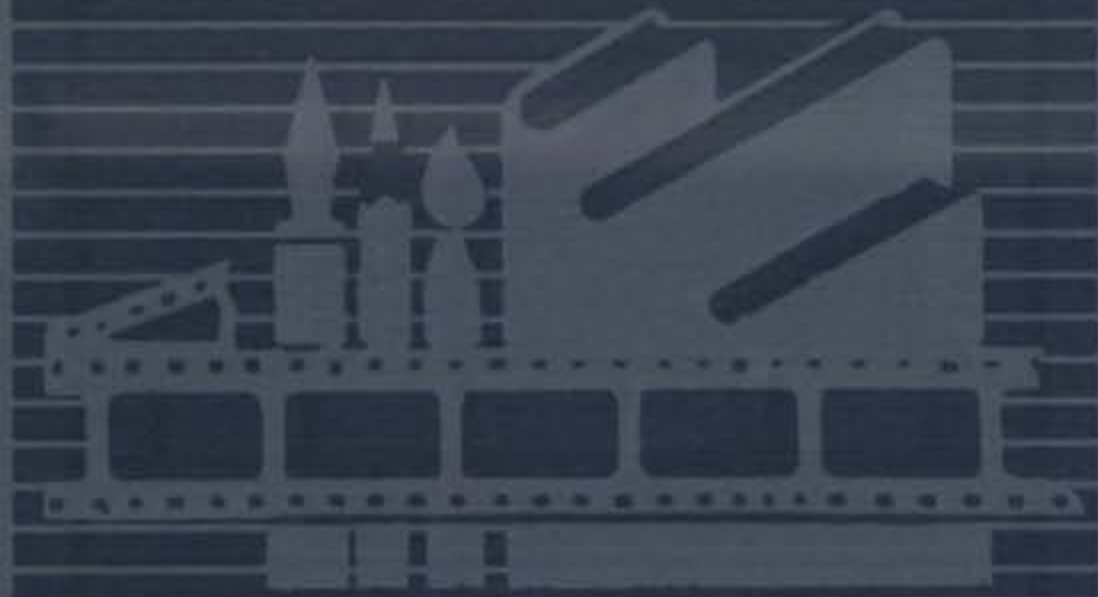

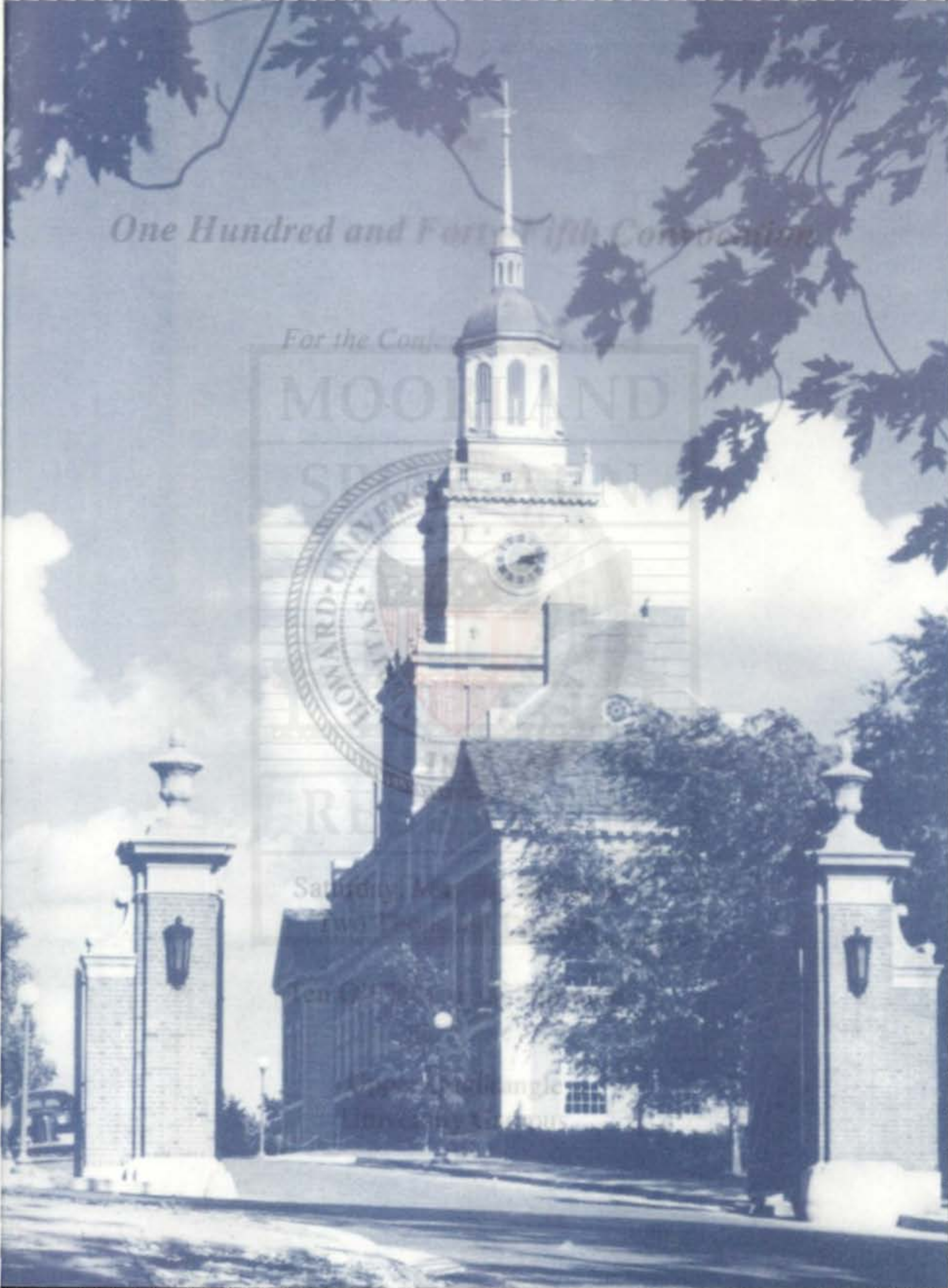

Marie Collins Johns has been a leader in business, civic and government service for more than 30 years.

Throughout her career, she has focused her community service in the areas of education and economic development. She has held senior positions in the telecommunications industry, including serving as President of Verizon Washington. Under her leadership, the company developed and implemented a regulatory plan that served as a model for the corporation. She is highly regarded for her corporate citizenship. One of her on-going efforts to leverage corporate resources for greater community good was the SEEDS program (Students Educated for Economic Development Success). It allowed dropouts to complete their high school requirements and receive technical training for jobs in the telecommunications industry. Over 200 students were employed as a result.

Her most recent appointment is Deputy Administrator of the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) in 2010, where she is responsible for management of the agency and development of SBA programs and policies. In 2011, her initiatives resulted in lending over \$30 billion to more than 60,000 small businesses, a record in SBA history. She has had the privilege of serving as the chair of the President's Interagency Task Force on Veterans Small Business Development. She was also the force behind "Start Young," a SBA/Department of Labor initiative that provides entrepreneurial training to Job Corps students and encourages them to use their technical skills to start a business.

