Case Awards

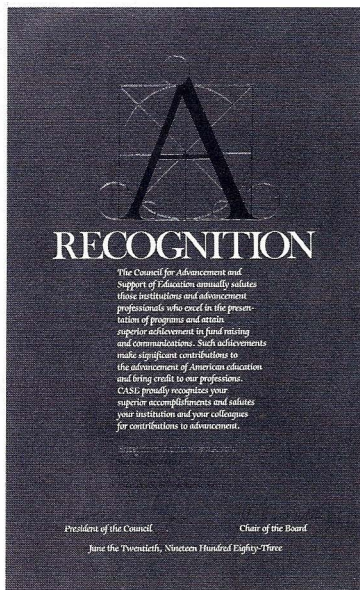
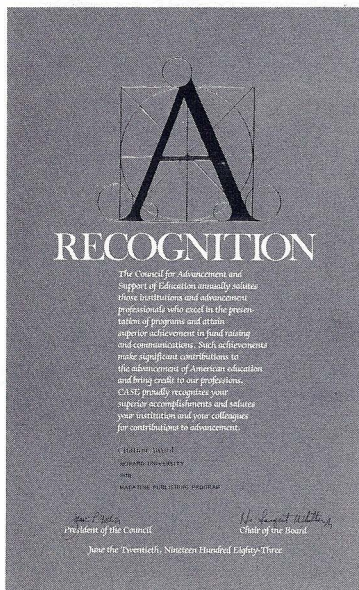
This year, *New Directions* won two additional national honors — an Exceptional Achievement Award for Excellence in Periodical Writing and a Citation for Magazine Publishing—both from the Council for Advancement and Support of Education, CASE.

During the past 10 years, *New Directions* has won nine CASE national awards in all areas of magazine publishing, including "Top 10 Magazine/Editor Award" in 1975 and 1980. The 1983 award for excellence in periodical writing, the second since 1980, marks a double win—for the magazine and for staff writer Harriet Jackson Scarupa.

Other awards for excellence since 1975 include two from the Printers Industries of America, and one each from McGraw Hill and the Advertising Directors Club of Washington.
