The Isabele Taliaferro Spiller collection consists of a combination

of manuscript material of Isabele Spiller, Director of the Spiller School

of Music, New York City, and her husband, William N. Spiller, founder of

the school.

The collection contains biographical material on the Taliaferro and

Spiller families, correspondence, photographs, organizational material,

and a large volume of material relating to the Spiller School of Music

and the Musical Spillers.

The Musical Spillers were a unique musical group organized by William

 $$\rm N.$$ and Isabele T. Spiller in 1906 in Chicago, Illinois. The group performed

all over the United States, Europe, South America and Africa. There are

broadsides, playbills, programs, clippings, and photographs publicizing

the exciting musical career of these famous black musicians during the

years 1906-1940. There are also a number of individual profiles of

members of the group.

Mrs. Spiller provides her own personal notes and reminiscences to

many of the materials, particularly the photographs, giving an added