She has also been an entrepreneur, founding L&L Consulting, LLC, an organizational effectiveness and public policy consulting practice. As a leader in the Washington, D.C. business community, she is recognized nationally as a champion for small businesses. She is a member of the Greater Washington Business Hall of Fame and one of Washingtonian magazine's "100 Most Powerful Women." In addition to being founding chair of the Washington DC Technology Council, she has served as a board member, president or

chair of the D.C. Chamber of Commerce, the Federal City Council, the Greater Washington Board of Trade, the Economic Club of Washington, Leadership Greater Washington, and the International Women's Forum of Washington, DC.

She was a member of the Board of Trustees of Howard University, served as Chair of the Academic Excellence Committee, and was the first chair of the Howard University Middle School of Mathematics and Science, a public charter school committed to academic excellence and preparing middle school students in the STEM disciplines. She has served on the board of Howard University Hospital, and on the national board of Girl Scouts USA.

Her passion for her adopted home – Washington, DC – led to a run for Mayor in 2006. Even though she was a first time candidate, her record of business and civic success, and her platform of creative solutions to tough problems led to a third place finish in a field of five candidates – all long-time incumbent office holders.

She is the recipient of over 100 awards for her community service, including the National Coalition of 100 Black Women, "Trailblazer in Business" Award; the *National Journal*, 25 Influential Black Women in Business Award; the D.C. Chamber of Commerce, Women's Leadership Award; and the Greater Washington Board of Trade, Leader of the Years Award.

