MR. FRANK J. BISIGNANO

The Candidate Will Be Presented by the Honorable Alphonso Jackson Member, Board of Trustees

Frank Bisignano is the Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of First Data – one of the largest FinTech companies, providing commerce solutions to businesses and financial institutions across the globe. Bisignano joined First Data six years ago, and under his leadership, the company has transformed from a declining payments processing utility, to a valuable technology leader, enabling approximately 100 billion electronic transactions, representing \$2.6 trillion in payment volume and equity value of over \$20 billion.

Bisignano's leadership in Financial Services extends through his nearly 30-year career and includes senior roles at some of the world's largest financial institutions. Before coming to First Data, Bisignano served as Co-Chief Operating Officer and CEO of Mortgage Banking at JPMorgan Chase. Prior to Chase, Bisignano served in many leadership positions at Citigroup, including Chief Administrative Officer and CEO of the company's Global Transaction Services unit.

Now and throughout his business career, Bisignano contributes time and attention to causes for which he is committed and corporate citizenship. At First Data, Bisignano leads initiatives supporting a diverse workforce, and has been awarded a number of accolades for his work in unity and diversity, such as First Data's inclusion in the 2018 Bloomberg Equality Index. In 2011, Bisignano focused his vision for transformation to create career opportunities for men and women who served in uniform by founding the 100,000 Jobs

Mission, an initiative that is the leading private sector solution for hiring veterans.

In 2014, Bisignano received the Colonel Michael Endres Leadership Award for Individual Excellence in Veteran Employment from the U.S. Chamber of Commerce and the Man of the Year from the USO. In 2010, Bisignano was awarded Syracuse University's Chancellor's Medal for Outstanding Achievement for his innovation in technology and education. Syracuse University has bestowed upon him an Honorary Doctor of Law degree for his distinguished business career and his work in championing higher education and supporting the disadvantaged. He later received an honorary PhD from the New York Institute of Technology. In 2012, Bisignano received accolades for his work leading the Martin Luther King, Jr. Papers Project, which digitized hundreds of thousands of documents of Dr. Martin Luther King and other civil rights leaders. Bisignano also holds multiple board positions in both public sector and non-profit organizations including the Partnership for New York City, the National September 11 Memorial and Museum, The Battery Conservancy, The Perelman Center for Performing Arts at the World Trade Center, and many more. Bisignano was received by the Holy Father Pope Francis, and continues his work as a Trustee of St. Patrick's Cathedral in New

Born and raised in Brooklyn, New York, Bisignano has three children, Morgan, Alexa, and Henry. He and his wife, Tracy, reside in New Jersey.

DR. NORMAN C. FRANCIS

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Dr. Danette G. Howard Member, Board of Trustees

During his long tenure as president, Dr. Norman C. Francis and Xavier University of Louisiana were virtually synonymous.

As the leader of the nation's only historically Black and Catholic university, Francis guided Xavier's growth both in size and dimension. During his presidency, the University more than doubled its enrollment, broadened its curriculum, expanded its campus, and strengthened its financial base. Its tradition of academic excellence was further enhanced. Francis, then the longest-sitting university president in the U.S. (since 1968) and himself an alumnus, was at Xavier for more than five decades as an administrator. He was credited with being the catalyst for nearly every building constructed on the campus during a period of four decades. The campus itself was physically enlarged with the acquisition of the adjacent properties to the East and West of the original main campus.

Among the major accomplishments of Francis' tenure has been the successful completion of several capital campaigns. Giving by alumni also increased dramatically. All of this growth has not been at the expense of academia, however. Through his leadership, the University instituted a core curriculum and mandatory comprehensives, and became nationally recognized as a leader in minority education.

According to the U.S. Department of Education, Xavier continues to rank first nationally in the number of African American students earning undergraduate degrees in biology and the life sciences, chemistry, physics and pharmacy. Xavier is one of only six schools chosen to participate in the National Science Foundation's Model Institutions for Excellence in Science, Engineering and Mathematics program. Xavier has been especially successful in educating health professionals. In pre-medical education, Xavier is first in the nation in placing African American students into medical schools, where it has been ranked #1 since 1993. The College of Pharmacy, one of only two pharmacy schools in Louisiana, is among the nation's top three producers of African American Doctor of Pharmacy degree recipients.

