Scope and Content

The Papers of the Pittsburgh Courier Washington Bureau span the years 1946-1968 and measure approximately 13 linear feet. The manuscript portion of the collection documents the relationship between the Washington branch and the main office of the Courier in Pittsburgh. Correspondence forms the bulk of this portion and documents the inter-departmental relationships of the Washington Bureau. Primary correspondents include Washington Bureau Chiefs, Levi Jolley and Hugo Warren, as well as Bookkeeper Josephine E. Lowery. Correspondents are listed alphabetically. The remainder of the manuscript portion of the collection includes material documenting the roles of the advertising, circulation, and financial and legal departments of the Washington Bureau.

The bulk of the collection (9 1/2 linear feet) consists of approximately 3,500 photographs from the 1940's to the 1960's documenting all aspects of African-American life in Washington and across the Nation. Primary photographers include Blackburn, Cabell, Harris, Pease, and Scurlock. The photographs are arranged by subject including People, Business, Education, Entertainment, Social Events, and Sports. The bulk of the photographs are of entertainment figures and include images of such notable performers as Louis Armstrong, Duke Ellington, The Edward Sisters, Katherine Dunham, Ella Fitzgerald, Lionel Hampton, Billie Holliday, Dinah Washington, and Muddy Waters.

The Moor land-Spingarn Research Center purchased the collection after the Washington Bureau closed in the 1970's.

A Correspondence, 1948-1968

The correspondence document the inter-departmental functioning of the Washington Bureau, as well as its relationship with the main office in Pittsburgh, and with its subscribers. The bulk of the correspondence are from the offices of Levi Jolley, E. Josephine Lowery, Robert Robinson, and Hugo Warren. Their correspondence are arranged alphabetically. Other significant correspondents include Trezzvant Anderson, George F. Brown, J. Walter Carroll, W. Beverly Carter, Jackson Lowe, John C. Moore, George Nunn, and Willard Savoy. The subseries, Metropolitan Police Department, is a collection of letters documenting the Courier's role in the D.C. police department's "Award of Merit." The subseries, Other Correspondence, includes both internal and external communications.

The bulk of the series is comprised of entertainment photographs documenting local and national performers including Louis Armstrong, Duke Ellington, The Edward Sisters, Katherine Dunham, Ella Fitzgerald, Lionel Hampton, Billie Holliday, The Orioles, Muriel Rahn, Dinah Washington, and Muddy Waters. Other subseries of note include those of Businesses, highlighting African American owned businesses in the District; Social Events, including anniversaries, banquets, beauty pageants, birthdays, debutantes, embassies, fashion, formal occasions, funerals, parades, parties, presentations, and weddings; and Sports, including images of local and national athletes participating in baseball, basketball, boating, bowling, boxing, equestrian, football, golf, tennis, track and field, weight-lifting, and wrestling.