Her Bachelor of Science and Master of Public Administration degrees are from the School of Public and Environmental Affairs, Indiana University, where she later served as a board member for the Tobias Center for Leadership Excellence. She also was awarded a Doctorate of Humane Letters degree from Trinity University (Washington DC). She is a member of Metropolitan African Methodist Episcopal Church, where she serves on the Senior Board of Stewards.

Marie and Wendell Johns have been married for over 42 years. Their son and daughter-in-law, Richard and Lynn Johns, are the parents of their beloved grandchildren, Richard Franklin and Lauren Marie.

MRS. SHEILA CRUMP JOHNSON

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Mr. Robert L. Lumpkins

Sheila Crump Johnson is a successful entrepreneur and impassioned philanthropist. As CEO of Salamander Hotels and Resorts, a hospitality company she founded in 2005, she oversees a growing portfolio of luxury properties. Grand Golf Resorts of Florida features three golf and family resorts reaching from the Gulf to the Atlantic – Innisbrook Resort near Tampa, Reunion Resort in Orlando, and Hammock Beach Resort in Palm Coast. The ultra-luxurious Salamander Resort & Spa will open in August 2013 in Middleburg, Virginia, the heart of the state's horse and wine country.

She is Vice Chairman of Monumental Sports & Entertainment and President and Managing Partner of the WNBA's Washington Mystics. She is the only African American woman to have ownership in three professional sports teams, including the NBA's Washington Wizards and the NHL's Washington Capitals.

She is a partner in ProJet Aviation, a comprehensive aviation service company specializing in aviation consulting, aircraft acquisitions, management, and charter services. She is also a partner in Mistral, the makers of fine bath, body, and home products. Inspired by her travels around the world, she recently launched her own collection of luxury scarves manufactured in Prato, Italy.

Her powerful influence in the entertainment industry for many decades began with her work as founding partner of Black Entertainment Television (BET). She has served as executive producer of four documentary films, including *Kicking It*, which

premiered at the 2008 Sundance Film Festival; *A Powerful Noise*, which premiered at the 2008 Tribeca Film Festival; *She is the Matador*; and *The Other City*, a critically acclaimed portrayal of the HIV/AIDS crisis in Washington DC, which premiered at the 2010 Tribeca Film Festival.

In 2006, she was named global ambassador for CARE, a leading humanitarian organization that combats poverty around the world by empowering women. Since 2011, she has served as Strategic Advisor for Multicultural and African American Initiatives for the AOL Huffington Post Media Group, and has served as a member of the International Council of the Accordia Global Health Foundation, rallying support for the efforts to overcome the burden of infectious diseases in Africa. She is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations.

A fervent supporter of education and the arts, she serves on the Board of Governors of Parsons The New School for Design in New York and Sundance Institute. She is a board member of the ANNIKA Foundation and is on the Executive Committee of the United States Golf Association.

An accomplished violinist, she received a Bachelor of Arts in Music from the University of Illinois, as well as honorary degrees from numerous other institutions. She lives in Middleburg, Virginia, is married to the Honorable William T. Newman, Jr., and has two children.

For the Degree of Doctor of Laws (Posthumously)
THE HONORABLE JACK F. KEMP
The Candidate Will Be Presented by Dr. Reed V. Tuckson
Member, Board of Trustees

The Honorable Jack F. Kemp, a Trustee at Howard University from 1993 until his passing in 2009, played pro-football 13 years, served as a member of the U.S. House of Representatives for 18 years, was Secretary of Housing and Urban Development for 4 years, and received his party's nomination for Vice President in 1996. For all of his accomplishments as a leader in sports and politics, his most enduring legacy will be the ideas he championed: growth, opportunity, inclusion, dignity, freedom and hope. Excerpts from one of the many tributes written upon his death:

"Jack believed that ideas -- not interests or political deals or public passions -- rule the world. Economic freedom, in his view, provides the poor with a hope beyond the dreams of socialism or large "L" Liberalism -- the hope of becoming wealthy themselves. Opportunity, he argued, is the most important measure of economic justice; capitalism is perfected by the broadest possible distribution of capital; and economic freedom and political freedom are inseparable.