Named by his peers as one of the 100 most effective college and university leaders, Francis is often cited for his involvement in the community and his work on the national, state and local levels to improve education. Francis enjoys a prestigious national reputation, of which Xavier is still a primary beneficiary. He has served in an advisory role to eight U.S. presidential administrations – not only on education issues, but civil rights as well – in addition to serving on 54 boards and commissions. In 2006 then-President George W. Bush presented him with the nation's highest civil award, the Presidential Medal of Freedom. In 2009 he was named one of "America's Best Leaders" by U.S. News Media Group and the Center for Public Leadership (CPL) at Harvard's Kennedy School of Government.

He has received 40 honorary degrees from other universities, and at least 20 major awards in recognition of his leadership in higher education as well as his unselfish service to New Orleans and to the nation. Among Francis' civic endeavors, he serves (or has served) as chair of the Louisiana Recovery Authority, immediate past chair of the Louisiana Disaster Recovery Foundation, immediate past chair of the Southern Education Foundation, chairman of the board of Liberty Bank and Trust and a member of the Times-Picayune Advisory Board. In the past he has been chairman of the New Orleans Aviation Board, the Metropolitan Area Committee Education Fund and the board of directors of PBS-affiliate WLAE-TV.

On the national level, Francis' activities include serving as past chairman of the boards of the Educational Testing Service, the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching, The College Board, the Southern Education Foundation and the American Association of Higher Education. In the past he was member president of the UNCF, a member of the Board of Trustees of Catholic University, and chairman of SACS, the southern regional accrediting agency for more than 11,000 institutions in 11 states.

Francis was named Xavier "President Emeritus" in 2015.

DR. JEANNE CRAIG SINKFORD

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Dr. Reed V. Tuckson Member, Board of Trustees

Dr. Jeanne Craig Sinkford is Senior Scholar-in-Residence Emerita. Office of the President and CEO of the American Dental Education Association. She is also Professor and Dean Emeritus, Howard University College of Dentistry. Dr. Sinkford's distinguished career in dental education includes serving as Dean of Howard University College of Dentistry from 1975-1991.

Dr. Sinkford is a nationally and internationally renowned dental educator, administrator, researcher and clinician. She finished first in the dental class of 1958 at Howard University before pursuing graduate study at Northwestern University where she received her M.S. (1962) and Ph.D. (1963). She completed a Pedodontic Residency at Children's Hospital National Medical Center in 1975. Dr. Sinkford became the first woman dean of a dental school in the U.S. in 1975. She served in that capacity for 16 years.

She has served on numerous committees and advisory councils of national significance including: Council, Institute of Medicine, National Academy of Sciences NRC Governing Board, National Advisory Dental Research Council; Directors' Advisory Council. National Institutes of Health; Governing Board of the American Society for Geriatric Dentistry; Advisory Board, Robert Wood Johnson Health Policy Program; Committee A, Council on Dental Education and Chair, Appeal Board Council of Dental Education, American Dental Association; Chair, Council of Deans, American Association of Dental Schools; Council on Dental Research, American Dental Association; Tuskegee Study Advisory Panel; Special Medical Advisory Group (SMAG), Veterans Administration; National Academy of Sciences; Chair, Anatomical Review Board of the District of Columbia and National Board of Directors of the Girl Scouts USA. She served on Advisory Boards: Boston University Goldman School of Dental Medicine, Howard University College of Dentistry, West Virginia University Health Sciences Center National Advisory Council, the Sullivan Alliance Advisory Board, the National Project Advisory Committee (NPAC) Department of Health and Human Services and the Advisory Committee on Research on Women's Health (ACRWH), National Institutes of Health.

Dr. Sinkford has more than 100 articles published in refereed journals and has written an instructional manual for Crown and Bridge Prosthodontics. From 1992 to 2011, Dr. Sinkford was responsible for diversity programming and initiatives at the American Dental Education Association (formerly, American Association of

Dental Schools). Under her leadership. ADEA created numerous opportunities for the advancement of women and under-represented minorities including: ADEA/Enid A. Neidle Scholar-in-Residence Program for Women; ADEA International Women's Leadership Conferences (1998, 2003, 2005, 2010); ADEA/W.K. Kellogg Access to Dental Careers Program: ADEA/W.K. Kellogg Minority Dental Faculty Development Program. Dr. Sinkford co-authored two seminal reports related to women's health: Women's Health in the Dental School Curriculum, Report of a Survey and Recommendations (1999) and ADEA Survey on Women's Health in the Dental Curriculum, An Update 2011.

Dr. Sinkford holds honorary degrees from the University of Michigan, Meharry Medical College, Georgetown University, the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey, and Detroit-Mercy University. She has received Alumni Achievement Awards from Northwestern University and Howard University and numerous other Citations for Exceptional Professional Achievement. Dr. Sinkford was selected as an Outstanding Leader in Dentistry by the International College of Dentists. She is the first AA woman to be so honored. She has received the Lucy Hobbs Taylor Award from the Association of American Women Dentists and Presidential Citation from the American Dental Association and the Society of American Indian Dentists.

