I've learned from the bulletin many interesting things about the dear ole school of which you may not be quite as loud as I. You see it whenever you like. Here on the front lines in Italy I sort of wish I were back there in some class with my wife, Mrs. Ewena M. Bage. She's doing quite well there. Thank you.

I really appreciate the bulleting. Saw one in a regimental headquarters where at least six ex-Howard men greeted me by surprise. I hope to see my correct address printed in the next issue instead of "whereabouts unknown." Thank you and goodbye.