This belief in the power of ideas removed all rancor from Jack's political approach. Everyone fell into one of two categories: convert or potential convert. He seemed to believe that if he had just an hour -- better yet, three hours -- with anyone, he could change their mind

by the force of his ideas. So he gave nearly everyone the benefit of the doubt. He assumed goodwill on the part of his opponents. And he became the rarest kind of public figure -- a conviction politician who was also a peacemaker.

The direction of Jack's career was set by two events. In the 1960s, he saw the American civil rights movement from the perspective of sports. As a quarterback and leader of the American Football League players union, he stood up for African American teammates victimized by segregation on their travels. The experience left a deeply rooted impatience with bigotry.

The second event that shaped Jack's career was a stroke of intellectual lightning in the 1970s that became known as supply-side economics. Jack was an amateur economist of broad reading, convinced he knew exactly the way the world works. National wealth depends on productivity, which depends on low tax rates that reward work, enterprise and investment.

Jack's ideals and priorities never really changed over the years, as a congressman, as a Cabinet secretary, as a vice presidential nominee...Be a happy warrior, not an angry one." © Michael Gerson, "Remembering Jack Kemp," The Washington Post, May 3, 2009.

PATRICIA A. McGUIRE, ESQ.

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Dr. Charles M. Boyd

Patricia McGuire is President of Trinity Washington University; her tenure began in 1989. Before coming to Trinity, she was the Assistant Dean for Development and External Affairs at Georgetown University Law Center, where she was also an adjunct professor of law. She began her career after law school as the project director for the DC Street Law clinical program at Georgetown. She was also a legal affairs commentator for the award-winning CBS children's news magazine "30 Minutes" and the Fox Television program "Panorama" in Washington.

She earned her Bachelor of Arts degree *cum laude* from Trinity College and her law degree from the Georgetown University Law Center. She writes and speaks on a wide variety of topics concerning higher education, women, and Catholic education. Her articles have appeared in *The Wall Street Journal*, *The Washington Post*, *The Baltimore Sun*, *Current Issues in Catholic Higher Education*, and a wide variety of other publications. Her blog on contemporary issues appears at www.trinitydc.edu/president/blog; another blog called "On Success" appears twice weekly in *The Washington Post* online.

She is currently a member on the boards of directors of the Greater Washington Board of Trade, the Washington Metropolitan Consortium of Universities, the D.C. College Success Foundation, the Community Foundation of the National Capital Region, the Morris and Gwendolyn Cafritz Foundation, United Educators, and the Ameritas Mutual Holding Company. She is also a member of the Women's Advisory Board of the Girl Scouts of the Nation's Capital.

In 2012, the National Association of Independent Colleges and Universities recognized her leadership in higher education with the Henry Paley Award. In 2007, the Greater Washington Board of Trade named her the "Leader of the Years," the top business honor for this regional chamber of commerce. The *Washington Business Journal* included her among the list of "Women Who Mean Business." *Washingtonian* magazine has named her among the "150 Most Powerful People in Washington" and the "100 Most Powerful Women of Washington." She has received several honorary degrees, and other honors and awards from business, civic and educational organizations.

In 2000, she was appointed by D.C. Mayor Anthony Williams and the D.C. Financial Control Board to a special term on the Education Advisory Committee overseeing the D.C. Public Schools. In June 1998, Treasury Secretary Robert Rubin appointed her to serve as a member of the first-ever citizens' advisory panel on coinage, the 8-member Dollar Coin Design Advisory Committee, which recommended the image of Sacagawea for the new dollar coin.

She served previously on the boards of Goodwill of Greater Washington, the Eugene and Agnes Meyer Foundation, the Washington Hospital Center, the American Council on Education, the National Association of Independent Colleges and Universities, the National Defense Intelligence College, the Association of Catholic colleges and Universities, and the Middle States Commission on Higher Education.

For the Degree of Doctor of Laws
THE HONORABLE WILLIAM JEFFERSON CLINTON
The Orator Will Be Presented by The Honorable L. Douglas Wilder
Member, Board of Trustees

William Jefferson Clinton was the first Democratic president in six decades to be elected twice – first in 1992 and then in 1996. Under his leadership, the country enjoyed the strongest economy in a generation and the longest economic expansion in U.S. history, including the creation of more than 22 million jobs.