Dr. Sinkford received the 2007 Trailblazer Award from the National Dental Association (NDA). She was also recognized with the distinguished 2009 Herbert W. Nickens Award from the Association of American Medical Colleges for her outstanding contribution to promoting justice in medical education and health care. In 2010, Dr. Sinkford received the Pierre Fauchard Academy Gold Medal Award for her outstanding contributions to the progress and standing of the dental profession. In 2015, Dr. Sinkford was presented with the American Dental Education Association's William J. Gies Award for Vision, Innovation and Achievement for Outstanding Vision by a Dental Educator and the American Dental Association's Distinguished Service Award. In 2017, Dr. Sinkford received the Lifetime Achievement Award from the American College of Dentists. She is a life member of the American Dental Association and was elected to Life Membership in the National Dental Association in 2012. Dr. Sinkford has been a member of the Institute of Medicine. National Academy of Sciences since 1975.

DR. MICHAEL R. WINSTON

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Dr. Laurence C. Morse Member, Board of Trustees

Born in New York City in 1941, Michael R. Winston received his secondary education at Stuyvesant High School. He was awarded the Bachelor of Arts degree in history magna cum laude by Howard University in 1962 and elected to Phi Beta Kappa. He then attended the University of Edinburgh as a Moten Fellow, to study British intellectual and social history. From 1969 to 1970 he was a Ford Foundation Faculty Fellow, undertaking research at the Haus, Hof-und Staatsarchiv in Vienna. The award of a Woodrow Wilson Fellowship and a John Hay Whitney Fellowship enabled him to complete graduate work in European history at the University of California, Berkeley, which awarded him the M.A. degree in French History in 1964 and the Ph.D. in European History in 1974. In 2008 Rollins College awarded him the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, honoris causa.

He was appointed to the Howard University faculty in 1964. Two years later, he became Associate Director of the Institute for Services to Education, which developed the National Upward Bound Program for the Office of Economic Opportunity during the administration of President Lyndon B. Johnson.

In 1968 he returned to Howard as Assistant Dean of the College of Liberal Arts, and later, the Director of Research in the Department of History. From 1973 to 1983 he was Director of the Moorland-Spingarn Research Center, where he established a professionally staffed Manuscript Division, Research Department, Oral History Department, the University Archives, and the Howard University Museum. He was appointed Vice President for Academic Affairs in 1983 by President James E. Cheek. Dr. Winston retired from Howard in 1990. In 1992 he became Vice President of the Alfred Harcourt Foundation, and President in 1993, serving in that role until his retirement in 2008. In 2013 he was asked by Interim President, Dr. Wayne A. I. Frederick to return to Howard as his Academic Counsel. In 2014 he was appointed Provost and Chief Academic Officer, serving until 2015. A year later, he retired from Howard University.

Dr. Winston has served as a consultant to many research organizations, government agencies, foundations and universities, including the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, the Joint Center for Political Studies, the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars (Senior Scholar, 2001-2008), the National Endowment for the Humanities, the National Science Foundation,

the Library of Congress and the Smithsonian Institution. From 1980 to 1991 he was a member of the Board of Directors of Harcourt Brace Jovanovich, Inc., then the world's largest publisher of scientific, medical and educational books. From 1992 to 1993 he was Chairman of the World History Committee of the National Council for History Standards. He has also been a member of the Council on Foreign Relations, the Council of Scholars of the Library of Congress, the Board of Managers of the Historical Society of Washington, and a Center Scholar at the National Center for History at the University of California, Los Angeles. From 1996 to 2006 he was a member of the Board of Overseers Visiting Committee for the Department of History at Harvard University.

In Washington, D.C. he has been a trustee of the District of Columbia Public Defender Service, (1985-1988); President of the District of Columbia Public Library Foundation, (1995-1999); and a member of the Board of Governors of the Folger Shakespeare Library, (2007-2011).

From 1997 to 2006 he was a trustee of the Woodrow Wilson National Fellowship Foundation in Princeton, New Jersey.

Michael R. Winston is co-author with Rayford W. Logan of The Negro in the United States, Vol. 11 (1970), and author of The Howard University Department of History, 1913-1973. He is also co-editor with Rayford W. Logan of The Dictionary of American Negro Biography (1982), and co-editor with Genna Rae McNeil of Historical Judgments Reconsidered (1988). He has also written articles and reviews for many scholarly and professional journals. In 2012, the Oxford Handbook of Psychology included his collaborative research with Cynthia E. Winston, "Cultural Psychology of Racial Ideology in Historical Perspective: An Analytic Approach to Understanding Racialized Societies and the Psychological Effects on Lives."

