**Abstract** Helen Brown was a teacher of home economics in the D.C. Public School

system for over 40 years. Her papers consist of consist of teaching

materials, lecture notes, and sheet music. Of particular interest are family papers, including correspondence and writings of her father, Sterling N.

Brown, and her brother, Sterling A. Brown.

## Biographical/Historical note

Helen Brown was born in Washington, D.C. Her parents, Rev. Sterling N. Brown and Adelaide A. Brown, had five other children. Her brother was Sterling A. Brown, literary scholar and professor at Howard University. Her sister was Elsie Brown Smith, Dunbar High School teacher and wife of Principal Walter L. Smith. Along with her sisters and brothers, she attended M Street High School, now Dunbar. She received her bachelor's degree in Home Economics in 1920 from Howard University, and her master's degree from Columbia University in 1929. In addition to her studies at Howard and Columbia, Helen also studied at New York and Catholic universities. Helen joined Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. in 1917, just four years after its founding at Howard University. In 1920, Helen was appointed to teach home economics at Armstrong High School, where she eventually chaired the department. As part of her teaching responsibilities, Helen served as teacher of Foods and Nutrition and managed the cafeteria. After Armstrong closed, Helen continued her teaching career at Roosevelt High School, and then to Eastern High School, retiring in 1964. Helen taught home economics for over 40 years in the D.C. public school system, serving as the head of the district department during the latter years of her appointment. After retiring from the school district, Helen worked for the Woodlawn Cemetery Perpetual Care Association in order to save and restore one of the last predominately African American burial sites in the city. Helen was a member of Lincoln Temple Congregational Church for over 60 years. Her father, Rev. Sterling N. Brown, served as pastor of Lincoln Temple. Helen passed away in August 1985.

## **Scope and Contents note**

The Helen Brown Papers consist of teaching materials, lecture notes, and sheet music. Also included are reports concerning the Home Economics curriculum in D.C. Public Schools, and conference and workshop materials. Of particular interest are family papers, including correspondence and writings of her father, Sterling N. Brown, and her brother, Sterling A.