After leaving the White House, President Clinton established the William J. Clinton Foundation with the mission to improve global health, strengthen economies, promote healthier childhoods, and protect the environment by fostering partnerships among governments, businesses, nongovernmental organizations (NGOs), and private citizens to turn good intentions into measurable results. Today, the Foundation has staff and volunteers around the world working to improve lives through several initiatives, including the Clinton Health Access Initiative (formerly the Clinton HIV/AIDS Initiative), which is helping more than 4 million people living with HIV/AIDS access life-saving drugs. Other initiatives – including the Clinton Climate Initiative, the Clinton Development Initiative, and the Clinton Giustra Sustainable Growth Initiative – are applying a business-oriented approach worldwide to fight climate change and develop sustainable economic growth in Africa and Latin America. Established in 2005, the Clinton Global Initiative brings together global leaders to devise and implement innovative solutions to some of the world's most pressing issues. In the U.S., the Foundation

is working to combat the alarming rise in childhood obesity through the Alliance for a Healthier Generation, and is helping individuals and families succeed and small businesses grow.

In addition to his Foundation work, President Clinton has joined with former President George H.W. Bush three times – after the 2004 tsunami in South Asia, Hurricane Katrina in 2005, and Hurricane Ike in 2008 – to help raise money for recovery efforts and served as the U.N. Envoy for Tsunami Recovery.

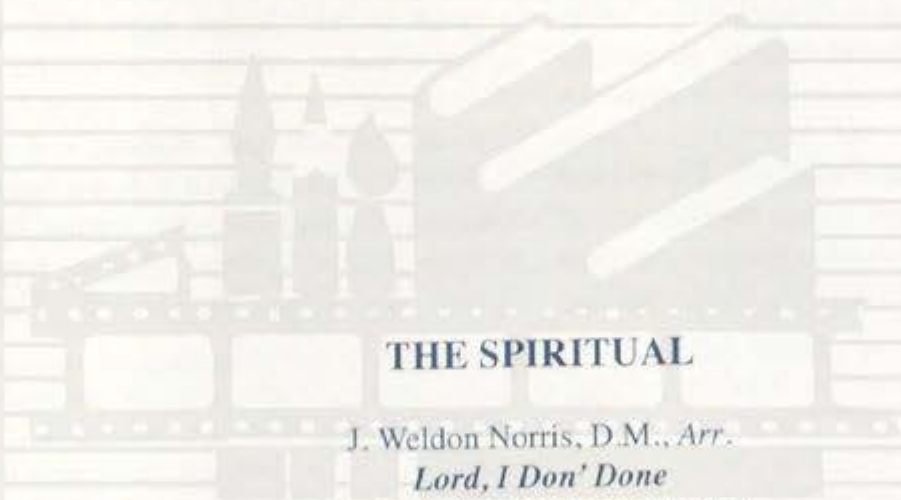
Building on his longstanding commitment to Haiti as President and through his Foundation, President Clinton was named U.N. Special Envoy for Haiti in 2009 to assist the government and the people of Haiti as they “build back better” after a series of hurricanes battered the country in 2008. Following the 2010 devastating earthquake in Haiti, he dedicated Clinton Foundation resources to help with immediate and long-term relief and assistance. At the request of President Obama, he joined with President George W. Bush to establish the Clinton Bush Haiti Fund, which supports highly effective organizations on the ground in long-term rebuilding efforts. Today, the Clinton Foundation is supporting economic growth, job creation, and sustainability in Haiti.

President Clinton was born on August 19, 1946, in Hope, Arkansas. He and his wife, former United States Secretary of State Hillary Rodham Clinton, have one adult daughter, Chelsea, and live in Chappaqua, New York.

THE CONFERRING OF DEGREES IN COURSE

The order of presentation of Schools and Colleges for the conferring of degrees is based on two factors—the year of establishment of the School or College and the distinction between graduate and undergraduate programs. The first seven Schools and Colleges, beginning with the College of Arts and Sciences and ending with the College of Pharmacy, and College of Nursing and Allied Health Sciences, were established between the years 1868 to 1997. Undergraduate programs are predominant in these seven Schools and Colleges. The next five Schools and Colleges, beginning with the School of Divinity and ending with the School of Social Work, were established between the years 1868 and 1945. These Schools and Colleges offer professional graduate level programs. The last School listed, the Graduate School, was established in 1934 and offers graduate-level programs exclusively.

