Scope Note

The Sara A. Turner collection consists of two scrapbooks covering the period from 1866 to 1901. The materials contains poems; prayers; religious anecdotes; articles and multi-subject clippings on the Negro from various newspapers; clippings of political conventions, congressional reports and

other articles of national and international importance. A special interest of the compiler seems to be to collect obituaries of famous Black men.
