Scope Note

The papers of Myra Spaulding cover the period from 1892 to 1922 and measure approximately one linear foot. This collection consists of letters, invitations, greeting cards, and postcards of family, friends, and business contacts. The collection also includes three certificates and a pamphlet featuring a map of Washington, D.C. that shows the locations of established churches.

Biographical Sketch

Biographic information on Myra L. Spaulding is sketchy. She received her teaching certificate from the State of New York, November 16, 1892, her Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Chicago in 1900 and Master of Arts degree from the same university in 1904.

Between the years 1918-1922 Myra Spaulding lived in a boarding house in Southeast Washington, D.C. and worked as a searcher with the War Department's War Risk Insurance Division which was organized in 1917 under the Adjutant General.

No other biographic information could be found on Myra Spaulding.