THE MACE

The mace is the ceremonial symbol of the University and is carried by the University Marshal, Dr. Gary L. Harris, Dean of the Graduate School, Professor of Engineering and Director of the Howard Nanoscale Science and Engineering Facility (HNF). One of the earliest visual images of the mace is the front-side of the "Narmer Palette" of Ancient Egypt, an oval-shaped cosmetic palette inscribed with human and anthropomorphic figures. King Narmer is depicted on the palette as a mighty conqueror wielding a mace over a symbolic enemy. King Narmer, also known as King Menes or King Midas to the ancient Greeks, unified Upper and Lower Egypt *circa* 3100 B.C., ushering in the great pyramid building of the old kingdom dynasties (c. 3000-2150 B.C.) of Imperial Egypt. At today's Convocation, the entry of the mace heralds the arrival of the academic procession.

THE BATON

The batons carried by the Marshals and Assistant Marshals of each School are being used to lead the academic procession of the respective Schools and Colleges into and out of the place of the ceremony. The batons are made of wood, painted blue, and tied with red, white and blue ribbons denoting the colors of Howard University.

THE ACADEMIC DRESS

The caps, gowns, and hoods worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students used them to keep warm in medieval castles and halls of learning. From these practical origins, they have developed into the accepted garb which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves, pointed at the fingertips. These gowns may be worn either open or closed.

The Master's degree gown is worn open, and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow.

Gowns for the Doctorate degree are also worn open. They carry broad, velvet panels down the front, and three velvet bars on the full, round sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the degree.

Mortar board or caps worn with baccalaureate and Master's gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

The blue Kente stole worn by the graduates was commissioned for the 1996 Commencement by the University and produced in Ghana. The stole depicts the Nkasewa pattern, which means eloquence, wisdom, and intelligence, and the symbol, Fi-Hankra, means safety, security, brotherhood, and solidarity.

Faculty members and guests in today's procession are robed in gowns and hoods which represent the institutions from which they have received degrees.

The hood gives color and real meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the colors of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains as follows: medicine, green; music, pink; nursing, apricot; pharmacy, olive green; public administration, peacock blue; science, gold yellow; social work, citron; theology, scarlet; architecture, blue violet; arts, letters, and humanities, white; business, drab; dentistry, lilac; education, light blue; engineering, orange; fine arts, brown; law, purple; and philosophy, dark blue.

THE HONORS MEDAL AND HONORS CORDS

The Honors Medal is worn by graduates who have achieved cumulative grade point averages making them eligible for the *cum laude*, *magna cum laude*, or *summa cum laude* honors. The Medal and Honors Cords symbolize that excellence is a hallmark of Howard University. The Medal was commissioned by Howard's President Emeritus, H. Patrick Swygert, for the 1996 graduating class. Its round shape is enhanced with a gold finish, symbolizing the eternal and universal value of excellence. The center of the seal asserts the mission of the University – "Truth and Service." Encircling the seal is the phrase, "Honors Graduate and Leadership for America," which heralds excellence and the contributions of Howard University to the nation. The silver Honors Cord symbolizes the high academic rank of *magna cum laude*. The gold Honors Cord worn by graduates symbolizes the highest academic rank of *summa cum laude*.

THE TORCH PIN

The Torch Pin symbolizes that responsibility and excellence in leadership have been passed down and entrusted to the graduating seniors. It was commissioned by Howard's President Emeritus, H. Patrick Swygert, for the 1997 graduating class. Its round shape is enhanced with a gold finish, symbolizing the eternal and universal value of excellence. Encircling the seal is the phrase, "Howard University – Bearers of the Torch," which emboldens graduates to go forth in the Howard tradition to serve as beacons of hope and light in their respective communities.

THE UNIVERSITY'S HONORARY DEGREE MEDALS

The University's Honorary Degree Medals worn today by our distinguished honorary degree recipients were formally presented to them at the annual "President's Dinner" held last evening in their honor at the Four Seasons Hotel in Washington, D.C. These medals commemorate the high esteem and honor bestowed upon them as honorary degree recipients at Howard University's Commencement Convocation.

