Scope Note

Medical reprints by Black physicians, printed material on Black medical organizations, the writings of Dr. Wright, and some family and personal papers constitute the Louis T. Wright Collection. The collection totals ten linear feet and the time period spans from 1878 to 1952. The collection was donated by his wife, Mrs. Corinne Wright, in 1955.

Dr. Louis T. Wright (1891-1952), Director of Surgery of Harlem Hospital, Chairman of the Board of the NAACP, and recipient of the 1940 Spingarn Medal, was a prolific writer of medical articles. Dr. Wright's interest in medical research was not limited to his personal inquiries but extended to the research of other Black physicians. He kept detailed records of his research projects and actively collected the published writings of other Black physicians.

Dr. Wright's interests generated an important collection of medical articles on and by Black physicians and included printed material on Black medical organizations. The reprints by Black physicians cover the spectrum of medical inquiry. Subject areas include surgical procedures, general medical issues, Negro health concerns and unusual medical cases. In some instances the physician had several fields of expertise, so non-medical writings are also included among these materials. The printed material on Black medical organizations includes information on outstanding faculty, special events, and some historical sketches.

Scope Note continued

Prominent Black physicians in the collection include W. Montague Cobb, Charles R. Drew, William A. Hinton, Peter Marshall Murray, and Hildrus Poindexter. Prominent Black medical organizations in the collection include Freedmen's Hospital, Harlem Hospital, Howard University Medical School, Medio-Chirurgical Society of D.C., Manhattan Medical Society, and Meharry Medical School.

The series of writings by Wright documents his many contributions to Harlem Hospital and to the medical field. One research project of special note was the 1948 aureomycin project. Dr. Wright, head of a research team of doctors, was the first to use aureomycin (a new antibiotic) in humans.

From 1948 to 1951 this group was responsible for many articles in the use of aureomycin. In this particular series, there are over 25 articles, some with research notes, on aureomycin. Dr. Wright's personal papers include an excellent autobiographical sketch and several biographical sketches. The career and honors data, clippings, correspondence, and printed material reveal many of Dr. Wright's achievements. Of special note is a group of materials on the Louis T. Wright Library of Harlem Hospital Dinner, a testimonial and dedication program held in 1952. The dedication of the library was held to acknowledge Dr. Wright's pursuit of professional medical research, his life long efforts to end discrimination and his contributions to Harlem Hospital and the Harlem community.

Scope note continued

Two important works: *Surgeons of the Poor: The Harlem Hospital Story*, 1978 by Dr. Aubre de L'Maynard, and "Louis Tompkins Wright, 1891-1952" by W. Montague Cobb in the *Journal of the National Medical Association*, March 1953, highlight the significance of many of the printed articles in this collection and provide excellent insight on the life and works of Dr. Wright.
