Abstract	Mark Hanna Watkins was an anthropologist and linguist who studied and published books about African languages. The Mark Hanna Watkins papers document Watkins' teaching career and research on African linguistics. Among the files are teaching files for anthropology and sociology classes, research files on Yoruba and Swahili, journals, correspondence, organizational files, and notebooks.

Biographical/Historical note

Mark Hanna Watkins was an anthropologist and linguist who studied and published books about African languages. Watkins was born in Huntsville, Texas to Walter and Laura Williams Watkins in 1903. Watkins later graduated from Prairie View State College with a B.A. in Education in 1926. After his undergraduate years, Watkins entered the University of Chicago to earn a master's degree (1930) and a doctorate (1933) in anthropology, one of the first African Americans to do so. While Watkins's undergraduate research was about Guatemala and native languages in Mexico, his Ph.D. work examined African languages. His dissertation titled, *A Grammar of Chichewa: A Bantu Language of British Central Africa*, was the first book on African grammar and intonation written by an American. Following graduate school, Watkins accepted a position as professor of anthropology at Fisk University in Nashville, Tennessee, serving from 1934-1947. In 1943, the first African Studies program in the country was created at Fisk and Watkins served as one of the faculty members in the department. In 1947, Watkins began his tenure at Howard University as a professor in the Sociology department, primarily working with African languages. Watkins eventually served as the head of the Sociology department while also a professor of anthropology. Watkins pressed for recognition of African languages at universities nation-wide and facilitated the African language center, which opened at Howard University by an Act of Congress. Under contract with the Department of Health, Education and Welfare, Watkins created material for Howard's center as well as centers at the University of California, Duquesne University and Michigan State University. Watkins was a visiting professor and lecturer at universities all over the world including the Universidad de San Carlos in Guatemala, Escuela Nacional de Antropología e Historia in Mexico, Georgetown University, and the University of Chicago. Watkins belonged to several professional associations including the African Studies Association, the American Association of Physical Anthropologists, Linguistic Society, and the Society for Applied Anthropology.