In 1963 he married Judith A. Marianno Winston, who is former General Counsel and Under Secretary of the United States Department of Education. They have two daughters, Lisa M. Hicks (Jerry Hicks) an attorney in Dallas Texas, and Cynthia E. Winston Proctor, (Christopher Proctor) Professor of Psychology at Howard University. Their two grandchildren are Lindsey E. Hicks of Dallas and Winston Michael Proctor of Washington.

For the Presidential Medal of Achievement

THE HONORABLE M. KASIM REED

The Candidate Will Be Presented by Stacey Mobley, Esq. Chairman, Board of Trustees

M. Kasim Reed is an American attorney and politician who served two terms as the 59th mayor of the city of Atlanta from 2010 to 2018. Reed is a graduate and proud alumnus of Howard University where he received his Bachelor of Arts and Juris Doctor degrees and an honorary Doctor of Laws. As an undergraduate member of Howard University's Board of Trustees, he created a fundraising program entitled The Independence Initiative that has contributed more than \$12 million to the University's endowment since its inception. Reed became the institution's youngest general trustee in June 2002 and remains a dedicated trustee emeritus.

As mayor, Reed increased core city services while reducing Atlanta's spending during the worst recession in 80 years. His Administration led the city to unprecedented growth, fiscal stability and international respect. Upon entering office, Reed hired more than 900 police officers, creating the largest police force in Atlanta's history. He oversaw a 37 percent drop in crime during his tenure. He also improved fire rescue response times and re-opened all of the city's previously shuttered recreation centers as safe havens for young people. During his tenure, he successfully led a series of sweeping reforms to address the city's \$1.5 billion unfunded pension liability. Though he began his term managing a \$2.2 billion overall budget and facing a \$48 million budget shortfall, under Reed's leadership, Atlanta produced eight years of balanced budgets

with no property tax increases, increased its cash reserves from \$7.4 million to \$200 million, and received nine consecutive credit rating increases resulting in an AA+ credit rating from Standard & Poor's, Moody's and Fitch. As a result, at the conclusion of Reed's service, the City of Atlanta was on its best financial footing in 40 years.

He is a graduate member of the Aspen Institute-Rodel Fellowship Class of 2007, Leadership Georgia Class of 2000 and Leadership Atlanta Class of 1998. Reed was a prime-time speaker at the 2016 National Democratic Convention in Philadelphia. In 2011, Governing Magazine named Reed one of the top state-and-local government officials of the year. Thomas Friedman, the Pulitzer Prize-winning New York Times columnist and author of That Used to Be Us, called Reed "inspiring" and labeled him as "one of the best of this new breed of leaders." And David Axelrod, former Chief Strategist for President Barack Obama, called him "the most dynamic Mayor in America." In 2013, he was ranked among the top 10 most influential African Americans in the nation by The Root. His civic leadership and service have been nationally recognized on news outlets and programs such as Meet the Press, MSNBC, CNN, FOX and CNBC; and in publications including The New York Times, the Wall Street Journal, and the Washington Post.

Reed lives in Atlanta with wife, Sarah-Elizabeth and their daughter, Maria Kristan.

THE CONFERRING OF DEGREES IN COURSE

The order of presentation of Schools and Colleges for the conferring of degrees is based on two factors—the year of establishment of the School or College and the distinction between graduate/professional and undergraduate programs. The first six Schools and Colleges, beginning with the College of Arts and Sciences and ending with the College of Nursing and Allied Health Sciences, were established between the years 1868 to 1974. Undergraduate programs are predominant in these six Schools and Colleges. The next six Schools and Colleges, beginning with the College of Medicine and ending with the School of Social Work, were established between the years 1868 and 1945. These Schools and Colleges offer professional graduate level programs. The last School listed, the Graduate School, was established in 1934 and offers graduate-level programs exclusively.







THE MACE

THE MACE is the ceremonial symbol of the University and is carried by the University Marshal. One of the earliest visual images of the mace is the front-side of the "Narmer Palette" of Ancient Egypt, an oval-shaped cosmetic palette inscribed with human and anthropomorphic figures. King Narmer is depicted on the palette as a mighty conqueror wielding a mace over a symbolic enemy. King Narmer, also known as King Menes or King Midas to the ancient Greeks, unified Upper and Lower Egypt circa 3100 B.C., ushering in the great pyramid building of the old kingdom dynasties (c. 3000-2150 B.C.) of Imperial Egypt. At today's Convocation, the entry of the mace heralds the arrival of the academic procession.