THE PRESIDENTIAL CHAIN OF OFFICE

The Presidential Chain of Office, worn by President Ribeau, was presented to the University on the occasion of the Centennial Celebration in 1967 by the late Trustee Emeritus, Herman B Wells, and his late mother, Mrs. Granville Wells. The chain symbolizes the current and past holders of the office of President. The basic material of the chain is sterling silver, plated with hard gold. Both the University Seal and the Centennial Seal are appended to the chain.

Let us march on till victory is won.

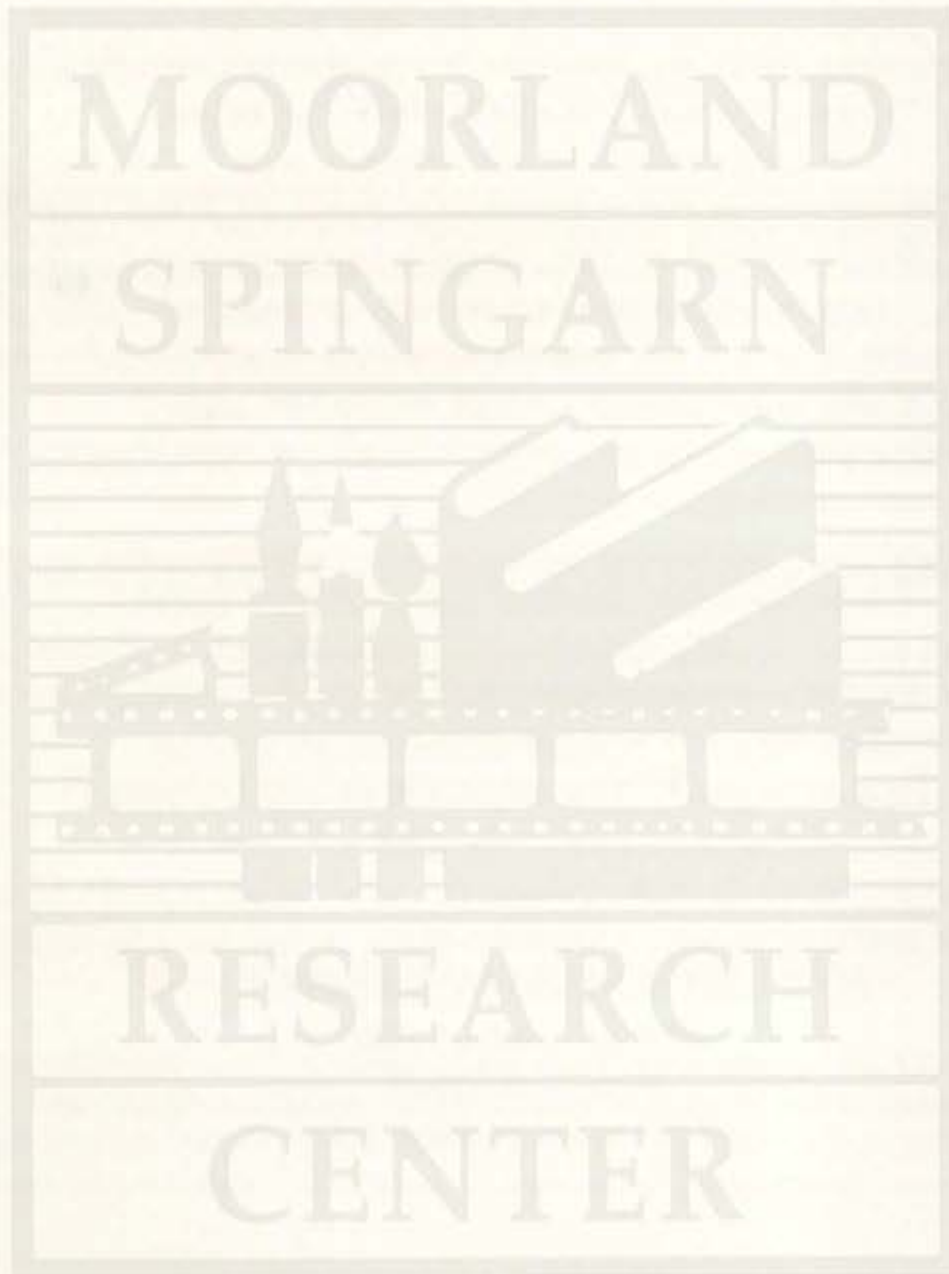
Stony the road we trod, bitter the chastening rod,