THE BATON

THE BATON carried by the Marshals and Assistant Marshals of each School is being used to lead the academic procession of the respective Schools and Colleges into and out of the place of the ceremony. The batons are made of wood, painted blue, and tied with red, white and blue ribbons denoting the colors of Howard University.

THE ACADEMIC DRESS

THE CAP, GOWN, AND HOOD worn at college and university functions date back to the Middle Ages. Monks and students used them to keep warm in medieval castles and halls of learning. From these practical origins, they have developed into the accepted garb which symbolizes scholarly achievement.

Baccalaureate gowns have a long pleated front with shirring across the shoulders and back. They are primarily distinguished by flowing sleeves, pointed at the fingertips. These gowns may be worn either open or closed.

The Master's degree gown is worn open, and the sleeve is cut so that the forearm comes through a slit just above the elbow.

Gowns for the Doctorate degree are also worn open. They carry broad, velvet panels down the front, and three velvet bars on the full, round sleeves. This velvet trimming may be either black or the color distinctive of the degree.

Mortar board or caps worn with Baccalaureate and Master's gowns generally have black tassels. The tassel of the doctoral cap is usually made of gold bullion.

The blue Kente stole worn by the graduates was commissioned for the 1996 Commencement by the University and produced in Ghana. The stole depicts the Nkasewa pattern, which means eloquence, wisdom, and intelligence, and the symbol. Fi-Hankra, means safety, security, brotherhood, and solidarity.

Faculty members and guests in today's procession are robed in gowns and hoods which represent the institutions from which they have received degrees.

The hood gives color and real meaning to the academic costume. Its silk lining bears the colors of the institution conferring the degree. The hood is bordered with velvet of prescribed width and color to indicate the field of learning to which the degree pertains as follows: medicine, green; music, pink; nursing, apricot; pharmacy, olive green; public administration, peacock blue; science, gold yellow; social work, citron; theology, scarlet; architecture, blue violet; arts, letters, and humanities, white; business, drab; dentistry, lilac; education, light blue; engineering, orange; fine arts, brown; law, purple; and philosophy, dark blue.

THE HONOR MEDAL AND HONOR CORD

THE HONOR MEDAL and HONOR CORD are worn by graduates who have achieved cumulative grade point averages making them eligible for the cum laude, magna cum laude, or honors. The Medal and Honor Cord symbolize that excellence is a hallmark of Howard University. The Medal was commissioned by Howard's President Emeritus, H. Patrick Swygert, for the 1996 graduating class. Its round shape is enhanced with a gold finish, symbolizing the eternal and universal value of excellence. The center of the seal asserts the mission of the University—"Truth and Service." Encircling the seal is the phrase, "Honors Graduate and Leadership for America," which heralds excellence and the contributions of Howard University to the nation. The silver Honor Cord symbolizes the high academic rank of magna cum laude. The gold Honor Cord worn by graduates symbolizes the highest academic rank of.

THE TORCH PIN

THE TORCH PIN symbolizes that responsibility and excellence in leadership have been passed down and entrusted to the graduating seniors. It was commissioned by Howard's President *Emeritus*, H. Patrick Swygert, for the 1997 graduating class. Its round shape is enhanced with a gold finish, symbolizing the eternal and universal value of excellence. Encircling the seal is the phrase, "Howard University — Bearers of the Torch," which emboldens graduates to go forth in the Howard tradition to serve as beacons of hope and light in their respective communities.

THE UNIVERSITY'S HONORARY DEGREE MEDAL

THE UNIVERSITY'S HONORARY DEGREE MEDAL, worn today by our distinguished honorary degree recipients, is formally presented to them at the annual "Commencement Dinner" held last evening in their honor at the Four Seasons Hotel in Washington, D.C. These medals commemorate the high esteem and honor bestowed upon them as honorary degree recipients at Howard University's Commencement Convocation.

THE PRESIDENTIAL CHAIN OF OFFICE

THE PRESIDENTIAL CHAIN OF OFFICE, worn by President Wayne A. I. Frederick, was presented to the University on the occasion of the Centennial Celebration in 1967 by the late Trustee *Emeritus*, Herman B. Wells, and his late mother, Mrs. Granville Wells. It is a visible symbol of the Office of the President and has been worn by all presidents of Howard University, since 1967. The basic material of the chain is sterling silver, plated with hard gold. Both the University Seal and the Centennial Seal are appended to the chain.
